NeilG51628 drafted like someone who showed up with a plan and executed it badly. The most damning evidence sits at quarterback: Jaxson Dart, taken at 3.01 and projected QB11, was a 2.4-round reach, followed by C.J. Stroud, a QB22 taken 2.7 rounds early at 6.12. That is two of the first seven picks spent chasing quarterbacks in a positionless format where the position carries no positional premium, and neither dart landed on a QB1. The rest of the board follows the same logic: ten chalk picks, six minor reaches, three major reaches, zero steals, and one measly value in Jadarian Price falling a round. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is genuinely excellent and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 is useful, but the draft capital surrounding them was squandered well before the roster could be properly built out. The result is a team sitting last in the Sensible Soccer division and in the bottom five percent of the field, scoring 39th percentile last season and showing no evidence in this draft that 2026 will feel any different.

amstaggs35 enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Sensible Soccer division and in just the 24th tournament percentile, which means the margin for error is basically nonexistent. The foundation is not without promise: Josh Allen is a true QB1 anchor, and Malik Nabers, Garrett Wilson, and Tee Higgins give this roster genuine upside in the skill positions. But the draft process burned meaningful capital in the wrong places. Fernando Mendoza was taken 5.3 rounds before his QB27 projection warranted, and Justin Fields followed with an equally puzzling reach of 5.2 rounds early for a QB38. That is two mid-draft picks swallowed by quarterbacks who will almost certainly never see a starting lineup in a positionless format. Meanwhile, RJ Harvey, who projects as a starter, is walking into a Denver backfield clouded by JK Dobbins and a newly drafted Jonah Coleman, making his RB28 projection feel optimistic

at best. With three major reaches already baked in and no obvious corrective lever available, this roster looks more like a team hoping for chaos than one built to manufacture wins.

eterpuss sits 10th in Sensible Soccer and in the 27th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The receiver group is legitimately impressive, headlined by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and Drake London (WR7), with Tetairoa McMillan (WR15), Jameson Williams (WR21), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) rounding out a projected starting corps that most managers would envy. The problem is that everything feeding that group is thin. Bo Nix grades out as a QB15, Sam Darnold as a QB21, and the best projected non-receiver starter is AJ Barner at TE24. The Nix-Waddle stack offers at least a theoretical upside spike, since Waddle steps into a Denver offense that led the league in pass attempts last year, but a stack built on a QB15 is less a lever than a loose handle on a door that might not open. The draft added 13 chalk picks, no steals, and one major reach in Tyreek Hill (WR77). There is no obvious correction coming from the waiver wire that the draft did not already offer.

vinaygudapati sits ninth in the Sensible Soccer division and down in the 34th percentile of the field, and the uncomfortable truth is that the roster does not hide many excuses. The headline assets are real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Saquon Barkley at RB8, and Josh Jacobs at RB16 give this team a legitimate elite core, and George Pickens at WR10 is a genuine difference-maker. But Pickens was a reach of nearly a full round at pick 2.05, and the draft as a whole produced zero steals and two major reaches, including David Njoku at TE29 taken 2.5 rounds before the market agreed. That draft capital spent early on back-end value is hard to recover from. Justin Herbert, the most interesting name to build around at QB8, carries his own ceiling concerns: Mike McDaniel's arrival in Los Angeles is encouraging, but if the Chargers keep winning and playing ball control the way they have under Jim Harbaugh, Herbert's arm stays somewhat corked. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, and the standings will likely confirm it.

ghost_clown did almost everything right in the draft. Eighteen chalk picks, one minor reach in Rhamondre Stevenson, and a late gift in Tyrone Tracy falling past his ADP. The discipline was real. The result, somehow, is a team sitting eighth in the Sensible Soccer division and in the 42nd percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes a manager question whether they were ever in control to begin with. The core is genuinely good: Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Chase Brown at RB11, Derrick Henry at RB12, Breece Hall at RB14, and Drake Maye developing into a QB2 with AJ Brown now in New England. On paper, that should be enough. But the projected starters thin out fast, and when Tony Pollard at RB30 is your weakest projected starter, you are one injury away from a lineup that no longer resembles the one you drafted. ghost_clown followed the rules, hit the values, and still landed in the wrong half of the field. The cruelest drafts are the ones where you cannot point to the mistake.

Dingaling75 sits at the 53rd percentile and ranks seventh in Sensible Soccer, which is about as noncommittal a position as a team can occupy. The engine here is real: Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and A.J. Brown (WR8) give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the field would envy, and Tyler Warren (TE4) adds another projected starter who can genuinely move the needle. But the margins are where this gets complicated. The quarterback situation, headlined by Baker Mayfield (QB18) and Kyler Murray (QB19), is functional rather than frightening, and Brown's durability has been a quiet concern throughout his career, with missed time in five of his seven seasons. If Brown stays healthy and the Mayfield-Emeka Egbuka (WR18) stack hits on a few big weeks, this roster has the top-end talent to outperform its division standing. If it doesn't, Dingaling75 is exactly what the numbers suggest: a team that finishes fine, bothers nobody, and wonders what might have been.

thefantasyfirstdown sits at 53rd percentile and sixth in the Sensible Soccer division, which is exactly the kind of position that demands things go right rather than just not wrong. The engine here is a loaded group of tight ends, with Trey McBride (TE2), Tucker Kraft (TE5), Dalton Kincaid (TE11), and Dallas Goedert (TE15) all projecting as starters, giving this roster a legitimate upper-crust foundation at that spot. The problem is what surrounds it. The quarterback situation leans heavily on Jordan Love (QB17) and Tyler Shough (QB20), both taken slightly ahead of their ADPs, and neither projects as someone who lifts a lineup on his own. The Love/Kraft and Shough/Chris Olave stacks offer some upside if those connections click, and Olave (WR11) and Rashee Rice (WR13) give real receiver firepower at the top. But the margin for error is thin. A modest quarterback week, a quiet game from McBride, and this team slides toward the bottom of the standings before it ever threatens the top.

FoFdowie didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right, over and over again. The headliner is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, a projected starter who gives this roster a genuine top-end anchor. But the real story is the running back group: Omarion Hampton (RB9), Jeremiyah Love (RB13), Javonte Williams (RB17), and Bucky Irving (RB21) are all projected starters, and Williams came at a discount, falling more than a full round past his ADP. That kind of patience compounds. Patrick Mahomes arrives with some uncertainty after a torn ACL and LCL late in 2025, but his recovery is reportedly ahead of schedule, and if he plays a full season, he walks back into the QB12 projection with very little rust on his resume. After a 29th-percentile finish in 2025, FoFdowie needed a reset, and this looks like one. Not a gamble, not a wholesale reinvention, just a draft that consistently came out ahead, round after round, sitting 65th percentile in a field that rewards exactly that kind of discipline.

ashperry83 walked out of this draft looking like someone who ignored every traffic signal and somehow arrived first anyway. The centerpiece is a foundation that most managers would envy without apology: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Brock Bowers at TE1, both projected starters, both acquired at or near fair value. That is the kind of infrastructure that wins leagues before Week 1. But the board shows four reaches and two major ones, and that is where conviction becomes the argument. Jonah Coleman, snagged 3.7 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Evan Engram, pulled 2.7 rounds early, are the reaches that will define this roster's ceiling or its cautionary tale. Neither was a panic pick, both were deliberate, and if they hit, ashperry83 looks like a genius. If they miss, the team still has Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 keeping the lights on. Sitting at 69th percentile and fourth in the Sensible Soccer division, this team is good enough to climb and just reach-heavy enough to make you wonder whether the architect knew something or just got lucky.

Poshcartlich23 didn't just assemble talent, they assembled connected talent, and the difference matters enormously in a positionless format where ceiling is everything. The architecture here is two interlocking stacks: Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb on one side, Brock Purdy and George Kittle on the other. Lamb projects as WR5 and Prescott as QB7, meaning this isn't a dart throw on an upside pairing, it's a bet on two genuinely elite players who happen to share a field. Kittle at TE6 and Purdy at QB13 add a second live wire to the same outlet. When both stacks fire, the scoring ceiling for this roster becomes something the rest of the Sensible Soccer division will not be able to match, which is exactly how a team sitting third in the division with a 78th percentile tournament projection climbs into something more dangerous. Last season's 99th percentile scoring output confirms this manager knows how to build for volume. The correlation isn't a gimmick. It's the whole blueprint.

AndyFC didn't win the draft with a single thunderclap moment. They won it the way a good poker player wins, not by bluffing big, but by consistently extracting value from a patient, disciplined hand. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the roster, and the supporting cast was assembled shrewdly: Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, Jordan Addison at WR43, and Xavier Worthy at WR49 all slipped past their ADPs by more than a round apiece, three separate instances where the market was wrong and AndyFC was right. Carnell Tate at WR29 adds genuine upside as the centerpiece of a Tennessee passing offense built around a former first-overall quarterback. The one blemish is Matthew Stafford, reached for 1.3 rounds early at a position that rarely decides these tournaments, though the Stafford and Davante Adams stack at least gives the move some structural logic. With three confirmed values, a projected WR31 as their weakest starter, and a finish in the 79th percentile of the field, AndyFC looks like a team that earned its standing pick by pick.

MattFlo sits atop the Sensible Soccer division and lands in the 89th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly why: this roster was built round by round through discipline rather than any single moment of genius. The foundation is real. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Jayden Daniels as QB5, and Nico Collins as WR9, a trio of starters that gives MattFlo a ceiling most managers in this tournament would envy. Then consider that Jalen Hurts fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed in the lineup as QB9, essentially a free upgrade tucked behind Daniels. The one subplot worth watching is Alec Pierce, projected at WR32 and currently on the PUP list after offseason ankle surgery. If Pierce clears by late August, he suits up Week 1. If he doesn't, MattFlo absorbs the early absence with enough starter-quality depth to stay afloat. That kind of resilience doesn't happen by accident. It happens when almost every pick lands where it should.
