One More Quarter finished last season at 67 percent wins and in the 64th percentile of scoring, which makes the current projection of 10th percentile feel like a trapdoor opening underfoot. The draft tells much of the story: three major reaches and zero steals across the entire board. Spending a pick at 4.01 on Matthew Stafford, a QB14, and a pick at 3.12 on Jared Goff, a QB16, meant committing enormous early capital to two aging quarterbacks whose combined ceiling barely clears replacement level at the position. The Goff / Amon-Ra St. Brown stack gives the team a real weapon, since St. Brown projects as WR4, but one elite receiver and a pair of undersized QB investments do not quietly add up to a contender. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 is legitimately exciting, but he was reached on too, taken nearly a round ahead of his ADP. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no late-round coup hiding in the back of the roster. This team is projecting bottom of the division, and the draft decisions make it hard to argue otherwise.

The Banana Slugs sit 11th in Space Invaders 2, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches across 20-plus rounds of opportunities. The biggest indictment is at the top of the board, where Joe Burrow went at 1.08 despite an ADP of 2.05. Taking a QB4 nearly a full round early in a positionless format is the kind of decision that echoes all season, and Banana Slugs compounded it by doubling back for Patrick Mahomes at pick 4.05, another minor reach for a QB12 who projects as a clear step below Burrow. The receiver group is projected weak, with Jaylen Waddle checking in at WR23 as the top option and a supporting cast that bottoms out at Tyreek Hill sitting at WR77. Meanwhile, RJ Harvey, the team's projected weakest starter, was pulled two full rounds ahead of his ADP. There is no unlucky bounce to blame here, no injury fog obscuring a sound plan. Banana Slugs reached persistently and built a roster that reflects every one of those decisions.

SomeYumphla drafted with genuine patience and discipline, collecting value pick after value pick, and somehow arrived at a roster sitting tenth in Space Invaders 2 and in just the 24th percentile of the field. That is the cruel part. Aaron Jones fell more than two rounds past his ADP, Isiah Pacheco fell more than two rounds, Makai Lemon fell nearly a round and a half, and every one of those players is ranked outside the top 35 at his position anyway. Getting a discount on a bargain-bin item is still buying a bargain-bin item. The quarterback shelf is genuinely enviable, Josh Allen and Drake Maye anchoring a group that includes Jalen Hurts as depth, but this format rewards overall player quality across the lineup, and the projected starters outside that quarterback group are a collection of WR40s and TE11s that flatline quickly. Romeo Doubs projects as the weakest starter on the roster, taken a round early at WR53, which tells you everything about the ceiling here. SomeYumphla did almost nothing wrong in the draft room and is projected to go almost nowhere because of it.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from catastrophe but from math, and the Porcelain Punishers know it well. The roster grades at the 30th percentile of the field and sits ninth in the Space Invaders 2 division, and the draft did not move the needle much: thirteen chalk picks, two major reaches, and just one steal across the whole board. The brightest light here is Christian McCaffrey at RB3 anchoring a genuinely strong backfield group, but at the top of the lineup the Punishers are leaning heavily on a stack that carries real uncertainty. Kyler Murray, a major reach taken nearly three rounds early at QB19, is paired with Justin Jefferson in the hope that their new Minnesota connection delivers what J.J. McCarthy could not last season. Jefferson's projections suggest last year's struggles were more about the quarterback than the receiver, and that is the bet this team is quietly making. If Murray never seizes the starting job in Minnesota, that calculus collapses, and there is no obvious fallback waiting on this roster to catch them.

Marty_S enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Space Invaders 2 division and in just the 40th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The foundation is not without merit: Brock Bowers projects as the TE1, and A.J. Brown at WR8 gives the lineup a genuine top-end piece. But after those two, the drop-off is steep and largely unforgiving. Justin Herbert sits at QB8, which sounds fine until you remember that Mike McDaniel inheriting a Chargers offense built around ball-control under Jim Harbaugh may keep his ceiling exactly where it has been, capped by team success rather than lifted by it. The weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, which tells you everything about the depth of this roster. The draft offered no help: zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and a roster that looks like it was assembled by someone who hit every consensus board square on the nose. Coming off an 11-25 campaign, Marty_S needed aggressive drafting to climb back into relevance. That did not happen.

jenpiacenti sits at 44th percentile in the field, a number that tells the whole story before a single game is played: good enough to beat the teams below the median, not good enough to frighten the teams above it. The receiving corps is genuinely impressive at the top, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba, Drake London, and Malik Nabers all projected as starters and ranking WR3, WR7, and WR12 respectively. Nabers is the clearest draft win on this roster, falling nearly a full round past his ADP to land at 4.07. But the draft board tells a cautionary tale too: Harold Fannin, taken 1.8 rounds earlier than his WR market, and two late-round tight end investments in Darnell Washington and Michael Mayer that each cost nearly five rounds of premium. That is three major reaches against zero steals, which means the top end of this roster is real and the depth underneath it was bought at a discount in the wrong

direction. In Space Invaders 2, seventh place is survivable. Whether jenpiacenti climbs out of it depends entirely on whether the stars stay healthy and the margins break right.

RFKemp3rd did not win the draft on one big swing. They won it on accumulation, and the cumulative evidence is hard to argue with. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 slid to pick 2.03 when his ADP was 1.11, a windfall that set the tone for everything that followed. Tee Higgins at WR19 fell a full round past his ADP, and Chris Olave at WR11 rounds out a receiving group that projects among the tournament's better collections at the position. Trey McBride at TE2 is the kind of anchor that wins weeks quietly, and the Tyler Shough and Olave stack gives this roster a built-in multiplier on big Shough games. Yes, there are reaches on the board, including a 2.5-round early pop on Shough himself, but the five legitimate values elsewhere absorbed that cost comfortably. Coming off an 80th-percentile scoring season in 2025, RFKemp3rd enters 2026 sitting 6th in Space Invaders 2, which feels like a placeholder rather than a ceiling for a roster built this deliberately.

P2WFantasy enters 2026 carrying a concentrated payload of elite talent, and in a positionless format, concentration at the top is exactly what wins. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Caleb Williams at QB6 give this roster two projected starters who can go punch for punch with anyone in Space Invaders 2, and the front of the running back room is just as formidable: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 form a backfield anchor that most managers would build an entire draft around. Barkley slipping a full round past his ADP, along with Jeremiyah Love falling 1.5 rounds to land at RB13, means P2WFantasy picked up genuine production at a discount in those spots. The tight end group, led by Sam LaPorta at TE8 and Travis Kelce at TE10, rounds out a top-heavy roster that projects to field one of the more intimidating starting lineups in the division. The 57th-percentile tournament standing feels like it undersells what sits at the top of this depth chart. When the best players are this good, the argument starts and ends there.

spudsteeler didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. This roster was built the way good ones usually are: round after round of quietly coming out ahead. George Pickens fell a full round and a half past his ADP and landed at WR10. Jameson Williams and Marvin Harrison Jr. slipped similarly, with Williams projected at WR21 and Harrison at WR33, both taken at meaningful discounts. George Kittle came along at TE9 for less than he should have cost. Stack those together with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Nico Collins at WR9 anchoring the top of the lineup, and the cumulative effect is a roster that projects deeper than its draft cost. The Purdy-Kittle stack adds a connected layer that can surge on the same big game. Yes, Purdy was the clearest reach in the draft, and Harrison carries real uncertainty with a new quarterback situation in Arizona. But one reach and one question mark don't unwind what is otherwise a methodically assembled group, one that finished in the 78th percentile in scoring last year and looks built to push higher in 2026.

Deacon Blues didn't build this roster with one seismic swing. They built it pick by pick, round by round, consistently coming out ahead of the market. The engine here is undeniable: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a top-end foundation that most managers in the Space Invaders 2 division simply cannot match. But the real craft shows in the middle rounds, where Deacon Blues collected Josh Jacobs at RB16 and Bucky Irving at RB21 a full round and a half after the field expected them to go. Jacobs carries real uncertainty right now given an unresolved legal situation from the offseason, but at that draft price, the manager bought the upside without overpaying for it. Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 keep the ceiling elevated, and four values against zero major reaches is the quiet signature of a draft that never panicked. Sitting third in the division and in the 69th tournament percentile, Deacon Blues looks exactly like a team that knows what it is.

deardrfantasy didn't win the draft on one bold swing, they won it on volume and accuracy, and the receiver group is where that approach paid off most visibly. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, a genuinely elite anchor, and the depth behind him is just as disciplined: Zay Flowers at WR16, Davante Adams at WR25, and D.J. Moore at WR26 are all projected starters, all acquired near or at their market price, none of them flukes. The two values on this roster, Quinshon Judkins and Michael Wilson, were taken after the field moved past them, quiet evidence of a manager paying attention rather than chasing names. Tyler Warren at TE4 required a slight early commitment, but projecting as a top-five tight end makes that an easy defense. Dak Prescott and Trevor Lawrence give the team real quarterback options to play matchups. Coming off a 53rd-percentile finish in 2025, this roster sits at 82nd percentile heading into 2026, and the draft record explains why: seventeen chalk picks that hit, two values, nothing wasted.

Last year the Shaolin Dragons finished in the 3rd percentile in scoring, which is the kind of season that makes a manager question every life choice leading up to draft day. The 2026 version of this roster looks like a genuine correction. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of anchor that makes a lineup hum, and the manager surrounded him with Rashee Rice (WR13), Luther Burden (WR22), and Colston Loveland (TE3) and Tucker Kraft (TE5) giving this team two of the top five tight ends in the field. Burden and Jordyn Tyson both came to the roster as good value, sliding past their ADPs and rewarding patient drafting. Omarion Hampton (RB9) adds a projected top-10 backfield option to complete the core. The quarterback room is the least intimidating part of the roster, with Jordan Love and C.J. Stroud carrying some uncertainty, but this is a positionless format and the surrounding talent is strong enough to absorb that. Division rank first, 91st percentile overall: the rebound is already taking shape.
