Mershmellow drafted like someone panicking at an auction they couldn't afford, and the board kept the receipts. The three major reaches tell the whole story: Brian Thomas Jr. pulled more than two rounds early, D.J. Moore yanked nearly as far, and Ray Davis, a projected RB62, somehow got treated like a difference-maker at pick 17.05 when his ADP was buried in round 20. Zero steals, zero values, nineteen picks that were either chalk or a manager bidding against themselves. The result is a team sitting 12th in the Stadium division and in the 8th percentile of the field, which is the draft class equivalent of a participation trophy with a dent in it. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is genuinely elite and the one moment where Mershmellow let the board come to them, but Baker Mayfield at QB18 and Bryce Young at QB26 project as the starting options at the position, and Dallas Goedert at TE15 is fine without being exciting. When your best argument is Gibbs, your draft philosophy failed you everywhere else.

Daboys222 ran a disciplined draft, which is supposed to matter. Garrett Wilson fell a round and a half before the pick at 6.01, Tyler Warren slid nearly a full round to 3.12, and David Njoku dropped a staggering 3.2 rounds before anyone bothered to notice him at 18.01. That is real execution. And yet the roster lands 11th in the division and in the 17th percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether efficiency is its own reward. The problem is that getting value on a player only helps if that player projects to help you, and this roster is built around a WR group rated average and an RB group rated average despite the patience exercised in building both. Joe Burrow at QB4 is legitimately good, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 is legitimately good, but below them the drop-off is gradual in the wrong direction, with Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 and Chuba Hubbard at RB29 anchoring a starting group that the projections find underwhelming. Daboys222 bought the right tickets to the wrong movie.

Miller Genuine Draftees are sitting at 27th percentile and 10th in the Stadium division, and the painful irony is that the plan itself is sound. The entire roster is built around two stacks, Drake Maye paired with A.J. Brown and Bo Nix paired with Jaylen Waddle, and if those connections fire, this team has a real ceiling. The problem is that correlation cuts both ways. Maye is a QB2 with Brown projected as a WR8, so that pairing carries genuine upside, but the Nix-Waddle stack is the one that keeps you up at night. Waddle moving from Miami's dysfunction to Denver is genuinely encouraging, and Nix led the league in pass attempts, but projecting a new pairing to click on schedule in a tournament format is a coin flip with consequences. If one stack collapses, you are leaning entirely on the other, and leaning entirely on anything in the Scott Fish Bowl is a quiet way to go home early. The ceiling exists. The floor is somewhere underground.

MaxxPowers enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Stadium Division, projecting out in the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The receiver group is legitimately impressive, headlined by Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and supported by Tetairoa McMillan, Ladd McConkey, and Marvin Harrison Jr., all projected starters. But the draft that assembled this roster was defined less by shrewd maneuvering than by wishful thinking elsewhere: Jaxson Dart was taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, Jacoby Brissett was grabbed nearly three rounds early, and neither is projected to crack the top 25 at their position. That is three high draft picks spent on a quarterback room that grades out strong largely because of Jayden Daniels, who was already on the roster. The talent at the top is real, but with zero steals, three major reaches, and a projected starter floor of Jayden Reed at WR48, MaxxPowers looks like a team that drafted its ceiling and mortgaged the depth needed to reach it.

ImakeitBlaine sits eighth in the Stadium division and in just the 42nd percentile of the field, and the draft record explains why the ceiling feels low before a single game is played. The manager burned a fifth-round pick on Jordan Love at QB17 when the consensus said wait until round seven, then doubled down by taking Justin Fields at QB38 nearly eight rounds ahead of schedule in the late rounds, where real value is the only currency that matters. Those two reaches consumed capital that could have shored up a receiver group where Tee Higgins at WR19 is the lone projected starter with genuine upside and the next name behind her is Khalil Shakir at WR51. Josh Allen at QB1 is real and the stack with Dalton Kincaid at TE11 is a legitimate tournament weapon, but a roster climbs on the back of its weakest projected starter, and RJ Harvey checking in at RB28 is a fragile floor. The pieces that grade out well were mostly acquired at chalk prices, leaving no hidden leverage to unlock if things go sideways.

heismanberg_ is the fantasy equivalent of a mid-table soccer club that will not be relegated and will not win the title, and they know it, and they have made their peace with it. The receiver corps is genuinely dangerous, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Drake London at WR7, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 giving this roster a ceiling that can survive a bad week from almost anyone else. The Jalen Hurts and Smith stack adds a multiplier on the good weeks when everything hums. But the margins are where this season lives or dies, and the draft introduced two fault lines: Cam Ward taken 2.1 rounds early for a QB23 projection, and Jalen Coker grabbed 2.2 rounds before the market agreed, landing at WR55. Neither is a disaster, but in a 50th-percentile roster where every point counts, spending future capital on a speculative quarterback and a fringe receiver does not buy insurance, it spends it. When heismanberg_ contends, it will be because St. Brown, London, and Smith carried the weeks the reaches could not.

jewishchilean sits at the tournament's exact midpoint, 51st percentile, which sounds like a polite way of saying "could go either way" and is exactly that. The foundation is real: Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Omarion Hampton (RB9) anchor a deep backfield, and a receiving corps headlined by Malik Nabers (WR12), Rashee Rice (WR13), and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) gives this roster genuine upside in the starters that matter most. The problem is that jewishchilean spent draft capital like someone who genuinely believes in their own hunches, logging five major reaches with essentially nothing coming back the other way, zero steals and zero values across the entire board. Kaytron Allen (RB61) cost nearly five rounds of premium, Tyreek Hill (WR77) cost three, and Fernando Mendoza (QB27) was drafted like a QB10. Those late-round gambles compress the margin between a winning week and a frustrating one. When KC Concepcion (WR50) is your projected weakest starter, you are never that far from the edge, and this roster drafted as if the edge did not exist.

mikeush7 didn't just assemble players, they assembled a theory. The entire ceiling here runs through Caleb Williams, and the roster is built to maximize the upside when he goes off: Luther Burden at WR22 and Colston Loveland at TE3 both project as starters, and both are stacked with Williams, meaning a big Chicago day doesn't just help, it cascades. Loveland as a projected TE3 is the anchor that makes the whole architecture credible, and Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 round out a position group that is genuinely elite from top to bottom. The concern isn't talent, it's concentration. A 2025 that landed in the ninth percentile is the cautionary tale in the room, and correlation cuts both ways: when the Bears stack clicks, this roster can chase a tournament; when Williams has a quiet week, the plan gets quiet with him. Sitting 56th percentile entering the season, mikeush7 is a live dart, aimed squarely at one outcome.

IWishIWasBeer didn't win the draft on any single pick, but they won it on volume, and that distinction matters. The clearest evidence is in the receiver group, where Christian Watson (WR28), Courtland Sutton (WR37), and Jordan Addison (WR43) each came off the board at least a round later than consensus said they should, turning the back half of the draft into a quiet accumulation of projected starters rather than a scramble for whatever was left. Add Justin Jefferson (WR6) as the anchor and Sam LaPorta (TE8) providing above-average production at a position where most managers are simply hoping for competent, and the roster has genuine top-end quality backed by genuine depth. The one blemish is Elic Ayomanor (WR95), a reach of nearly eight rounds that stands out precisely because nothing else on the sheet looks like it, but at pick 13.10 the downside is limited. Sitting fourth in the Stadium division at the 66th percentile, this team hasn't done anything flashy. It's just quietly built something worth watching.

ECMFer didn't stumble into a 74th-percentile roster. This is the product of a manager who understood the board, stayed patient, and collected value at almost every turn. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Justin Herbert at QB8 both fell past their ADPs and land as projected starters, giving this team elite ceiling at the position. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, and Makai Lemon, the weakest projected starter at WR40, was scooped up nearly two full rounds after his ADP, which means even the lineup's soft spot was acquired at a discount. The draft sheet reads like a clinic: two steals, six values, and a roster that earns third in the division without a single catastrophic misstep. The one blemish is Emmett Johnson, taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, but one reach buried in an otherwise disciplined 19-round draft is the kind of imperfection that only makes the rest of the work look more deliberate. This is what it looks like when a manager trusts the process from start to finish.

GreatScarbini didn't reinvent anything in the Scott Fish Bowl draft. They just kept winning small, and the ledger adds up to something worth respecting. The centerpiece is Puka Nacua at WR1, a projection that needs no qualifying language, paired with Nico Collins at WR9 and Zay Flowers at WR16 to form a starting group that sits comfortably in the upper tier of the field. That's not luck; that's a manager who recognized value and acted on it repeatedly, finishing the draft 19 picks deep without a single steal and without needing one. The Jared Goff and Jameson Williams stack adds a correlation layer that pays dividends when it fires, and De'Von Achane at RB6 gives the roster a true difference-maker away from the receiver group. The one blemish worth noting is Kirk Cousins, taken roughly three and a half rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the lone moment GreatScarbini's otherwise steady hand flinched. It's a minor scar on an otherwise clean draft, and at 89th percentile in the tournament, the roster speaks louder than that one slip.

The Yuma Yummies sit first in the Stadium Division and in the 94th tournament percentile, and the draft tells you exactly why. There was no single franchise-altering heist, just a consistent pattern of getting more than they paid for. Patrick Mahomes landing at 7.11 when his ADP sat at 5.08 is the headline, a QB12 projection sliding more than two rounds past his market value. Trey McBride came off the board at 2.02 with an ADP of 1.08, meaning the Yummies nabbed a TE2 at a modest discount while the field paid full price. Saquon Barkley at RB8 fell nearly a round into their lap, and he lines up alongside Christian McCaffrey and Derrick Henry in a group where the depth behind the studs is real. Mahomes pairing with Travis Kelce, who is officially back and chasing a return to the top-12 conversation, gives this roster a reliable floor that compounds the upside elsewhere. Twelve chalk picks and four values with zero major reaches is not a flashy draft story, it is a disciplined one, and discipline built this.
