EvanLieginger sits at the bottom of the Tony Hawk division and in the fifth percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly how it happened. Four major reaches, zero steals, and a philosophical commitment to tight ends that would impress a coach running a 1990s West Coast offense. Harold Fannin, Kyle Pitts, Isaiah Likely, Colston Loveland, Trey McBride, ranking TE2 through TE13 among the starters, are a genuinely elite collection, but taking Likely nearly three full rounds before his ADP and Pitts a round and a half early meant EvanLieginger was sacrificing value elsewhere to collect depth at a position where only the top performers separate themselves. The damage shows up at receiver, where Jayden Reed projects as the weakest projected starter at WR48, and at quarterback, where Mac Jones at QB39 is less a gameday asset than a placeholder with a

headset. Last season's 36 percent win rate was a warning. This roster, built on overcorrection and wishful drafting, reads like someone ignored it.

There is no sugarcoating what the projections say about Zero, Zip, Zilch, Nada RB: this roster grades out at 11th in the Tony Hawk division and sits in just the 11th percentile of the entire field, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might close that gap. Three major reaches dot the board, including Stefon Diggs at WR56 burned two rounds early and De'Zhaun Stribling at WR73 cost three and a half rounds more than the market demanded, which means the manager was already paying tomorrow's prices for today's question marks. The one obvious pillar, Drake Maye stacked with A.J. Brown at WR8, gives the team a genuine foundation, but after Brown the projected starters thin out quickly, and Mike Evans, the name that was supposed to add a reliable floor, arrives in San Francisco carrying the weight of a body that played only eight games last season and an uncertain fit in a new offense. The lever that might turn this around is not visible in the data, and that, more than any single ranking, is the quiet dread hanging over this season.

blamejesus sits 10th in the Tony Hawk Division and in the 14th percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not offer much reason for optimism. The headline asset is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a genuinely elite projection, but after Gibbs the depth falls off fast, with Jaylen Warren projecting as the weakest projected starter at RB27. The draft offers little comfort either: fourteen chalk picks, zero steals, and a major reach on Trevor Lawrence at QB10, taken 1.8 rounds early when the positional scarcity simply does not justify that cost. The receiver group has some texture, with George Pickens at WR10 and Zay Flowers at WR16 giving the lineup real upside at the top, but this format rewards sustained quality across the whole roster and blamejesus is leaning hard on a few names to carry dead weight everywhere else. Coming off a 36% win rate in 2025, the path to relevance in 2026 requires Gibbs to be transcendent and Lawrence to prove the reach wrong, which is not a plan so much as a prayer.

The 32nd percentile is a brutal place to be planted, and the uncomfortable truth for laweegee is that the path back up is mostly blocked. The RB group is genuinely strong, with Christian McCaffrey, Kenneth Walker III, Kyren Williams, Josh Jacobs, and Bucky Irving all projected starters, but strength at one position cannot paper over everything else when the format lets you start anyone. The WR group grades out weak, and Jakobi Meyers sitting as the projected weakest starter at WR45 is the kind of number that keeps managers up at night. The draft did not help matters. Spending a second-round pick on Caleb Williams at QB6 is defensible in a vacuum, but burning a third-round selection on Patrick Mahomes at QB12 when the market had him priced as a fifth-rounder means laweegee paid premium rent on a position that does not carry teams. That is two early picks concentrated in a tier where the return is modest, and with the receiver group already thin on upside, there is no obvious lever left to pull. This one figures to be a long season.

Savvantman enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Tony Hawk division and barely cracking the 40th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The foundation looks serviceable on paper: Joe Burrow at QB4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 are legitimate anchors, and Saquon Barkley sliding to RB8 was a genuine draft-day win, plucked a full round after his ADP. But the value stops there. Fourteen chalk selections and three reaches tell the story of a draft that rarely zigged when the board zagged, and the Jalen Tolbert selection, grabbed nearly six and a half rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting all the way down to WR102, is the kind of move that haunts a roster for months. Beyond the top names, the depth grades out as average at best, Chuba Hubbard projects as the weakest projected starter, and a Matthew Stafford and Davante Adams stack feels more like a life raft than a weapon. This roster is treading water, and the tide is coming in.

theFunoneDunn did almost everything right on draft day and has almost nothing to show for it, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether effort matters at all. Malik Nabers fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP and landed at 6.09, a genuine heist for a WR12 projected starter. The value kept coming in the middle and late rounds, with Jordan Mason, Tyler Allgeier, and Jauan Jennings all sliding past their ADPs by nearly two rounds apiece. So far, so good. The problem is that Jalen Hurts, projected as a QB9, was drafted 1.2 rounds early at 2.09, and Sam LaPorta, a TE8, was grabbed 1.3 rounds ahead of schedule at 4.09. Two major reaches in the first four rounds quietly consumed the surplus that the rest of the board generated. The roster that assembled itself from those decisions sits 7th in the Tony Hawk division and in the 41st percentile of the field, which is the draft equivalent of balancing your checkbook perfectly and still being broke.

American Made Outlaws finished 76th percentile in scoring last year and land at just 46th percentile in projections for 2026, which tells you everything about where the uncertainty lives. This is a roster built on margins, not dominance. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are genuine anchors, but the supporting cast is a series of question marks dressed up as depth. Luther Burden is the swing vote. The Bears spent 2025 easing him in, and he only started looking like the player people believed in during the final stretch of the season. Now head coach Ben Johnson is comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown and Burden enters 2026 as one of the most hyped potential breakout candidates in fantasy, projected WR22. If that hype is earned, American Made Outlaws has a ceiling worth talking about. If Burden stays a projection rather than a result, this team spends the season hovering around .500, winning the games it should and losing the close ones it cannot afford to drop.

Swiftie Knicks did not build this roster by hunting for a single transformative pick. They just kept coming out ahead. The receiving corps reads like a quiet argument that gets louder the longer you listen: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Chris Olave at WR11, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 form a top line that would anchor any contender in the Tony Hawk division, and Rome Odunze landed at WR30 after falling a full round past his ADP, a value that padded an already comfortable group. Brock Bowers at TE1 was the first pick of the draft and he was still a value, arriving five picks later than his ADP suggested he would. The one genuine question sits at quarterback, where Kyler Murray is the projected starter at QB19 despite a lisfranc injury that cut his previous season to five games and eventually cost him his job in Arizona. His situation in Minnesota looks promising but it is not yet resolved, and that uncertainty is the one thread worth pulling. Still, a roster that landed three values, no major reaches, and a TE1 with its first overall pick is not a roster that snuck in. It built its way here.

wadepfuller did not walk into the Scott Fish Bowl draft swinging for the fences on a single transformative pick. The approach was quieter and more effective than that: round after round, the board simply cooperated. Drake London fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at WR7. James Cook slipped half a round and arrived as RB5. Alvin Kamara dropped more than two and a half rounds to give this roster a WR-heavy build with real RB depth underneath it. The crown jewel is Puka Nacua at WR1, a projected starter who gives the whole lineup a ceiling most managers in the Tony Hawk division are not working with. The one subplot worth watching is Jordan Love, whose stack with Christian Watson is either a quiet masterstroke or a familiar frustration, given that Love has never been a top-ten fantasy scorer despite being a genuinely valuable NFL quarterback. If Green Bay leans on Love's arm the way the offseason chatter suggests, Watson becomes much more interesting. This roster sits at the 83rd percentile tournament-wide, and the draft process, not any single gamble, is exactly why.

sleandres didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, over and over again. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are the kind of anchors that make a lineup competitive every single week before the rest of the names even matter, and then the rest of the names do matter: Nico Collins at WR9, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, Dallas Goedert at TE15 and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 all project as starters on a team that finished in the 84th percentile of the field and third in the Tony Hawk division. The draft itself reflects the same disciplined hand, 14 chalk picks and just a handful of reaches, with Jaxson Dart falling nearly two rounds past his ADP as a quiet dividend. The one note of genuine concern is Gadsden, whose upside took a hit when the Chargers brought in David Njoku late in the offseason, introducing real competition for targets. But one complicated situation does not define a roster this consistently constructed.

Army Of 10 didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't make one blockbuster move and coast. They just kept winning the pick. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 slid to 1.06 when he should have been gone by 1.02. Ashton Jeanty landed at RB7 despite falling nearly a full round past his ADP. Chase Brown followed the same script a round later. By the time Bhayshul Tuten came off the board at 9.06, it was clear this wasn't luck, it was a manager who stayed patient and let the draft come to them. That discipline carries into the starting lineup, where Jayden Daniels pairs with Terry McLaurin in a stack that gives Army Of 10 a built-in multiplier on Washington's passing game. Even the weakest projected starter, Malik Willis, carries real upside as a dual-threat who parlayed two solid injury-fill-in stints in Green Bay into a starting gig in Miami. Five values, no drama, and a roster sitting at 86th percentile in the field. That's not a gamble. That's a plan.

There is no single moment that defines gwalor21's 2026 roster, no lottery ticket swung late that either makes or breaks the whole enterprise. What there is, instead, is a draft that kept winning small battles round after round until the cumulative margin became impossible to ignore. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 were all taken past their ADPs, meaning gwalor21 paid discount prices for three of the better backs in the field. The Bo Nix and Jaylen Waddle stack gives the lineup a correlated ceiling that can genuinely blow up a week. Even the quieter finds hold up: Zach Charbonnet fell more than four full rounds past his ADP before gwalor21 scooped him at RB42, a pick that costs almost nothing and carries real upside. The result is a team sitting first in the Tony Hawk division and at the 96th percentile of the entire field, built not on any single audacious bet but on the compounding interest of a draft that simply kept coming out ahead.
