namatteo enters 2026 sitting in the 8th percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason to expect a climb. The headliners are genuinely impressive, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a ceiling, but Nabers was already a reach at pick 2.10 against an ADP of 3.11, which means the aggressive early spending didn't uncover hidden value so much as it paid a premium for what the market already knew. Below that top tier, the projected starters thin out quickly, with Kenneth Gainwell grading out as the weakest of the group at RB34. Travis Kelce, who only confirmed his return after some offseason uncertainty, projects at TE10, which is serviceable but not the difference-maker this team needs. The draft produced zero steals and one major reach, which is not the profile of a team that found inefficiencies when it mattered most. namatteo finished 56th percentile in scoring last year and the roster grades suggest regression is the more likely direction this time.

Voodoo Pikachu enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Squirtle Division and in just the 12th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster leans on Christian McCaffrey (RB3) as its anchor, and that is a fine place to start, but the draft process spent too much of its goodwill reaching early and often rather than letting value come to it. Josh Jacobs, projected RB16, was pulled 1.5 rounds ahead of schedule in Round 4. Jake Ferguson, projected TE12, came off the board nearly two full rounds early in Round 6. Those are the kinds of aggressive bets that need to pay off to justify the cost, and with eight chalk picks and six minor reaches rounding out the rest of the board, there is almost no surplus value baked into this roster to absorb a miss. The one dependable bright spot is Kyren Williams, a legitimate RB15 projection grabbed a full round and a half late, but one good bargain does not fix a draft that essentially paid retail everywhere else and premium at the wrong stops.

ColbyConway's 2026 season preview reads like a cautionary tale about drafting with conviction you haven't earned. The signature disaster is Skyler Bell, taken at pick 15.12 despite an ADP sitting nearly nine full rounds later, a reach so aggressive it suggests ColbyConway was drafting from a different board than everyone else in the room. That pick alone would be survivable, but it wasn't alone. Jaxson Dart went in round four against an ADP that had him squarely in round five, Antonio Williams came off the board two and a half rounds before the market agreed, and Jack Bech arrived three rounds early for good measure. Five major reaches, zero steals, and a draft grade that lands this team in the bottom 15 percent of the field. The foundation has some legitimate pieces, Ashton Jeanty and Justin Jefferson give ColbyConway a real top of roster, but a 31 percent win rate in 2025 and a division rank of tenth suggest the supporting cast, assembled through wishful thinking and early triggers, will once again be the story.

There is no spin available for CharizardOnU, and the draft sheet does not offer one. The headline asset is Josh Allen at QB1, which is real, but Allen was taken tenth overall in a positionless format where that kind of capital can reshape a roster. What followed that pick mostly didn't. Christian Kirk, projected WR100, was taken more than six full rounds before his ADP. Jaydon Blue, projected RB70, went nearly six rounds early as well. Those are not aggressive bets on upside, they are the draft equivalent of leaving money on the table and then setting fire to the table. The reaches accumulate, four major ones across the board, against zero steals and two values that arrived late and quiet in Bryce Young and Colby Parkinson. The projected starters are functional, Nico Collins at WR9 and Harold Fannin at TE6 carry genuine weight, but the draft capital spent to get here does not match the projected output. CharizardOnU sits ninth in the Squirtle division and in the 31st percentile of the field, and honestly, the numbers are being generous.

Catemi enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Squirtle Division and projecting at just the 43rd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The receiving corps is genuinely impressive, headlined by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and A.J. Brown (WR8), and the Detroit stacks with Jared Goff add a layer of upside. But Brown's move to New England, while intriguing given Drake Maye's development, comes with the same durability questions that have shadowed him throughout his career, and counting on him to stay healthy for a full season is a leap of faith this roster can ill afford. Beyond that receiving group, the roster thins out quickly. Goff grades out as a QB16, and the fallback options at quarterback, Daniel Jones and Aaron Rodgers, are QB25 and QB29, respectively. Kenneth Walker III is a serviceable centerpiece, but the rest of the projected contributors project near the back half of their positions. The draft was almost entirely chalk with no steals, meaning catemi got the players they paid for and nothing more. That is a hard way to climb out of eighth place.

tmdean19 is the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl team that will haunt your sleep not because it's terrifying but because it's so relentlessly reasonable. The floor here is legitimate: Jonathan Taylor at RB4, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and a Caleb Williams/Rome Odunze stack that converts Chicago touchdowns into double-dipped points. Those are the names that keep this roster out of the dumpster. The ceiling, though, is where the margins start whispering. Tyreek Hill at WR77 and Brandon Aiyuk at WR81 were both reached for before their ADPs, which means tmdean19 spent draft capital chasing nostalgia at the back end of the board. The weakest projected starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, and a 47% win rate in 2025 confirms this is a team that has historically lost more coin flips than it wins. Seventh in the Squirtle division and sitting at the 45th percentile, this roster isn't broken, it's just parked one or two upgrades short of the kind of season that actually matters.

RedRyderSFB is a team that will win the weeks it deserves to win and lose the ones it doesn't, and that 48th percentile ranking feels less like an insult and more like an accurate diagnosis. The ceiling here is real: Drake Maye and Justin Herbert give this roster legitimate QB firepower, and Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of anchor that makes other managers quietly annoyed at roster construction. But the margins tighten fast once you get past the headliners. The wide receiver group is projected weak, and Michael Pittman as the WR44 is a fragile third starter in a format where startable depth matters. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which means RedRyderSFB is exactly what it looks like on paper, no hidden upside baked in from aggressive value hunting. C.J. Stroud, taken nearly three rounds after his ADP, is the one flier worth watching, because if he recaptures his early-career form,

the positional surplus at QB becomes genuine leverage. This roster does not scare anyone. It also does not lose quietly. The margins decide everything.

revellea didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by consistently finding players after the market had already moved on. Brock Purdy at QB13 slipped nearly two rounds past his ADP before revellea scooped him up at 7.04, and Sam Darnold at QB21 fell a similar distance before landing at 10.09. Those are the kinds of quiet wins that add up. Meanwhile, the foundation was already in place: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster as strong a backfield anchor as you'll find in the Squirtle division, and Barkley was the one notable reach, taken about a round early, which is a price most managers would pay without blinking. Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 round out a starting group with real upside. No single moment defines this draft, just a pattern of getting slightly more than the market offered, again and again. That pattern has revellea sitting at 68th percentile, and there's a reasonable argument it should be higher.

KoryHolst's 2026 squad is the kind of draft that makes you want to sit down and take notes. The foundation is obvious: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and a receiving corps built around Luther Burden (WR22), Terry McLaurin (WR24), Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), and Chris Godwin (WR38) as projected starters gives this team genuine week-to-week upside. But the real craftsmanship shows up in the value column. Jordan Love fell three and a half rounds past his ADP, Tyjae Spears dropped more than three rounds, and Colston Loveland landed at TE3 despite coming off the board later than the market expected. Then Isaiah Likely, now reunited with John Harbaugh in New York with a light tight end room ahead of him, arrives as a TE13 with genuine upside baked in. Three steals, two values, zero major reaches, and a 73rd-percentile finish overall. KoryHolst didn't get lucky here. He knew exactly what he was doing, and the board rewarded him for it.

There was no single moment where fstampfl won the draft, which is exactly the point. Pick after pick, the board came back a little friendlier than it had any right to. De'Von Achane at RB6, Breece Hall at RB14, Travis Etienne at RB18, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 form the kind of projected starting core that keeps other managers up at night, and none of them required a gamble to acquire, with 18 of 21 picks landing at or near chalk. The one name that carries real volatility is Rashee Rice, a WR13 projection attached to a situation that requires serious patience: suspension history, a knee procedure, and now reported probation violations that could mean jail time before the season even kicks off. If Rice is active and healthy he is a genuine difference maker, but fstampfl's floor does not depend on him. Sitting third in the division and in the 82nd percentile of the field, this is a roster built the quiet way, and the quiet way is working.

After finishing in the 18th percentile in 2026 scoring, ColinMcT arrives in 2026 with something that looked scarce a year ago: genuine star power at the top of the roster. Drake London checks in at WR7, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Trey McBride at TE2, and that trio alone represents a different level of ceiling than last season's roster could dream of. The rebound narrative gets even louder when you factor in Jalen Hurts at QB9, drafted nearly two rounds after his ADP, stacked with Smith for the kind of correlated upside that wins weeks outright. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 fill out a starting group that comfortably projects to the 84th percentile in the field. ColinMcT drafted mostly chalk, which is fine when the chalk is this good, and the Hurts value alone is the kind of draft-room gift that can carry a season. The misery of last year built the appetite. This roster looks ready to eat.

joedat0 didn't win the Squirtle Division with one flashy move. This roster was built the way good teams actually get built, by drafting consistently ahead of the market and letting the surplus compound. Joe Burrow at QB4 slid a full round past his ADP, and Trevor Lawrence at QB10 fell nearly two rounds before joedat0 scooped him up. Those aren't lottery tickets, those are the kind of quiet wins that separate a good draft from a great one. Layer in Puka Nacua at WR1 and James Cook at RB5, both acquired at or near value, and you have a core that justifies the team's 93rd percentile tournament standing before you even get to the depth. Tucker Kraft and Dallas Goedert anchoring the tight end spots only reinforce the theme: joedat0 didn't need to force anything. The 2025 season showed a manager who can actually win, 64 percent of matchups and 4,669 points, and the 2026 roster looks like the product of someone who learned from that and got sharper.
