With a floundering quarterback situation anchored by Justin Herbert and Jordan Love, their chances of rising from the bottom of their division standings seem bleak. The team's decision to reach for players like A.J. Brown and Tee Higgins earlier than their average draft positions reveals a desperate attempt to inject life into an already shaky lineup. Unfortunately, it hasn't paid off. Brandon Aiyuk, projected as a starter despite his WR50 ranking, highlights the frailty of their receiving corps, while the decision to overcommit on Harold Fannin further diminishes their prospects. Occupying dead last in their division and languishing in the dismal 4th percentile overall, Durant and Destroy seems poised to endure a long and challenging season with little hope for significant improvement.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, Live, Laugh, Olave faces an uphill battle in both their division and overall tournament standings. With a disheartening rank of 11th in their division and languishing in the basement at the 4th percentile overall, this team is already weary before the season even begins. Their quarterback situation leaves much to be desired, with Brock Purdy's QB14 ranking offering a glimmer of hope over Tua Tagovailoa's troubling QB24 status—especially considering he was drafted significantly earlier than his ADP suggested. Despite boasting a stellar receiving corps led by Justin Jefferson WR2 and Nico Collins WR7, Live, Laugh, Olave struggles with a lack of depth and strength at other positions. The tight end slot remains a glaring weakness, and their running backs, consisting of Breece Hall RB13 and James Conner RB20 among others, offer only middling contributions as evidenced by their division rank. Reaching on several players,

particularly on Tua and some late-round swings like Will Shipley, has led to lost value, leaving the team exposed as they prepare for what could be a challenging season ahead.
