There is no charitable read available for Seahawk1969, a team sitting dead last in the Soap McTavish division and projecting out at just the 16th percentile of the field. The draft tells the story before the season even begins: zero steals, zero values worth writing home about, and four major reaches scattered across the board like evidence at a crime scene. Jayden Daniels cost a second-round pick at 2.01 when his ADP sat nearly a full round later at 2.12, a modest overpay that might be forgiven in isolation. It is not in isolation. Kaelon Black, projecting as RB71, was taken in the 18th round when the market said late 26th, an eight-round reach on a player who does not project to start. Keenan Allen, projecting as WR99, went six-plus rounds early at 16.01. Quinshon Judkins offers genuine intrigue after a promising year cut short by a fractured fibula, and he is at least a projected starter, but a roster built on chalk and phantom value needs more than one interesting question mark to climb out of the basement.

zanzibar00 is sitting 11th in the Soap McTavish division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, and the roster reads like a slow-motion explanation of why. The headliners are real: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Joe Burrow at QB4 give this team a genuine top tier, and Chase Brown at RB11 keeps the floor from caving in entirely. But the depth behind those names decays fast, and the draft process did little to shore things up. Of 19 picks tracked against ADP, zanzibar00 produced zero steals and just one value, while burning a major reach on Josh Jacobs at RB16, taken nearly two full rounds ahead of his ADP. Jacobs is a fine player, but paying early-fourth-round price for a RB16 projection tilts the math against you before Week 1 kicks off. The projected weakest starter is Jaylen Warren, and when your floor is a RB27 you're hoping everything above him holds, which is a hope, not a plan.

There is a specific kind of fantasy misery that comes not from catastrophe but from the slow realization that the math simply does not work in your favor, and MortyNiners49 appears to be living inside that math in 2026. The roster grades out at the 31st percentile and sits 10th in the Soap McTavish division, and there is no obvious place to find the points needed to climb. The QB situation looks like a strength on paper, with Josh Allen at QB1 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 anchoring the projected lineup, but Hurts carries real risk: the offseason departure of AJ Brown to New England puts his passing game under a microscope it has never faced before, and if the Philadelphia offense sputters, those rushing touchdowns that fueled five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes will not come as freely either. Strip away the optimism around Allen and the receiver group bottoms out at Khalil Shakir at WR51 as the projected weakest starter. The draft offered almost no help, producing zero steals against 14 chalk picks and one major reach on Jordan James. This roster is not broken. It is just short.

Jobby's 2026 campaign looks less like a rebuild and more like a slow leak, with almost nothing on the roster suggesting the situation is about to reverse. The draft tells the story plainly: zero steals, one value, and the single most notable draft-day decision was reaching more than a round early on Caleb Williams at QB6 in a positionless format where quarterback value is already compressed. Williams may justify it, but the math on that pick needed to go perfectly just to break even. Meanwhile, the projected starters at receiver grade out as WR32, WR37, and WR44, a ceiling that gets worse when you realize Michael Pittman landed in Pittsburgh to catch passes from a 43-year-old Aaron Rodgers on an offense that hasn't found its identity yet. Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine asset, and Omarion Hampton and Derrick Henry give the top of the roster some real weight, but a 38th-percentile team sitting ninth in its division doesn't have the margin to absorb a disappointing starter or two. Right now, Jobby doesn't have a lever left to pull.

Finfan1313 is a team that will win or lose the Scott Fish Bowl on the thinnest of margins, which is either exciting or exhausting depending on your relationship with antacids. The receiver group is legitimately good, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 forming a core that most managers in the Soap McTavish division cannot match, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Christian Watson at WR28 keeping the depth real. The problem is that the draft left some unnecessary fingerprints on the margins. Tyler Shough was taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, a significant investment in a 27-year-old with talent around him in New Orleans but real questions about whether a second-year ceiling exists at that age. Dalton Schultz was reached 2.3 rounds early and sits at only TE22. Those two picks represent resources that could have sharpened an already thin edge. Finfan1313 sits at 46th percentile, solidly in the field's belly, not threatening the top and not sinking toward the bottom. The receiver talent says this roster can push higher. The draft inefficiencies say it will have to earn every inch.

SportyG10 enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Soap McTavish division and right at the tournament median, which sounds survivable until you dig into why. The draft tells a quietly damning story: 11 chalk picks, four minor reaches, and one major reach, with Harold Fannin pulled 2.1 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 3.03. That kind of aggressive early investment in a TE6 only makes sense if the rest of the roster punches above its weight, and it mostly doesn't. The projected starters grade out as average, the weak end of the lineup bottoms out at Josh Downs as a WR46, and Shedeur Sanders sits at QB32 after being reached for in round 15. There are names worth believing in, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and a starting corps that includes Zay Flowers, Emeka Egbuka, and Jaylen Waddle, but the good values the draft produced were incremental, not transformative. Isaiah Likely follows John Harbaugh to New York with a chance to carve out real usage, but asking a TE13 to be the roster's upside play is a thin hope to hang a season on.

DCNS sits at 47th percentile and sixth in the division, which is exactly where a team looks when it has genuine stars but genuine questions eating at the foundation. Brock Bowers at TE1, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Nico Collins at WR9 give this roster a ceiling worth respecting, and the Purdy-Kittle stack adds a wrinkle that could pop off in the right week. But Purdy is the problem hiding in the blueprint. He missed eight weeks with a turf toe injury in 2025, and this offseason his receiving corps has been gutted by injury and uncertainty at nearly every turn, leaving Mike Evans as the primary answer to a question that keeps getting longer. Malik Willis sits as the projected fallback at QB24, and taking him nine rounds before his ADP suggests the manager felt the Purdy risk acutely. The margins here are thin and honest: the elite pass-catchers make DCNS dangerous, but the roster only goes as far as Purdy's health and weapons allow, and right now neither is settled.

SONofaSWAN22 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by winning the transaction almost every time. The clearest proof: Jeremiyah Love lands as a projected RB13 after slipping a full round and a half past his ADP, and Rome Odunze comes in as a projected WR30 after falling more than a round. Neither pick is the kind of moment that gets screenshot-shared in group chats, but both are exactly how a draft quietly compounds into something real. Across the whole board, the manager posted two good values against zero major reaches, with CeeDee Lamb sitting at WR5 anchoring a receiver group that also includes Chris Olave at WR11 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 as projected starters. That is a lot of reliable production at the top of the lineup. The division rank of fifth doesn't quite reflect what this roster actually looks like, and a 49th-percentile tournament standing feels like a floor rather than a ceiling. SONofaSWAN22 came out ahead on enough picks that the cumulative math should catch up.

There was no single moment in bobbycables' draft where the room gasped, no headline swing that will anchor a highlight reel, just round after round of quietly correct decisions that accumulated into something genuinely formidable. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 form a projected starting core that most managers in the Soap McTavish division would trade their best picks to own, and the fact that Achane arrived a full round past his ADP means bobbycables earned that pairing rather than simply paying for it. Justin Jefferson landing at WR6 while sitting at 2.05 when his price suggested he should have cost 1.12 is the kind of draft arithmetic that quietly separates thoughtful managers from lucky ones. The Tyreek Hill reach at 14.05 against a 17.09 ADP is the one moment the process slipped, but in a format that rewards volume of quality, three values against one major reach is a ledger that tilts comfortably toward the black. The result is a 59th-percentile projection that figures to climb as a starting lineup anchored by McCaffrey, Achane, and Jefferson finds its legs.

ColinGooz didn't win the draft with one flashy pick, they won it by repeatedly coming out on the right side of small edges. Puka Nacua at WR1 was available half a round past his ADP, and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slid a handful of spots further than he should have, and ColinGooz was there for both. That kind of quiet opportunism is harder to execute than it looks, because it requires the patience to let the board come to you rather than chasing names. The projected starting group around Nacua, Taylor, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Justin Herbert at QB8 is genuinely difficult to game-plan against, and Carnell Tate at WR29 and Michael Wilson at WR39 give the lineup real depth behind them. Makai Lemon at WR40 was another value, taken a round late. The Elijah Sarratt reach in the late rounds is a minor blemish, but that is a late-round swing, not a structural problem. At 59th percentile and fourth in the Soap McTavish division, ColinGooz has the pieces to climb both standings.

mattyhills did not build this roster with one dramatic swing of the sledgehammer. They built it the way a good contractor builds a house: competently, repeatedly, and without leaving money on the table. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the whole operation, and Rashee Rice at WR13 slid more than a round past his ADP to land beside him. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 give mattyhills a starting combination at tight end that most managers cannot match with one. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 adds a genuine difference-maker. The draft leaned chalk, which is not a criticism when the chalk is this good, and three players came in as clear values. Kyler Murray is the one thread worth watching. He landed in Minnesota after a lisfranc injury ended his Arizona tenure early, and now he is in a quarterback competition with JJ McCarthy that most observers consider Murray's job to lose. Whether Murray holds that job or not shapes how much mattyhills can squeeze from the QB slot. The rest of this roster is already doing its job.

JKelleher83 sits atop the Soap McTavish division and in the 87th percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why. Eight values and one outright steal across the board, with almost nothing wasted on reaches, is the kind of discipline that separates managers who understand the SFB from those who just show up. The steal headline goes to RJ Harvey, a projected RB28 who fell more than two full rounds past his ADP, landing at 12.08 as if nobody else noticed. Pair him with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5, both projected starters, both taken at value, and the foundation here is genuinely difficult to attack. George Pickens at WR10 and Tee Higgins at WR19 give the receiving corps the same kind of upside. JKelleher83 came back from a solid 2025 campaign, 83rd percentile in scoring, and built something cleaner this time around. There is very little to pick apart. That is not luck. That is a manager who knew what they were doing on every single pick.
