There is not much left to argue about with bradleytwin01. Sitting third in the Solid Snake division and in just the 3rd percentile of the field, this roster graded out near the bottom in 2025 and the 2026 build does not change the math in any meaningful way. The draft was mostly chalk, and the one move that might have reshuffled the deck, a second-overall pick on Jaxson Dart, was a 3.4-round reach on a QB11 projection that would have been fine in round five and is hard to justify where it was taken. The one genuine reason to stay interested is Carnell Tate, a WR29 projection going into Tennessee alongside Cam Ward in a pairing that still has to prove itself, and if it does not click, Tate's ceiling drops fast. Drake Maye grades out as a QB2 and anchors the position credibly, but the rest of the projected starters bottom out at Quentin Johnston at WR41, and when your weakest starter is your floor, you are not sneaking up on anyone in this field.

The Legion of Doom enters 2026 ranked 11th in the Solid Snake division and sitting at the 7th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the roster construction to argue otherwise. The most telling detail is not where they are but how they got there: four major reaches in the draft, including Blake Corum taken nearly three rounds early and Trey Benson grabbed more than three rounds ahead of his ADP. Those are not bold swings, they are the drafting equivalent of buying high on a hand you have already misread. The receiving corps compounds the problem, with Terry McLaurin projecting as WR24 and Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 as the primary contributors at the position. Justin Herbert grades out as QB8, which is genuinely useful, but when your supporting cast thins out this quickly, Herbert becomes a life raft on a sinking ship rather than an engine for contention. Last season's 25 percent win rate was not a fluke. This roster is not positioned to tell a different story in 2026.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes from watching a great thing slowly become a different thing, and TheDynastyMind is putting that feeling on display in 2026. Last year's team went 30-6 and scored in the 96th percentile. This year's team sits 10th in the Solid Snake division and projects to the 14th percentile of the field, and the distance between those two numbers is the whole story. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Puka Nacua at WR1, Nico Collins at WR9, and Rashee Rice at WR13 all projected as starters, but the draft that assembled this roster offers little reason for optimism about the process. Eleven chalk picks, five minor reaches, and a major reach on Keenan Allen taken nearly six rounds before his ADP suggest a manager who spent the draft chasing names rather than value. The names are fine. The gap between what this roster was and what it projects to be is not.

Bubblefish sits ninth in the Solid Snake division and projects at just the 40th percentile of the field, and a close look at the roster explains exactly why. The backfield is legitimately elite, with Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Jonathan Taylor (RB4) anchoring a group that almost any manager would envy, and that is precisely the problem: the rest of the roster is not keeping pace. The receiver corps grades out average at best, with Malik Nabers (WR12) as the only genuine difference-maker and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) as a reasonable secondary piece before the depth falls off a cliff into names like Jayden Higgins (WR54) and Rashod Bateman (WR92), the latter a player the manager reached 2.8 rounds early to acquire. The tight end group is the weakest position on the sheet, with Hunter Henry (TE18) leading a unit that offers little upside. Even more damning, the draft log shows zero steals, fourteen chalk picks, and one major reach. When your ceiling depends entirely on two elite backs and everything else is structure, you are not a team with a plan, you are a team with a prayer.

2Legit2Colquitt is a team that lives and dies by the margins, and right now the margins are sending mixed signals. The core is genuinely good: Trey McBride at TE2 was taken slightly past his ADP and quietly anchors the top end, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 gives the roster a weekly difference-maker, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 keeps the floor from dropping out. The problem is that the ceiling hinges on a question nobody can fully answer yet. Patrick Mahomes, reached 1.5 rounds early at QB12, is reportedly ahead of schedule recovering from a torn ACL and LCL, but "ahead of schedule" and "starting Week 1" are not synonyms. If Mahomes is full-go, this team competes squarely in the thick of the division. If he isn't, C.J. Stroud at QB22 inherits the job and the cushion disappears. Sitting at the 55th percentile of the field and eighth in the Solid Snake division, 2Legit2Colquitt doesn't need a miracle, just Mahomes healthy and a few projections to break right.

flyeronthewall is the kind of team that makes you squint at the standings trying to figure out where they belong, because the answer keeps changing depending on which version of this roster shows up. The ceiling is real: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Colston Loveland at TE3, and Derrick Henry at RB12 give the lineup a legitimate spine, and pairing Loveland with Harold Fannin at TE6 means the top of this roster can genuinely hurt you on a given week. But the floor is where the uncertainty lives. Dak Prescott projects as a QB7 but carries an asterisk that feels heavier than most, and RJ Harvey at RB28 is the projected weakest starter, the kind of player who decides close matchups by either doing just enough or not quite. The draft was mostly chalk with a few values, nothing that signals a roster built with an edge. A 64 percent win rate in 2025 suggests flyeronthewall already knows how to live in the middle. Whether they can escape it in 2026 is a different question entirely.

tstearns88 did not win the draft with a single lightning bolt moment. The edge came from a series of small wins compounding into something real. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 landing at 1.06 when consensus had him going four spots earlier is the kind of quiet deviation that separates disciplined drafters from the field, and Tyler Warren at TE4 paired with Kyle Pitts at TE7 gives this roster a ceiling at that position that most managers in the Solid Snake division simply cannot match. Then there is A.J. Brown, projected WR8 and now suiting up alongside Drake Maye in New England, a pairing that looks genuinely dangerous if Brown can stay healthy, which has been the persistent asterisk on his career. Three values against zero steals tells you this was not a flashy operation, just a manager who consistently refused to overpay, with the noteworthy exception of Tory Horton and Jack Bech taken well ahead of their ADPs late. Those are fine gambles at that stage. Sitting 64th percentile overall and sixth in the division, this roster has earned a quiet kind of confidence.

ExtraSus entered the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft and simply decided the board was wrong. Jaxon Smith-Njigba went at 1.02 when consensus had him closer to 1.06, Omarion Hampton was grabbed in round two before the market caught up, and the late rounds saw ExtraSus hoover up receiver after receiver ahead of schedule. Seven minor reaches in total, zero major ones, which means the conviction was calibrated rather than reckless. The receipts bear that out. Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Hampton as RB9, and Lamar Jackson, the one player who actually fell to ExtraSus, slots in as QB3 and anchors a live stack with Mark Andrews. The result is a starting lineup that looks like it was assembled by someone who knew exactly what they wanted and went and got it, ADP be damned. Coming off a 94th-percentile scoring season in 2025, ExtraSus lands in the 66th percentile this year, which sounds like regression until you remember the roster and ask whether the model has fully caught up to the manager.

Nick Josephson did not build this roster with one flashy gamble. He built it pick by pick, round by round, and the cumulative result lands him at 68th percentile in the field with a starting core that holds up to scrutiny. Justin Jefferson at WR6, Brock Bowers at TE1, and Chris Olave at WR11 give this team a genuine top-end that most managers would not complain about on a Tuesday morning, let alone a Sunday. Zay Flowers fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before Josephson grabbed him at WR16, and Khalil Shakir slipped almost two rounds as well, both values landing quietly in the middle rounds without fanfare. The quarterback shelf is thin across the board, with Bryce Young, Kirk Cousins, and J.J. McCarthy projecting as QB26, QB35, and QB37 respectively, but in a positionless format the strength of Jefferson, Bowers, and that receiver group absorbs that exposure. Michael Pittman heads to Pittsburgh to figure out a new offense alongside DK Metcalf, which is a question mark, but Pittman projects as a starter and adds real depth. This roster did not make headlines on draft day. It just kept coming out ahead.

Joe Dolan finished 2025 in the middle of the field and came back this offseason apparently determined to stop being polite about it. The draft sheet looks aggressive to the point of recklessness: three major reaches, two minor ones, zero steals. And yet the roster that emerged is sitting third in the Solid Snake division and at the 76th percentile tournament-wide, which suggests the aggression was directed rather than random. The spine of this team is legitimately impressive. Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Saquon Barkley as RB8, and Joe Burrow as QB4, with Burrow actually representing the one moment Dolan let value come to him, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP to land at 3.03. The Burrow and Tee Higgins stack adds another layer of upside on top of an already strong core. Dolan reached for Darnell Washington more than five rounds early and for Michael Mayer nearly three and a half, and both sit at the bottom of the projected lineup. Maybe that is where conviction ends and luck begins. The scoreboard will sort that out.

Cardboard Box A didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a steady hand and a sharp eye. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize the picks kept landing on the right side of value, headlined by Breece Hall falling more than a round and a half past his ADP into a waiting lap at 6.09. That kind of quiet patience compounds. The projected starters read like a team that simply won its rounds: Josh Allen at QB1 anchoring the top, Drake London at WR7 and George Pickens at WR10 giving the receiving corps genuine upside, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 adding a high ceiling if his comeback from a November ACL tears cleanly into a Packers offense that quietly cleared room for him at the top. The squad finished last year at the 79th percentile and now projects at the 85th, sitting second in the Solid Snake division. No fireworks, no heroics, just a draft that kept coming out ahead, round after round.

vheeb2 sits atop the Solid Snake division and in the 92nd percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly why: six good values, one steal, and zero reaches across the entire board. That is not luck, that is discipline. The steal anchoring this roster is Jeremiyah Love, an RB13 projection snagged at pick 6.08 when his ADP sat two-plus rounds earlier, and that kind of patience rewarded with upside is the signature move of a drafter who knows when to wait. Up front, Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 give vheeb2 a ceiling most managers in this tournament would trade for on the spot. Jalen Hurts, taken nearly a full round after his ADP, stacks neatly with Dallas Goedert and adds a second projected starter at quarterback without costing a premium pick. The weakest projected starter is Josh Downs at WR46, which is the kind of complaint that comes standard when everything else is this clean.
