grabs like Joe Burrow and Chris Godwin. With these missteps echoing through their lineup, kalebrabe enters the season with little more than the faintest hopes of climbing from the depths of mediocrity.

It remains to be seen whether the team's strengths can offset its vulnerabilities, but the season promises to test their mettle and strategic acumen.
