There is no soft way to say it: gianaaaa enters 2026 sitting at the 8th percentile of the field, coming off a 2-34 record that was as bleak as it sounds, and the draft did not supply much of a rescue. Twelve chalk picks, two major reaches, and zero steals is a draft profile that describes someone hoping the board falls their way and then watching it fall on them instead. The most telling reach is Jaxson Dart, pulled 1.6 rounds early to shore up a QB room that already had Drake Maye anchoring it as a projected QB2. That is a significant capital expenditure on a position that was already covered. Meanwhile the receiver group that has to carry so much of the scoring load grades out weak, with Jaylen Waddle as the headliner. Waddle does move from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense that led the league in pass attempts, so there is something to work with there. But Romeo Doubs, reached for 2.3 rounds early, is the projected weakest starter on the roster, and no amount of optimism about Waddle papers over that math.

Omega Co drafted like a manager who convinced themselves that if they just kept reaching, the board would eventually reward them for their confidence. It did not. Six minor reaches and two major ones define a draft where the panic button got hit early and often, and the results are sitting at 11th in the SimCity division and the 12th percentile of the field. The most damning evidence: Jared Goff, projected QB16, was grabbed nearly two rounds before his ADP, a price that would be uncomfortable for a QB8 and is simply indefensible for a QB16. Then, somehow, Keenan Allen materialized in round 17 at a cost of over five rounds of surplus draft capital, which is a remarkable commitment to a player projected QB99. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a pulse, and the Goff and Jameson Williams stack is a reasonable hedge, but when your 2025 season produced a 39 percent win rate and you spent this offseason reaching on six players, despondency is the only honest posture available.

There is a particular kind of fantasy exhaustion that comes not from catastrophic failure but from persistent, grinding mediocrity, and tristancook knows it well. Last season's 50 percent win rate and 56th-percentile scoring output was the kind of campaign that neither breaks your spirit nor gives you much to build on, and the 2026 roster, sitting tenth in the SimCity division and at just the 24th percentile of the field, does not suggest a dramatic reversal. The draft did tristancook no favors either: fourteen chalk picks and two major reaches, including Khalil Shakir at WR51 taken nearly four rounds early and Christian Kirk at WR100 taken more than seven rounds early, suggest a drafter who kept forcing moves when the board stopped cooperating. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Trey McBride at TE2 are genuine cornerstones, but when your projected weakest starter is Xavier Worthy at WR49, the margin for error is essentially zero, and this roster does not look built to survive a bad break.

sday is sitting ninth in the SimCity division and in the 24th tournament percentile, which is the kind of address that does not inspire confidence in anyone, including probably sday. The QB room is legitimately good, Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Brock Purdy at QB13 giving the roster a ceiling that the rest of the squad quietly undermines, and the Purdy-Mike Evans stack is a nice thought until you remember that Evans missed most of last season with injuries, snapped his legendary 1,000-yard streak, and is now learning a new offense in San Francisco. Below those two quarterbacks, the projected starters cluster between WR7 and RB17, solid enough but not the kind of top-end firepower that carries a team out of the bottom quarter of the field. Jayden Reed projects as the weakest starter at WR48, and the draft offered no real surprises, just 13 chalk picks, two major reaches, and no steals to brag about. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, just a long season and increasingly hopeful waiver wire refreshes.

The Unhappy Citizens are aptly named. Sitting 8th in the SimCity division and projecting at just the 35th percentile of the field, this roster has a ceiling problem that no amount of optimism can paper over. The receiving corps is genuinely elite, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), Chris Olave (WR11), and Malik Nabers (WR12) all projected starters, and Harold Fannin (TE6) flashing legitimate upside after outplaying his veteran predecessor in Cleveland last year. But that is precisely where the problem lives: Fannin's production runs through a Browns offense that may hand the keys to Deshaun Watson, and the quarterback situation on this roster isn't much prettier. Tyler Shough (QB20) was taken 1.2 rounds early, Malik Willis (QB24) was a 2.3-round reach, and neither projects as someone who can unlock those weapons consistently. The Shough-Olave stack is a reasonable swing, but betting on two fringe starters to carry a roster this deep in talent is less a strategy and more a prayer.

Commerce requires Airport drafted with discipline, and the ledger still does not balance. Five values, fourteen chalk picks, zero major reaches, and the team lands at 42nd percentile, seventh in the SimCity division. That is the cruelest arithmetic in fantasy football: doing the process correctly and watching the reward evaporate anyway. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this roster a legitimate top end, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Terry McLaurin at WR24 extend that depth past what most managers can match. But the format starts ten players, and the projected weakest starter is Jaylen Warren at RB27, which means the ceiling gets dragged toward the floor every single week by a back who barely qualifies as a reliable contributor. Jalen Hurts stacking with Dallas Goedert offers some upside correlation, but Goedert projects at TE15, not the kind of weapon that changes the equation. Commerce requires Airport built a beautiful second floor and forgot there was a ground level to worry about.

nickcoder is the team that wins the weeks it should win and loses the weeks it should lose, and the 2026 season lives entirely in the space between those two outcomes. The foundation is real: Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Bijan Robinson at RB2 are genuine difference-makers, and Rashee Rice at WR13 arriving four rounds later than his ADP suggests at least one moment where the draft broke the right way. But for every small win there is a corresponding tax. Caleb Williams was taken nearly a full round before the market agreed he was worth it, and Kenneth Gainwell, the projected weakest starter on the roster, is the direct consequence of that early spend pulling resources from depth that actually plays. Last season's 53rd-percentile scoring performance wrote the blueprint clearly enough: this is a team with a ceiling, not a floor. In the SimCity division, sitting sixth, nickcoder does not need to be better than everyone. It needs to be better than itself on the right Sundays.

Reticulating Splines didn't swing for the fences and whiff, they just quietly built something that holds up. The foundation starts with Joe Burrow at QB4 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, two projected starters who put this roster in elite company before the middle rounds even arrive. From there, the draft reads like a series of small, compounding advantages: Kenneth Walker III at RB10, Travis Etienne at RB18, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 give the team a run of projected starters that most managers would envy. The value column adds another layer, with Makai Lemon slipping a full round past his ADP and Denzel Boston falling nearly three rounds before Reticulating Splines scooped him up at pick 16.05. Fifteen chalk picks in one draft can sound like a manager playing it safe, but when you're consistently landing players at or near their market value and occasionally beating it, safe starts to look a lot like smart. Fifth in the SimCity division and sitting at the 48th percentile tournament-wide, there's real upside here if the projections break the right way.

BLong5 didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't land one transcendent pick and coast. They just kept winning exchanges. De'Von Achane at RB6 slid to pick 2.12 past his ADP, Kyren Williams fell a full round and a half to land at RB15, and TreVeyon Henderson drifted nearly two rounds before BLong5 scooped him at RB19. Three quiet wins that compound into something real. The Matthew Stafford and Puka Nacua stack gives the lineup a built-in multiplier, with Nacua projecting as the WR1 and Stafford checking in at QB14, both penciled in as starters. The two major reaches, Sam Darnold and Dontayvion Wicks, are the honest blemishes on an otherwise tidy card, but neither is a catastrophic swing. Coming off a 56 percent win rate in 2025 and landing at the 64th percentile of the field this year, BLong5 sits fourth in the SimCity division with the look of a team that earned every spot on the roster the unglamorous way, one sensible pick at a time.

Brock Llama Domers land at 79th percentile and third in the division not because of any single blockbuster move, but because the draft kept returning value round after round. The tight end group is where that discipline shows most clearly: Brock Bowers at TE1, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Travis Kelce at TE10 are all projected starters, and both Pitts and Kelce were taken after their ADPs slipped, meaning this team collected three elite options at the position without overpaying for any of them. The receiving corps follows the same pattern. George Pickens projects as WR10 and anchors a Dak Prescott stack that gives the roster a built-in correlation bonus, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 gives the team a second receiver projected inside the top 15. The one genuine indulgence was Aaron Rodgers, reached nearly three rounds early at QB29, but in a positionless format where Prescott and Baker Mayfield are both available, that is a minor footnote on an otherwise disciplined sheet.

Zoning Violations landed in the 94th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains most of why. Seven values against a single major reach is the kind of ledger that wins leagues before the season kicks off, and the best of those finds was Tyler Warren, a TE4 who fell all the way to pick 4.08 when his ADP sat at 3.04. Pair that with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, both projected starters, and you have a lineup that can absorb almost anything the season throws at it. A.J. Brown at WR8 adds another elite piece, and Bucky Irving came in at RB21 well past his ADP, so the depth behind the headliners was bought at a discount too. The QB group is the quietest part of the roster, with Jordan Love and Kyler Murray both sitting outside the top fifteen, but in a positionless format the rest of this talent base makes that easy to work around. Clean draft, clear ceiling, second in the SimCity division for a reason.

LaPorta Potty sits first in the SimCity division and in the 97th percentile of the entire field, and the reason is almost insultingly simple: this roster collected elite talent at the positions that matter most and did it at a discount. Josh Allen is a QB1 in a positionless format, meaning his ceiling is the starting lineup every single week. Behind him, Ashton Jeanty, Omarion Hampton, and Chase Brown project as RB7, RB9, and RB11 respectively, three projected starters acquired with value, Brown falling nearly a full round and a half past his ADP. Then there is the tight end group, where Tucker Kraft, Sam LaPorta, and Isaiah Likely project as TE5, TE8, and TE13, each one a projected starter, and Kraft alone fell almost two rounds past his draft position. In a format where you simply field your best players, concentrating this much top-end production in one place is not a strategy so much as an answer. The manager did not spread risk evenly across positions; they just went and got the good players.
