There is not much reason for optimism in Stardew Valley, where afrodynamics sits dead last in the division and in the 4th percentile of the entire field. The draft tells a damning story before you even get to the roster: the two most consequential picks of the day were Matthew Stafford, a QB14 taken nearly two and a half rounds before his ADP, and Dak Prescott, a QB7 taken a round and a half early, burning premium capital on quarterbacks in a positionless format where that kind of early investment has to pay off in spades. It mostly did not. The one genuine ceiling piece is CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and she stacks with Prescott, which is something. Tucker Kraft projects as a TE5 and was ascending toward stardom before a November ACL tear, and he came off the preseason PUP list cleanly, so the optimistic read is that he slides back into a featured role in Green Bay. But "maybe Kraft gets healthy" and "Lamb is good" are thin reeds to lean on when your roster grades near the bottom of the field and the draft gave you nowhere to hide.

There is no painless way to say this: MidnightExpress86 is sitting 11th in the Stardew Valley division and projects into the 9th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The backfield is legitimately impressive on paper, with Jonathan Taylor, Kyren Williams, Bucky Irving, D'Andre Swift, and RJ Harvey all projecting as starters, but the receiving group grades out as merely average, and tight end is a quiet disaster anchored by Dalton Schultz at TE22. The draft did little to change the trajectory. Two major reaches define the board: Jayden Daniels, grabbed nearly a round early at pick 2.04, and Irving, pulled almost three full rounds before his ADP at 4.04. You can occasionally reach for a player you love and be proven right, but reaching twice at premium picks while generating just one steal across the entire draft is how you arrive at the 9th percentile. The levers have been pulled. The ceiling is what it is.

There is a particular kind of heartbreak reserved for the manager who does everything right and still ends up here. Cottage Cheese ran a disciplined draft, 17 chalk picks and barely a reach in sight, and the roster landed them 10th in the Stardew Valley division and in the 29th percentile of the field. The WR group is genuinely good, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 anchoring a position that has real depth behind it. But the Lamar Jackson and Mark Andrews stack, the kind of pairing that is supposed to provide a weekly floor, rests on a TE corps where Andrews comes in at TE14 and the projected starters do not inspire much confidence beyond him. Then there is the backfield, where Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest starter at RB27 and Chase Brown at RB11 carries a workload that will need to be enormous to compensate. Cottage Cheese did not draft recklessly. They just assembled pieces that, when added together, keep producing the wrong sum.

December Underground finished in the 87th percentile last season, and the 2026 roster carries that reputation into a projection that lands at the 39th percentile, ninth in the Stardew Valley division. The blueprint looks fine on paper: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team elite backfield production, and the Brock Purdy and George Kittle stack adds a layer of connective upside. But the receiver group is where the gap between last year's version and this year's becomes visible, with DeVonta Smith projecting as a WR14 and DK Metcalf sitting at WR36, a combination that does the work without inspiring much confidence. The draft offered no help closing that distance, going 18-for-18 on chalk with zero steals and zero values, which is essentially a vote of confidence in a roster that the projections are grading as ordinary. Juwan Johnson, the projected weakest starter at TE20, is the exclamation point on a team that looks less like a contender defending its percentile than one hoping last year's magic was more than noise.

ChefJustice enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Stardew Valley division and right at the tournament median, which sounds like a foundation until you start pulling at the threads. The receiver corps is genuinely impressive, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Malik Nabers (WR12) anchoring a group that goes seven deep in projected starters, and Drake Maye (QB2) gives this team a ceiling most managers would envy. The problem is that the roster's weakest projected starter is Jadarian Price (RB26), and there is no obvious upgrade path behind him, with the next options grading out at RB36, RB54, and beyond. The draft did not generate much runway either: two major reaches, on Kimani Vidal and Darnell Washington, spent late capital on players projected well outside the top tier at their positions, while the one genuine steal, Maye falling nearly a round past his ADP, had already been baked into the ceiling. Chase and Nabers can carry this team to plenty of winning weeks, but at 48th percentile entering

the season, ChefJustice needs things to break right, and the roster as constructed offers very little margin for when they do not.

Wes3140 sits at 55th percentile in the field, division rank 7, and that's about as on-the-nose a definition of "fine" as you'll find in the Scott Fish Bowl. The case for optimism runs through the tight end group, where Brock Bowers (TE1) and Colston Loveland (TE3) give this roster a genuine edge at the position, and the case against optimism runs through Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), whose 2025 raised real questions about whether his connection with Trevor Lawrence is the asset fantasy managers once assumed it was. Those two storylines pull in opposite directions, and the margins between them are where this season gets decided. Jeremiyah Love (RB13), drafted more than a round past his ADP, gives Wes3140 one legitimate late-draft win to lean on, but the receiving corps beyond Thomas is thin on upside, and Malik Willis (QB24) is a projected starter who does no favors for anyone trying to make a push. This is a roster built to be competitive, not dominant, and in a field this deep, that might be just enough to stay forgettable in the best possible way.

Papadoonsk didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's precisely the point. This roster was built the way a good meal gets made, steady, deliberate, and better than it looked in the pan. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the entire operation, and A.J. Brown at WR8 gives the lineup a second pillar that most managers in the Stardew Valley division would envy. Then consider the tight end situation: Tyler Warren at TE4 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 are both projected starters, and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 provides genuine depth behind them. That's the kind of quiet, compounding advantage that doesn't show up in any single pick but shows up everywhere in the standings. The Jared Goff and Jameson Williams stack adds a coordinated ceiling to a team that otherwise trades in floors. Sixteen chalk picks sounds like a passive draft until you realize the chalk included Gibbs and Brown. Papadoonsk sat at 56th percentile heading in and looks like a team that wants to be much higher by October.

DakotaMagnum built something real in this draft, and the box score of their draft decisions looks worse than the roster they actually ended up with. The two major reaches tell the story most honestly: Matthew Golden at WR52 taken nearly three rounds early, and Tyquan Thornton at WR97 taken almost three rounds before his number was called. Those are the kinds of picks that draw groans in draft rooms and raised eyebrows in ADP discussions. But zoom out and the top of this roster is legitimately difficult to play against. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchor a projected starting group that also includes Jalen Hurts at QB9, a genuine value after sliding a full round past his ADP, and the Herbert-McConkey stack giving DakotaMagnum a built-in bonus two points on connected production. A 63rd percentile tournament projection and a fifth-place divisional standing feel like they are underselling a team this loaded at the top. Whether the receivers they reached for develop into the vision DakotaMagnum had for them is the question the whole season hinges on.

serum114 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by not losing it. The foundation is a backfield that would make most managers envious: James Cook at RB5, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and Derrick Henry at RB12 are all projected starters, giving this roster a ground game that should produce points week after week regardless of how the schedule sets up. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 provides an elite anchor at the top of the lineup, and Trevor Lawrence slipping to 6.07 when his ADP sat at 4.11 is exactly the kind of quiet win that separates good drafters from great ones. Across the board, serum114 drafted chalk, and there is nothing wrong with that when the chalk keeps coming out at the right price. Bhayshul Tuten at RB25 and Tony Pollard at RB30 round out a depth chart that keeps the floor elevated. After a 28th percentile scoring season in 2025, this roster looks like a genuine correction waiting to happen.

I've Made a Huge Mistake sits third in the Stardew Valley division and at the 79th percentile of the field, and the path there was quieter than you might expect. No lottery-ticket gambles, no reach-and-pray moments, just a draft that kept finding the player a tick better than the price. Three values across the board tell that story: C.J. Stroud slipping a full round past his ADP, Zach Charbonnet falling more than two, Jerry Jeudy nearly two more. None of those picks will headline a recap, but that consistency is exactly how rosters like this get built. The real engine sits at the top, where Drake London (WR7), George Pickens (WR10), and Tee Higgins (WR19) form a projected-starter corps that very few managers in this field can match, buttressed by Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) and Josh Allen (QB1) anchoring the whole operation. The one variable worth watching is Dalton Kincaid, whose knee has lingered long enough that Bills GM Brandon Beane would not promise it would be behind him in 2026. A healthy Kincaid running alongside Allen would be a genuine bonus. An unavailable one is already baked into the skepticism, and this roster handles it fine either way.

patgar100 sits second in the Stardew Valley division and in the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. There was no lottery ticket, no moment where the room held its breath. Just round after round of sound decisions that quietly added up. The anchor is Justin Jefferson at WR6, a projected starter who gives this roster a true top-end talent to build around. Trey McBride at TE2 is the kind of positional advantage that compounds over a long season, a projected starter at arguably the scarcest position in the format. Beyond those headliners, patgar100 found Baker Mayfield as the biggest steal of the draft, a QB18 projection taken nearly two full rounds after his ADP suggested he would go. Projected starters Zay Flowers at WR16, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 round out a group that was assembled almost entirely at fair value or better. The draft had 17 chalk picks, which sounds boring until you realize most managers cannot execute boring this cleanly.

There are no heists on this roster, no lottery tickets cashed in at peak value, just a draft that kept quietly winning the exchange. Amerika108 built from the top down, landing Puka Nacua (WR1) and Joe Burrow (QB4) as the kind of foundational pieces that make everything downstream feel manageable, then filled out the depth with names like Nico Collins (WR9) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) who would headline lesser rosters. Jordan Love (QB17) slipped nearly two full rounds past his ADP and landed here, giving the team a legitimate QB2 that most managers simply don't have. The one blemish, Keenan Allen taken more than four rounds early, barely registers against the broader picture. David Montgomery adds some intrigue after leaving Detroit's backfield for a Houston situation where he can compete for a larger role rather than split carries indefinitely. The result is a team sitting first in the Stardew Valley division and in the 96th percentile of the field, not because of any single brilliant move, but because the draft rarely gave anything back.
