HugHJasoole sits 12th in the Madden NFL division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the draft profile does not offer much reason for optimism. The most telling detail is Christian Watson, taken two full rounds before his ADP and projecting out as WR28, which means the team spent premium capital on a player who is not delivering premium production. Pair that with Rhamondre Stevenson, the projected weakest starter at RB31, who was also taken two rounds early, and you have a pattern: HugHJasoole consistently paid up for players who did not reward the faith. The one credible anchor is Bijan Robinson at RB2, but a single elite player cannot carry a roster this thin on upside. Jordan Love looms as a potential breakout, and there is genuine chatter out of Green Bay about leaning on his arm, but Love has finished outside the top 10 in fantasy scoring two years running and his supporting cast remains unsettled. Hope is not a roster construction strategy, and right now hope is about all HugHJasoole has left to deploy.

There is not much to love about silkywaves heading into 2026. The team sits 11th in the Madden NFL division and projects in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer an obvious path out of that basement. The one genuine bright spot is at the top, where Lamar Jackson grades as QB3 and Joe Burrow slots in as QB4, giving silkywaves a genuinely enviable pair of signal-callers. The problem is that quality does not carry far enough down the depth chart. Eight of twelve draft picks were pure chalk, the team produced zero steals, and the most glaring symbol of where things went wrong is Wan'Dale Robinson, the projected weakest starter. Robinson crossed 1,000 yards for the first time in his career in 2025, which would normally read as a reason for optimism, except he now lands in Tennessee battling for targets behind a newly drafted receiver in Carnell Tate. A team propped up by Jackson and Burrow but leaning on a WR47 as a starter is not a contender, it is a prayer.

BirdDog33 enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Madden NFL division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the draft chart offers little comfort for anyone hoping a turnaround is lurking. The roster managed zero steals and leaned heavily on chalk, while two major reaches, Jonathon Brooks at RB37 and Alec Pierce at WR32, ate up early capital on players who project as borderline starters at best. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a genuine anchor, and James Cook at RB5 was the one draft moment where value actually arrived, sliding a few picks past his ADP. But beyond that pair, the roster thins out fast. The team's best hope for a multiplier effect is the Justin Herbert and Ladd McConkey stack, though Herbert's outlook carries its own asterisk: Mike McDaniel's arrival in Los Angeles makes the offense more interesting, but if the Chargers keep winning and playing keep-away, Herbert's ceiling stays capped, and McConkey's floor goes with it. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and then there is the version that actually has to compete in the Scott Fish Bowl, which is considerably less fine. Commishner sits ninth in the Madden NFL division and in just the 28th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much cause for optimism: five chalk picks, three minor reaches, and two major reaches against only one steal. The major reaches tell the story. Derrick Henry, projected RB12, went a full round before his ADP, and Michael Wilson, a projected WR39, was taken more than two rounds early. Those are the kinds of bets that need to go right to matter, and neither projection suggests they will. Patrick Mahomes fell nearly three and a half rounds past his ADP, which is genuinely good fortune, but a QB12 on a team already struggling to crack the top third of the field is more life raft than engine. The floor here is visible from the ceiling, and Commishner is going to need some things to break very right, very fast.

RDD138 finished last season at 31st percentile in scoring and a 47 percent win rate, and the 2026 outlook offers little reason to believe the trajectory has changed. The roster sits eighth in the Madden NFL division and projects to the 33rd percentile of the field, the kind of standing where you are not rebuilding so much as just existing. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine anchor, and A.J. Brown at WR8 gives the lineup a second player worth building around, but the draft did those two no favors: Brown was a reach taken nearly a full round early, and the rest of the board leaned heavily on chalk with two major reaches and zero steals. Matthew Golden projects as WR52 after the manager spent a ninth-round pick on him as if he were an eleventh-rounder's problem. The weakest projected starter is Chuba Hubbard at RB29, which tells you everything about the floor here. McCaffrey and Brown are real, but one star and one good receiver is not a roster, it is a prayer.

Clure173 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting seventh in the Madden NFL division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, and the draft record doesn't offer much hope for a turnaround. Five major reaches across the roster is a brutal number, and the biggest offenders are the ones that sting the most. Kirk Cousins, a QB35, cost a 12th-round pick that was burned six rounds early on a player who projects as a fringe starter at best. Kenneth Walker III is a legitimate asset at RB10, but taking him a full round ahead of his ADP meant Clure173 was already paying a premium before the damage elsewhere piled up. At the bottom of the lineup sits Jalen Coker as a projected WR55, and even KC Concepcion, the more intriguing of the two late-round wideouts, is saddled with a Cleveland offense still waiting on a quarterback to make any of it matter. This roster doesn't have an obvious trade chip to flip or a sleeper waiting to pop. What you see is what you get, and what you get is a long season.

JMoeller05 enters 2026 as a team that will be decided by inches, not miles. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), George Pickens (WR10), and Malik Nabers (WR12) forming a top-shelf core that can carry a week on its own. But Nabers came at a price, taken 1.2 rounds ahead of his ADP in Round 2, which means JMoeller05 paid premium early and got chalk everywhere else, finishing the draft with zero steals and ten picks right at market value. That is not a damning indictment, but it does mean there is no hidden upside waiting to emerge, no sleeper quietly underpriced in the late rounds. What you see is what you get. A 58 percent win rate and a 68th percentile scoring finish in 2025 suggest this manager knows how to squeeze points, and a team ranked 42nd percentile entering 2026 is close enough to the bubble that small variance, one streaky week from Brock Purdy (QB13), one timely breakout from Jeremiyah Love (RB13), tips the whole thing.

keldevlin didn't win the draft with one flashy move, they won it by repeatedly coming out on the right side of value. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 landed nearly a full round after his ADP suggested he should have gone, and Jalen Hurts at QB9 slipped almost two rounds past where managers were taking him elsewhere. Those two prices alone give this roster a cushion before a single game is played. Layer in the Hurts-Lamb stack and the secondary Hurts-DeVonta Smith connection, and the offense has multiple paths to variance-beating upside. The tight end group projects as the thinnest part of the lineup, with Dallas Goedert sitting as the projected weakest starter at TE15, though Isaiah Likely's move to New York with John Harbaugh and a light target environment gives that spot genuine upside. None of this screams singular genius, it just quietly adds up. keldevlin enters 2026 sitting fifth in the Madden NFL division at the 51st percentile, but a roster that bought this well tends to look better once the season sorts itself out.

jakeallhands didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by not losing it. Eleven chalk selections and zero reaches is a draft that respected the board, and the payoff shows up in the projected starters: Brock Bowers at TE1, Drake London at WR7, and Dak Prescott at QB7 form a core that would make most managers in this field quietly jealous. The one deviation from the board worked out fine, as Chris Godwin slipped a full round past his ADP and landed at WR38 value on a pick that cost far less. That kind of quiet opportunism, picking well without gambling, is exactly what the overall draft profile reflects. The floor here is legitimate, and the ceiling is real. Sitting at 52nd percentile in the tournament and fourth in the division, this roster isn't quite a favorite, but it is absolutely in the conversation, which is all you can ask of a draft that never once overreached to get there.

dynastyjunkieff didn't win the Scott Fish Bowl draft with one thunderclap pick. They won it the way good teams usually do, by being right more often than wrong. Saquon Barkley landing at RB8 a full round after his ADP and Bucky Irving sliding to RB21 a round late are the kind of quiet wins that separate disciplined drafters from the field, and when you stack those two together at the top of a starting lineup, you have a genuine foundation. Drake Maye projects as a QB2, and Trey McBride comes in at TE2 alongside Harold Fannin at TE6, meaning dynastyjunkieff is drawing from the top shelf at two positions where positional scarcity bites most managers hard. The minor reaches on Fernando Mendoza and Jadarian Price are real, but neither blows up what is otherwise a draft with no major reaches and a track record that backs the approach: a 67 percent win rate and an 82nd percentile scoring season in 2025. Third in the division at 74th percentile tournament-wide is a perfectly respectable landing spot for a team that earned it the boring, effective way.

Dmaraim didn't build this roster by swinging for the fences on one marquee gamble. They built it by winning the small negotiations, round after round, until the totals added up to something serious. Caleb Williams landing at QB6 when he fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP is the kind of quiet heist that separates competent drafters from good ones, and picking up C.J. Stroud at QB22 for a similar discount means Dmaraim walked away from the quarterback market having paid well under market rate for real production. Meanwhile, Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 and De'Von Achane projecting as RB6 give this team a ceiling that justifies the grandiose expectations, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 keeps the pressure on every opponent in the Madden NFL division. One reach here, another there, but no major reaches on the board and the draft-versus-ADP ledger tilting clearly in Dmaraim's favor. Second in the division and in the 88th percentile of the field, this team earned its standing the methodical way.

Hawks4Life1 sits atop the Madden NFL division at the 89th tournament percentile, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: this manager just kept winning small. The headliner is Josh Allen, a QB1 taken at chalk, paired with Jayden Daniels, a QB5 who slipped all the way to pick 5.06 despite an ADP of 2.12, a two-and-a-half round gift that Hawks4Life1 quietly pocketed. Jonathan Taylor arriving a half-round past his ADP at RB4 is the kind of secondary win that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. The result is a starting lineup built on a foundation that was never overpaid for, with Tyler Warren anchoring a strong positional group at TE4 and the running back corps featuring Taylor alongside Josh Jacobs and Travis Etienne. The one aggressive move was reaching 1.4 rounds early for Jacobs, but at RB16 that is a calculated bet, not a panic. Eight chalk picks in a draft this clean reads less like caution and more like a manager who simply knew what things were worth.
