RaSt1FaRiN sits at 7th percentile in the field heading into 2026, and the roster offers very little reason for optimism. The best argument for this team is the tight end group, where Colston Loveland (TE3), Travis Kelce (TE10), and Sam LaPorta (TE11) give the squad genuine positional dominance, but in a positionless format that advantage spreads thin fast when the surrounding talent falls off a cliff. Jared Goff (QB16) is a quietly reliable producer, and the Goff/LaPorta stack adds some connective tissue, but Goff's ceiling is baked in: no legs, no upside, just steady. The wider roster tells the real story. Jaylen Warren (RB27) projects as the weakest starter, and the names propping up the rest of the lineup, Blake Corum (RB35), Brian Robinson (RB45), include no one capable of changing a week on their own. The draft leaned chalk with a few minor reaches, producing no meaningful upside swing. This is a team that finished 72nd percentile in scoring in 2025 and somehow has less to work with now.

sammyfavs enters 2026 sitting in 11th place in the Sonic division and the 8th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly how they got there. Zero steals, zero true values, eight chalk picks, and ten reaches, five of them major. The reaches are the real story: Emanuel Wilson, a projected RB69, was taken six rounds ahead of his ADP, Braelon Allen and Dylan Sampson were each pulled forward more than three rounds, and the cumulative damage of that approach bled the roster of the late-round upside that separates functional teams from desperate ones. The one moment sammyfavs actually let the board work for them, Tucker Kraft falling a full round past his ADP in the sixth, produced their lone good-value pick, and even Kraft comes with the caveat of a recent ACL recovery and questions about whether he can recapture what looked like a starring role before November ended his season early. Justin Jefferson and Drake London give this team a real top-two punch at WR6 and WR7, but a

floor built on wishful reaches and a ceiling dependent on a recovering tight end is not a plan. It is a prayer wearing a jersey.

There is a specific kind of draft misery reserved for the manager who did everything right and still ends up here. pro872198 played the ADP game with discipline, landing 16 picks at or near consensus value and snagging Tyler Allgeier three full rounds past his price tag. The receiver group looks genuinely promising on paper, with Nico Collins (WR9), Chris Olave (WR11), and Rashee Rice (WR13) all projected as starters. But the rest of the roster does not keep pace, and the cumulative shortfall lands this team at 10th in the Sonic division, sitting in the 10th percentile of the field. Parker Washington is interesting as a depth piece, but whether the Jaguars organization actually wants him as a lead option is a fair question, which means his ceiling stays real and constrained at the same time. The quarterback situation, headlined by a projected QB13 in Brock Purdy with Malik Willis lurking as the weakest projected starter, offers little cushion. pro872198 followed the rules. The rules did not care.

Golden(Super) Sonic Chaos came into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft sitting on a 95th-percentile scoring season and left with a roster that makes you wonder if they were trying to give it all back. Four major reaches across the draft board is not a rough patch, it is a philosophy, and this team committed to that philosophy with conviction. The most defensible of them, Tyler Warren at TE4, still cost a second-round pick on a player whose ADP sat in the third. The least defensible, Demond Claiborne at RB63, was taken five full rounds ahead of where the market had him. Somewhere in the middle of that carnage sits Emmett Johnson at RB54 and Nicholas Singleton at RB57, each plucked well before their time, which makes Travis Etienne at RB18 feel like the one accidental adult in the room. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Carnell Tate at WR29, pairing with Cam Ward in Tennessee, give this team something real to work with. But at 18th percentile and ninth in the division, the draft erased last year before the season even started.

SeanGresham sits at 24th percentile in the field and eighth in the Sonic division, and the draft record explains a lot of why. Five major reaches against a single steal is the kind of draft profile that leaves a manager hoping projection systems are wrong rather than banking on them being right. Matthew Stafford at QB14 cost a third-round pick when his ADP sat in the sixth, and Jayden Reed, the team's projected weakest starter, came off the board more than two rounds early to land at WR48. Those are the kinds of bets that need to hit just to break even, and so far the projections say they haven't. The saving grace is a backfield headlined by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, which is a genuinely elite foundation. But without a tight end better than Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19 and a receiving corps that grades average at best, there simply is not enough ceiling elsewhere to compensate. SeanGresham is not in a rebuilding phase, which would at least suggest a plan. This is just a tough roster with nowhere obvious to turn.

DynastyGriff sits at the 48th percentile and ranks seventh in the Sonic division, and that split-the-difference positioning feels entirely earned by a roster built on real quality at the top with genuine uncertainty below it. Trey McBride (TE2), Kyle Pitts (TE7), and George Kittle (TE9) give this team a projected starter group that most managers would trade for without hesitation, and the Jalen Hurts (QB9) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) stack adds a correlation piece that can erupt on the right week. George Pickens (WR10) as a projected starter rounds out a top end that is legitimately dangerous. The problem is that everything underneath that ceiling is a question. Jalen Coker (WR55) projects as the weakest starter, and the draft sheet shows two major reaches, including Skyler Bell taken nearly seven rounds ahead of consensus. Last season's 64 percent win rate proves DynastyGriff knows how to convert talent into wins, but this roster does not have last year's margin for error. When the studs produce, this team beats people. When they don't, there is not much cushion waiting behind them.

tuljhwk didn't win the 2026 draft with a single thunderclap moment, just a steady accumulation of correct decisions that left the roster sitting at the 63rd percentile with a compelling case for more. The foundation is hard to argue with: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this team two projected top-ten players at the same position, and in a positionless format that kind of depth at the top of the board translates directly into lineup flexibility and weekly upside. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 adds a genuine alpha to the receiver group, and Jameson Williams at WR21 and Christian Watson at WR28 fill out a projected starting corps that doesn't ask Chase to do everything alone. The one moment where tuljhwk deviated from chalk, landing Woody Marks at pick 18.11 against an ADP of 15.02, produced the draft's most notable value. After an 86 percent win rate and a 99th-percentile scoring season in 2025, this looks less like a team chasing lightning and more like a manager who simply keeps getting the quiet work right.

hopp134 didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's exactly the point. This roster was built the way good ones usually are, through consistent, quiet execution rather than any single flashy move. Chase Brown came off the board a full round past his ADP and slots in as a projected RB11, and David Montgomery slid a round late as well, giving hopp134 projected starters at useful spots without paying a premium for either. The receiving corps is anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, a projected starter who justifies whatever it cost to get him. Three values against zero major reaches across the entire draft is a clean sheet, the kind of draft grade that doesn't generate takes but does generate points. Sitting fifth in the Sonic division and at the 65th tournament percentile, hopp134 isn't the loudest name in the room, but this team is built to be relevant in October when quieter rosters tend to hold up better than the ones that made noise in August.

dnthsslethehoff didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a consistent eye for value. The foundation is hard to argue with: Brock Bowers at TE1 and A.J. Brown at WR8 are the kind of players who show up in winning lineups week after week, and landing Tony Pollard at RB30 more than a round after the market expected him is exactly the low-drama, high-upside maneuvering that compounds over a full season. Then there is Luther Burden, projected WR22 and entering 2026 with Ben Johnson comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown after a second-half stretch that paced a 1,000-yard pace. Burden has earned the hype, but this is still the season that proves it, and dnthsslethehoff is betting he delivers. With a 66th percentile projection and fourth in the Sonic division, this team is not a favorite, but it is exactly the kind of quietly built squad that looks obvious in hindsight when it goes on a run.

Rookz17 lands at third in the division and the 85th percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why: this is a roster built on consistently coming out ahead, pick after pick. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is the kind of foundational piece that anchors a lineup, and pairing him with Joe Burrow, a QB4 who slipped to 2.10 while his ADP sat at 2.05, shows the kind of low-drama, high-return efficiency that separates good drafters from lucky ones. Malik Nabers fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed as WR12, which is simply free money. The one wrinkle worth watching is Saquon Barkley. After a historically dominant 2024, he showed signs of regression in 2025 alongside a banged-up Eagles offensive line, and at 29 with Philadelphia reportedly managing his workload more carefully, his RB8 projection carries real variance. But that is a quibble on a roster with three genuine values, zero major reaches, and a Jaxson Dart double stack adding upside on top of an already-sturdy foundation.

Emerald Hall Zone sits at the 97th percentile in this field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. Seven values across the board, zero major reaches, and a manager who consistently let the board come to them rather than forcing their hand. Derrick Henry fell a full 1.3 rounds past his ADP before this team scooped him at RB12. Breece Hall slipped even further, a round and a half, and landed here as RB14. James Cook arrived at RB5 just four spots after his consensus number. That is not luck, that is patience rewarded three times over in the first six rounds. The backfield alone would make most managers blush, and then Davante Adams dropped a full round to fill out the receiving corps at WR25. Dallas Goedert came in 1.4 rounds late at TE15 to anchor the tight end spot. The two late reaches on Cooper Kupp and Keon Coleman are the only mild blemishes on an otherwise immaculate sheet. Emerald Hall Zone did not get here by accident.

Puka The Hedgehog sits at 97th percentile in the field and first in the Sonic Division, and the draft record explains exactly why: one steal, four values, and only two minor reaches against zero major ones. That is not luck, that is discipline. The headliner is Drake Maye, a projected QB2 who slid nearly a full round past his ADP before this manager pounced at 2.12, and Lamar Jackson, a projected QB3, fell a similar distance and landed at 3.01. Having two quarterbacks that good is almost beside the point in a positionless format, because what it really tells you is that this manager recognized value twice in the first three rounds while the rest of the room was looking elsewhere. Kenneth Walker III, projected RB10, dropped nearly two rounds before getting scooped at 5.01, and Bucky Irving, projected RB21, pulled off the same trick nine rounds in. The weakest projected starter is Dalton Schultz at TE22, and even he came at a discount. Clean from top to bottom.
