As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, 12inTennessee faces an uphill battle likely destined to yield more disappointment than triumph. After a disheartening performance last year, finishing in the 39th percentile and claiming victories in only 44% of their games, the squad once again finds itself languishing at the bottom of their division. Despite boasting one of the top tight ends in Trey McBride (TE2) and a solid, but not stellar, group of wide receivers led by Travis Hunter (WR12), the team is severely hampered by glaring weaknesses, particularly at running back with Bhayshul Tuten (RB45) as a projected starter. This glaring hole, coupled with questionable drafting decisions such as reaching for Matthew Stafford far ahead of his ADP, signals a challenging path ahead. The decision

to slightly overvalue Hunter Henry also suggests a lack of depth that could spell disaster as the season progresses. As their divisional rivals strengthen and show promise, 12inTennessee appears overwhelmed and outmatched, facing what could be a long and grueling season mired in the lower echelons of competition.
