As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, Steve Gallo (USA Today SMG) finds themselves entrenched in a challenging position. With aspirations to build on their underwhelming 2024 campaign, where they scored in the low percentiles and managed a win rate of only 32%, the outlook remains grim. The team's running back core is particularly dire, headlined by David Montgomery and further weakened by the inclusion of Rachaad White as a starter, highlighting an area with little depth or promise. Despite a relatively strong wide receiver lineup featuring Ja'Marr Chase, Mike Evans, and Jerry Jeudy, it feels like a case of misplaced hope, given their reliance on a fragile quarterback situation. The team's draft strategy left much to be desired, characterized by inexplicable reaches for players such as Kyler Murray and Dak Prescott, whose early selections have

done nothing but strain the roster's potential. While there was some commendable value found with Nick Chubb and Matthew Golden, these small victories are overshadowed by the overall lack of foresight. In a highly competitive environment, Steve Gallo seems destined to languish at the bottom, echoing their unfortunate past performances that see them starting the season ranked dead last in both division and tournament standings.




