The roster, already fragile from its ill-advised reaches during the draft, finds itself anchored by Tyler Allgeier, a running back ranked 51st at his position—hardly the foundation of a competitive lineup. Despite a respectable receiving corps led by Ladd McConkey, the rest of the team is weighed down by albatrosses like the early selections of Patrick Mahomes and Drake Maye, far ahead of their expected draft positions, squandering precious

capital. While the small synergy between Mahomes and Xavier Worthy offers a glimmer of potential, it's unlikely to elevate NeedUpside from their disheartening 11th-place division rank or the bleak 12th percentile in the tournament standings. As they brace for what's likely to be a long and arduous season, the team can only hope for a miracle that might pull them from the depths of despair.

Cooper Kupp—snagged later than expected—the team hopes for standout performances to offset their positional vulnerabilities. As they sit low in the tournament percentile and division standings, ShiaLABEOUF must lean on strategic plays and breakout games to climb from their current position and make this season one for the books.

Ultimately, Lpporto's journey this season hinges on balancing their stellar wide receiver assets with vulnerabilities in other positions. Their strategic decisions and player performances will determine whether they can climb the ranks and make a notable impact throughout the competition.


