RotobuzzGuy drafted like someone who showed up to a poker table already down money and decided aggression was the cure. The clearest evidence is the reach pattern: four major reaches, zero steals, zero values, a draft that was all cost and no discovery. Ashton Jeanty and Omarion Hampton are legitimate pieces, projected RB7 and RB9 respectively, but paying 1.12 and 2.01 for players with ADPs in the second and third rounds means the rest of the roster was built in a hole. That hole leads directly to Jordan Love, a QB17 projection for a quarterback the Packers have never trusted to throw for more than 250 yards per game, whose receiving room still lacks an alpha, and whose top tight end is returning from a late ACL injury. Love is the kind of quarterback analytical people love and fantasy managers quietly resent. The 2025 squad finished in the 9th percentile in scoring. Nothing about this draft suggests the 2026 version is pointed anywhere different, and sitting second percentile in the Space Invaders division, the evidence agrees.

There is no flattering angle here. svyatogornyj sits 11th in the Space Invaders division, projected in the 11th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and four major reaches in a single draft. Four. The most confounding of those is Jaydon Blue, hauled in 8.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, a back projected at RB70 who is not a projected starter and could not justify his selection even in a positionless format where every roster spot is a premium. Meanwhile, Jaylen Waddle, one of the few players on this roster with a genuinely interesting story heading into 2026, lands in Denver alongside Courtland Sutton in a high-volume passing offense after years in Miami's dysfunction, and even he projects only as WR23. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 gives this team a foundation, and the Jalen Hurts and Dallas Goedert stack adds a point of legitimate optimism. But when your draft looks like a series of accidents dressed as decisions, McCaffrey can only carry so much.

Last year's 78th-percentile finish made SkinnyMcKin look like a contender. The 2026 roster suggests that was closer to a high-water mark than a foundation. The top of the lineup holds real promise, with Caleb Williams projected at QB6 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, and A.J. Brown at WR8 giving the team a legitimate ceiling. But the floor is another story entirely. The projected starters thin out fast, with Rico Dowdle grading out at RB32 as the weakest link, and the tight end situation is a quiet disaster, with David Njoku sitting at TE29 on a position where anything outside the top ten is essentially replaceable. The draft didn't help much either, producing no steals and one major reach in A.J. Brown, taken nearly a full round before his ADP. Sitting at 12th percentile in the field and 10th in the Space Invaders division, SkinnyMcKin isn't shopping for an edge anymore. They're shopping for a lifeline.

There is something quietly devastating about where Toph013 sits entering 2026. Last season this team finished in the 94th percentile, going 32-4 and posting 5080 points, a performance that earns real credibility. This year the projections slot the team 9th in the Space Invaders division and in just the 14th percentile of the field, a collapse in standing so steep it almost reads as a clerical error. The core of the problem is at the top. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a genuine foundation, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 adds real starter-level upside, but the projected starting quarterbacks are Jared Goff at QB16 and C.J. Stroud at QB22, neither of whom inspires much confidence as a weekly engine. Toph013 drafted mostly chalk, produced no true steals, and reached on Stroud and Brian Thomas Jr. before the market came to them. The 2025 version of this team looked like a contender. The 2026 version looks like its memory.

TrTrl enters 2026 sitting at the 25th percentile in the tournament field, and the draft log explains exactly how they got there. The reaches tell the story: Malik Willis at QB24 was taken 2.3 rounds early, Josh Jacobs at RB16 cost a round and a half before his ADP, and Jalen Tolbert, projected at WR102, was pulled off the board nearly six rounds ahead of schedule. That is three swings where the market said wait and TrTrl said no, and the projections suggest the market was right each time. Drake Maye is a genuine bright spot at QB2, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as a WR3 worth building around, but after those two the roster grades out average at best. Derrick Henry, Kyren Williams, and Jacobs are all projected starters, yet none of them cracks RB12 territory, and Rhamondre Stevenson is the projected weakest starter. There is no obvious lever left to pull, no undervalued piece sitting at the bottom of the roster quietly waiting to save the season. This team is what it is, and what it is is eighth in the Space Invaders division.

DoobieJ enters 2026 sitting 7th in the Space Invaders division and at the 41st percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The backfield is genuinely impressive, with Bijan Robinson (RB2), Saquon Barkley (RB8), and Cam Skattebo (RB20) all projecting as starters, but that group is doing a lot of heavy lifting for a team whose receiver corps tops out at Luther Burden (WR22) and Courtland Sutton (WR37), neither of whom exactly inspire championship dreams. The draft did not help matters much. Skattebo was taken two full rounds ahead of his ADP, and Kirk Cousins (QB35) was yanked off the board 3.6 rounds early, a pair of reaches that consumed capital without adding a single elite-tier asset. Lamar Jackson (QB3) is a legitimate anchor and a rare bright spot, but one star quarterback cannot paper over a receiver group that grades out weak and a draft profile littered with chalk. Coming off a 4-32 campaign that landed in the 5th percentile of scoring, DoobieJ needed a transformative offseason and got a shrug instead.

Bounty7746 sits at the tournament's exact midpoint, 49th percentile, which is either the most comfortable place in the field or the most dangerous, depending on how the margins break. The case for optimism starts at the top: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Brock Bowers at TE1 are genuine difference-makers, the kind of projected production that props up a roster when everything else is running lukewarm. Chris Olave at WR11 and Zay Flowers at WR16 keep that ceiling respectable. The concern is that the floor drops off quickly, with D'Andre Swift projecting at RB24 and the depth behind him thinning fast, and the weakest projected starter, Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, representing exactly the sort of fringe contributor who swings close weeks in the wrong direction. The draft offered no real separation, eighteen chalk picks and two minor reaches, meaning Bounty7746 built this roster the way most managers build them and will need the players to outperform projections rather than the draft to carry any extra weight. Sixth in the Space Invaders division feels right, but right is not where anyone wants to stay.

Biggls1058 didn't make one splashy move and call it a draft. They made twenty of them, and the cumulative effect landed them at the 82nd percentile of the field. The anchor is Josh Allen, a QB1 who costs nothing to worry about on a weekly basis, but the real craftsmanship shows one pick later in the receivers. CeeDee Lamb slid nearly a full round past his ADP of 1.11, and Biggls1058 was sitting right there at 2.07 to collect a WR5 at a discount that most managers can only daydream about. From there the draft read like a patient accumulation of small wins: Garrett Wilson at WR17, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and Oronde Gadsden falling a round past his ADP to give the roster a projected TE16 as a secondary option. Fourteen chalk picks sounds uninspiring until you realize chalk tends to mean the market agreed with you, and when you sandwich it between a steal at the top and no major reaches anywhere, you end up with a team that is simply built right.

Mr Funbags lands at 83rd percentile in the field, and the draft tells you exactly why: no dramatic swings, just a steady accumulation of edge. The clearest example is the receiver group, where Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors a projected starting corps that also includes George Pickens at WR10, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and Ladd McConkey at WR20, with Colston Loveland at TE3 adding another projected starter who grades out among the elite at his position. None of that came cheap, but the manager found room to breathe elsewhere. Travis Hunter fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed here at WR62, a late-round addition that cost almost nothing and still contributes. The draft sheet shows 14 chalk picks and just two minor reaches, which sounds pedestrian until you realize it means virtually nothing was overpaid. When your baseline is Chase and Loveland and you keep tightening the margins on the back end, fourth in the Space Invaders division feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

Kcgould doesn't have a signature move to point to, just a draft that kept winning small battles until the ledger looked very good. Landing Dak Prescott at 4.12 when his ADP sat at 3.07 was the kind of quiet win that doesn't make highlights but absolutely makes rosters, and getting Breece Hall at 6.12 when the market had him going nearly two rounds earlier told the same story. The result is a starting corps that projects as genuinely formidable: Puka Nacua at WR1, Nico Collins at WR9, Hall at RB14, and Prescott at QB7 form a core that most managers in the field would trade their draft for. The minor reaches on Blake Corum and Kyle Monangai suggest Kcgould was willing to pay a small premium for depth, and Monangai projecting as the weakest starter at RB33 is not an indictment, it is a testament to how much quality sits above him. Third in the Space Invaders division and 92nd percentile overall, this roster earned that standing one well-timed pick at a time.

Sitting at 96th percentile in the tournament and second in the Space Invaders division, Aussie Invaders is what happens when a manager shows up with a plan and executes it clean: 20 picks, zero reaches, not one. The foundation is legitimately elite, with Jahmyr Gibbs projected as RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 both slotted as starters, and De'Von Achane was a good value pick on top of that, falling nearly a full round past his ADP. Justin Herbert, the QB8, was similarly patient money, taken a full round late. Then there is Michael Wilson, the steal of the draft, a projected WR39 who fell two full rounds to pick 11.04 and figures to contribute immediately. Drake London at WR7 and Harold Fannin at TE6 round out a starting group that projects as genuinely top-shelf. After a 2025 campaign that landed at just the 25th percentile in scoring, this roster looks like a legitimate correction, built not on hope but on discipline and draft-board value claimed at nearly every turn.

TheCak did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to gamble. This is a draft built on discipline, and the numbers back it up: sitting first in the Space Invaders division and at the 96th tournament percentile, the evidence is right there on the board. The anchor of this roster is the tight end group, where Trey McBride (TE2), Tyler Warren (TE4), Kyle Pitts (TE7), and Travis Kelce (TE10) form a projected starting core that most managers would trade entire rosters to access. Kelce drew some offseason uncertainty about whether he would return at all, but he is back, and landing him a full round after his ADP means TheCak got a motivated veteran at a discount. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) arriving two full rounds late, stacked with both Rashee Rice (WR13) and Kelce, compounds that value further. Michael Mayer (TE39) is the one reach on an otherwise clean sheet, taken nearly four rounds early, but when your floor is this high, one overpay at the back of the draft is barely a footnote.
