PodVader sits dead last in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in the first percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The most damning exhibit is the quarterback room: Patrick Mahomes, projected QB12, was taken in the second round at a time when QB12 value lives in round five. Trevor Lawrence, projected QB10, followed a similar trajectory, pulled a full 1.8 rounds early. Together those two picks swallowed premium real estate that could have addressed what became PodVader's actual problem, a receiver corps where the top projected starter is Jaylen Waddle at WR23 and the depth dissolves into names like Jalen Nailor (WR61) and Isaac TeSlaa (WR68). Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) is genuinely elite and deserves better company, but one transcendent piece cannot paper over a draft that produced zero steals, zero values, and five major reaches. This roster reads less like a plan and more like a series of panicked overcorrections, and the standings are likely to reflect that all season.

Rebel Scum sits 11th in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in the 20th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The receiving corps is genuinely elite, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) forming as dangerous a top-two as anyone in the tournament can point to, but the production has to come from somewhere, and that somewhere is Kyler Murray (QB19), a quarterback who spent most of last season on the shelf with a lisfranc injury that never healed cleanly before Arizona cut him loose entirely. Murray is now in Minnesota, theoretically in a competition for the starting job, and even if he wins it, QB19 is the ceiling. Stack a fragile QB19 against a field operating at a much higher level and those elite receivers start to feel less like assets and more like a beautiful car with a cracked engine block. The draft offered almost no relief, producing zero steals and one value against five reaches, including Tua Tagovailoa taken nearly three rounds early as the backup plan. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Boutte Fett is sitting at 20th percentile in the field and dead last in the Star Wars Battlefront II division, and the draft doesn't offer much of an alibi. The most consequential decision manager made was burning the first overall pick on Lamar Jackson, a reach of nearly a full round before consensus had him going, which set the draft board on a slightly defensive tilt from the jump. Jackson is legitimately good, projecting as QB3, and the Lamar Jackson/Mark Andrews stack adds a small structural bonus, but Andrews grades out as TE14 and Khalil Shakir, the projected weakest starter, is sitting at WR51. That's the ceiling of the lineup's floor. Derrick Henry at RB12 and Breece Hall at RB14 are real contributors, and A.J. Brown at WR8 is the kind of asset that keeps a roster competitive on paper, but there were only two values in the entire draft and zero steals. When the best compliment you can give a roster construction is "the chalk mostly landed," the math is already working against you.

Icemans TaunTaun Squad ran a nearly flawless value draft and still landed at 33rd percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of couponing your way to a cart full of groceries you cannot actually eat. Christian McCaffrey fell nearly a full round past his ADP to land at 2.05, Jordan Addison slipped two and a half rounds to 12.05, and the rest of the board filled in quietly at or around chalk, with only a handful of minor overpays scattered across the sheet. The process was sound. The problem is that the output is a WR group projected no higher than WR22 in Luther Burden, three tight ends none of whom crack TE10, and a quarterback situation built around Caleb Williams, who was the single major reach of the draft, pulled 1.8 rounds early at 1.08. Williams and Burden do stack, which helps, but Burden as the WR22 is not the stack anchor that makes a team. When your cleanest draft decision was McCaffrey falling into your lap and you are still sitting ninth in the division, the roster is quietly telling you something the draft grades refuse to admit.

Bothan Spy sits eighth in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and checks in at just the 47th percentile tournament-wide, and the roster does not offer much reason to argue with either number. Josh Allen is a genuine asset at QB1, and the receiver group has real depth near the top, with Drake London at WR7, George Pickens at WR10, and Tee Higgins at WR19 all projecting as starters. The problem is that the supporting cast thins out fast, and Brock Purdy at QB13 is a significant question mark rather than reassuring insurance: turf toe cost him eight weeks last season, Brandon Aiyuk is out of the picture entirely, George Kittle is recovering from a torn Achilles, and Ricky Pearsall's availability for 2026 is reportedly in doubt. Purdy's situation is the roster in miniature, promising on paper, undermined by circumstances. The draft did not help matters, producing zero steals, one major reach in Elijah Sarratt, and a value column so quiet it barely registers. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, and the clock is already running.

Olinger3781 sits at 52nd percentile heading into 2026, and that number tells the whole story: good enough to beat the teams below them, not quite enough to rattle the teams above. The ceiling here is real, anchored by a tight end group featuring Trey McBride (TE2) and Tyler Warren (TE4) as projected starters, which gives this roster a genuine edge at a position where most managers are scraping. Malik Nabers (WR12) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) add legitimate firepower at the top of the projection sheet. The problem is the margins. Drake Maye (QB2) is the kind of asset that can swing weeks, but the depth below the projected starters thins fast, and Matthew Golden (WR52) being the weakest projected starter means the floor on any given week is uninspiring. Mike Evans, now in San Francisco after his Tampa run ended last season, is a name that commands respect but a body that has proven fragile. Fourteen chalk picks and zero steals suggests a manager who drafted correctly but left no upside on the table. In a format where close calls compound, playing it safe rarely separates you from the pack.

The 501st Legion didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it by getting ahead on nearly every transaction that mattered. Saquon Barkley falling almost a full round past his ADP to the 3.11 slot would have been enough on its own, but then Courtland Sutton slid a round late too, and Jadarian Price dropped more than two full rounds to land at 11.11, where his RB26 projection looks like a bargain relative to what others paid for equivalent production. Stack in a Jordan Love and Tucker Kraft connection that creates built-in correlation upside, and you have a team built on accumulation rather than luck. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 give the roster a legitimate ceiling, and the projected starters carry real positional weight at nearly every spot. The 2025 squad finished in the 65th percentile in scoring, so the foundation was already there. This version is cleaner, deeper, and drafted with genuine discipline.

Any Given Parsec lands at 66th percentile and fifth in the division, which is a reasonable outcome for a team that spent its draft swinging early and often on players the board said could wait. The clearest example is Justin Herbert, grabbed at 2.10 when his ADP sat nearly a full round later, a move that announced the manager's intentions immediately. Then came Oronde Gadsden more than two rounds ahead of schedule, and Darnell Washington pulled forward by over three rounds in the back half of the draft. Against that backdrop, the roster could easily look like a monument to impatience. Instead, Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Herbert sits at QB8, and Rashee Rice landed at WR13 after actually falling past her ADP, which suggests the aggressive picks created enough board distortion to shake loose genuine value elsewhere. Whether the manager was executing a deliberate plan or just happened to reach for the right players at the right moments is genuinely unclear, and probably unknowable. The roster works either way.

Dbackss did not try to be clever. They just kept winning the pick. The headliner is Puka Nacua, projected WR1, who gives this roster a true top-of-market anchor before the rest of the draft even gets interesting. Then the values started stacking up quietly: James Cook landed at RB5 despite sliding nearly a full round past his ADP, Josh Jacobs came in at RB16 a round late, and Chuba Hubbard fell over two rounds to give Dbackss an RB29 at a discount. That is not one fortunate slip, that is a pattern. The Jaxson Dart reach at QB11 in round three stands out as the boldest call on the board, but Dart connects with Isaiah Likely in a stack that gives the offense a built-in multiplier on big Dart days. Five values, one steal, and a projected WR1 will land a team at 66th percentile in the field, and with a roster that keeps delivering surplus across the board, Dbackss looks like a squad that will quietly still be playing when the field thins out.

There was no single moment in this draft where CLANKERS reached into the hat and pulled out a rabbit. Instead, they just kept winning the smaller fights, and those accumulate. Chris Olave fell a round and a half past his ADP and landed at WR11. Chase Brown slid a full round and landed at RB11. Ja'Marr Chase, projected WR2, anchors the whole operation. None of these are lottery-ticket picks, they are consensus good players who happened to be available a little later than they should have been, and CLANKERS was there to collect. The two QB reaches are the one wrinkle worth noting, Fernando Mendoza and Deshaun Watson both taken well ahead of market, but in a positionless format that flexibility costs less than it might elsewhere. David Montgomery adds legitimate depth after leaving Detroit's committee backfield for a cleaner situation in Houston. The 77th percentile tournament ranking and second in the Star Wars Battlefront II division are the result of steady, unspectacular competence, which is exactly how good rosters get built.

shakenbake77 didn't build this roster with one thunderbolt pick. They built it the way good teams actually get built, by coming out ahead on deal after deal until the advantages stacked into something real. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9 anchor a receiver group that is genuinely elite, and Collins arriving 0.8 rounds after his ADP meant shakenbake77 essentially got a top-ten receiver at a discount before anyone else noticed the shelf was stocked. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 was the one place shakenbake77 overpaid, reaching 1.1 rounds early, but a projected RB10 starter is not a problem regardless of the acquisition cost. Javonte Williams at RB17 and Carnell Tate at WR29 both slid past their ADPs and landed in this lineup as starters, which is exactly the kind of quiet mid-draft competence that separates a good team from a great one. Third in the division and 77th percentile in the field are the current projections, but the draft process here suggests those numbers have room to climb.

The Cocaine Ewoks sit at the top of the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why. With six values and a steal on the board against just two minor reaches and zero major reaches, this is the kind of disciplined construction that separates managers who know what they're doing from everyone else. The headliner is Brock Bowers at TE1, a projectable anchor who elevates every lineup decision around him, paired with Colston Loveland at TE3, taken nearly a full round after his ADP. But the storyline worth watching is DeVonta Smith. The Eagles cleared the path for him this offseason, and Smith at WR14 finally gets to show whether he is the alpha he has always looked capable of being. Travis Etienne at RB18 came nearly two full rounds late, and D'Andre Swift at RB24 slid two-plus rounds past his ADP. When your weakest projected starter is a WR34, you have not just drafted well, you have drafted clean.
