As Doug's Weight embarks on the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook is anything but promising. Coming off a forgettable 2024 performance, where they languished in the lower tiers of competition, this year seems poised to be another uphill battle. Despite boasting a pair of stellar quarterbacks in Josh Allen and Joe Burrow, the team's glaring deficiencies at running back could be their downfall. With Travis Etienne, Javonte Williams, Tyler Allgeier, and Trey Benson all ranking disappointingly low, the ground game is more a liability than a strength. The wide receiver corps, though featuring a mix of talent such as Marvin Harrison Jr., Tee Higgins, and Davante Adams, is dragged down by Keon Coleman, a projected weak link. Even the tactical decision to reach for certain players in the draft—like Marvin Harrison Jr. and Calvin Ridley—adds to the uncertainty, with outcomes that could easily tilt unfavorable. The small stack bonus from pairing Burrow with Higgins

is a faint glimmer of hope in what appears to be a bleak landscape for Doug's Weight in both their division and broader standings.

Despite these concerns, the tight end duo of LaPorta and Tucker Kraft

should excel, particularly in this TE Premium format, offering a strategic edge. Currently positioned mid-pack in their division and below halfway in the broader competition, the team faces an uphill battle. Key performances from underdogs and the potential for breakout games may be essential for improving their standing. With the season's twists and turns yet to unfold, One Helmet & Two Balls will need a blend of strategic savvy and a touch of luck to climb the ranks.
