BordeauxJoe sat 9th percentile in scoring last year and somehow walked out of this draft in worse shape, landing 12th in the Super Mario Bros. division and in just the 7th percentile of the field. The blueprint was right there and got ignored. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team a real foundation, but Brown was reached on at 2.02 against an ADP of 2.10, so BordeauxJoe paid a premium to feel good about a pick that probably would have been there anyway. Then the draft turned genuinely ugly. Rachaad White, a projected RB39, was taken three-plus rounds early. Xavier Worthy, projected WR49, went three-plus rounds early as well. That is not aggressive drafting, that is paying round-eight prices for round-eleven players and leaving real value on the board. Parker Washington squeezed ahead of bigger names in Jacksonville last year, but whether the Jaguars actually want him as their lead receiver is an open question, and banking a starter's spot on that question is exactly the kind of hope this roster cannot afford.

jordews did almost everything right on draft day. Thirteen chalk picks, nearly every selection at or after ADP, and genuine value finds scattered throughout, most notably D'Andre Swift falling more than two full rounds past his average draft position. The problem is that being a disciplined, patient drafter and assembling a genuinely dangerous roster are two different things, and jordews discovered the hard way that they do not always arrive together. The receiver corps is legitimately good, with Justin Jefferson, Drake London, Chris Olave, and Garrett Wilson all projecting as starters, but the quarterback situation is a wasteland of Jacoby Brissett, Shedeur Sanders, and Michael Penix Jr., none of whom crack QB30 in a flattering way. Coming off an 81 percent win rate in 2025, jordews enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Super Mario Bros. division and in the 13th percentile of the field. The draft

was careful. The process was sound. The roster just does not work, and there is almost nothing to blame for it, which might be the worst feeling in fantasy football.

DynastyDegens finished 2026 as a 30th-percentile team sitting 10th in the Super Mario Bros. division, and the draft did not do much to change the math. The WR group is legitimately strong, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 anchoring a corps that goes six deep in projected starters, and Tyler Warren at TE4 is a genuine asset. But the quarterback shelf is a quiet catastrophe: Baker Mayfield projects as QB18, Malik Willis as QB24, and Tua Tagovailoa as QB31, and in a positionless format where any player can fill any slot, a weak QB room drags down the ceiling on the whole roster. The draft did not help matters either, producing two major reaches, most notably Josh Downs taken nearly three full rounds before his ADP and Elijah Arroyo pulled five rounds early. Those are the kinds of decisions that haunt a team already projected near the bottom, leaving DynastyDegens looking less like a contender and more like a squad hoping the projections are simply wrong.

The Elite sit ninth in the Super Mario Bros. division and project in just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft process offers little reason to believe a turnaround is coming. The top of this roster is genuinely strong, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give the team a legitimate foundation, but the rest of the card grades out as replacement-level optimism. The draft was defined by reaching early and often: four major reaches, including Dontayvion Wicks pulled nearly seven rounds before his ADP and Tyquan Thornton grabbed nearly five rounds early, inflating a receiver depth chart with players ranked WR96 and WR97 respectively. That is not building upside, that is spending future capital on players the market has largely priced as afterthoughts. With Wan'Dale Robinson projecting as the weakest projected starter at WR47, the gap between the top of this lineup and the bottom is steep. Gibbs and Barkley can carry a week, but they cannot carry a season.

Last year stred posted an 83% win rate and finished in the 94th percentile, the kind of season that earns a manager a reputation. This year's roster, sitting at the 35th percentile and eighth in the Super Mario Bros. division, is quietly asking whether that reputation was earned or inherited. The backfield is legitimately elite, with James Cook (RB5) and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) anchoring a group that runs deep enough to weather almost anything, and Drake Maye (QB2) gets a genuine upgrade with AJ Brown joining New England's offense, which should keep Maye in the QB2 conversation he earned last season. But the receiving corps beyond Maye's new toys is thin on paper, with D.J. Moore (WR26) and Christian Watson (WR28) as the projected starters at a position where the depth drops off fast. The draft did not help much either, producing zero steals and two major reaches, including Emmett Johnson (RB54) taken more than three rounds early. Stred built a team that could surprise people. It just does not look like the team that did it last time.

HeavyWt_Fantasy is a team that will spend the entire 2026 Scott Fish Bowl season hovering at the exact median of human experience, parked at the 49th percentile like a car that always starts but never quite gets you anywhere fast. The roster has genuine weapons: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Malik Nabers sits at WR12, and Ashton Jeanty clocks in at RB7, a top tier of starters that gives this team a real ceiling. The problem is what happens when that ceiling gets tested by injuries or variance, because the depth behind those names gets thin quickly, and HeavyWt built that depth with a draft that logged 13 chalk picks against zero steals. The one notable exception was Justin Herbert, a QB8 projection landed nearly a full round after his market price, a quiet win. But then the roster also contains Elijah Sarratt, taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, a gamble on a WR98 projection that represents exactly the kind of margin-shaving mistake that separates 56 percent win rates from something worth talking about in October.

allthepierogies sits at 53rd percentile and sixth in the Super Mario Bros. division, which is exactly where teams go to be forgotten or to quietly make noise. The roster is built on a foundation of shrewd patience at the draft, most notably Patrick Mahomes falling a full two rounds past his ADP to round 7.10, and CeeDee Lamb sliding to 2.03 despite an ADP near the end of round one. Those two alone give this team a Prescott-Lamb stack and a Mahomes insurance policy that most rosters at this percentile cannot claim. The problem is that the draft also includes two major reaches, Alec Pierce at WR32 going two rounds early and DK Metcalf at WR36 going nearly two and a half rounds early, which means allthepierogies essentially spent premium draft capital to land players projected outside the top 30. Trey McBride at TE2 is legitimately elite and Dallas Goedert at TE15 arrived as genuine value, but when Quentin Johnston at WR41 is your weakest projected starter, the margins between a winning week and a losing one are thinner than a pierogi wrapper.

mikea14 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, repeatedly. The backfield is the centerpiece: Bijan Robinson at RB2, Chase Brown at RB11, Breece Hall at RB14, and Javonte Williams at RB17 give this team a run of top-tier projected scorers that most managers would trade their entire draft for. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and George Kittle at TE9 add another layer of projected production at a position where plenty of rosters are thin. The draft wasn't perfect, with Chris Rodriguez and Emanuel Wilson taken well before the market agreed, but those are late-round gambles on upside, not catastrophic miscalculations. The bigger story is that the rest of the board was navigated cleanly, with 13 chalk picks and a Sam Darnold landing two full rounds after his ADP. Coming off an 89th-percentile scoring season in 2025, mikea14 arrives in the Super Mario Bros. division sitting fifth with a roster that will make that ranking feel undersized by October.

ajr540 didn't swing for fences that weren't there. This roster was built the quieter way, by consistently coming out ahead on value, and the results show up across the board. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 was already a strong pick at 2.06, but he slid just enough past his ADP to feel like a minor gift. Travis Etienne, projected RB18, fell nearly two full rounds before ajr540 scooped him up at 8.06, turning a late-middle pick into legitimate starter value. Jared Goff, RB16 running behind a Josh Allen headline, adds real depth at a position where the drop-off between starters is punishing. The one moment where ajr540 got ahead of the market was Matthew Golden, taken 2.4 rounds before his ADP, a bet that will either look visionary or merely aggressive by season's end. But one reach in a draft that logged three genuine values and fourteen chalk selections is a fine trade-off. Sitting 71st percentile in the field and fourth in the Super Mario Bros. division, this team earned its standing one sensible pick at a time.

luvtractor3 didn't win the draft with one flashy swing, they won it by refusing to lose any individual exchange. Four values across the roster tell that story cleanly: Jordan Love fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed at QB17, Matthew Stafford slipped a full round and brings a Davante Adams stack along with him, and Deebo Samuel dropped more than two rounds into the late innings. None of those are lottery tickets, they're just competent players acquired at a discount, which is exactly how draft equity compounds. Anchor the whole thing with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Omarion Hampton at RB9, both projected starters, and the foundation underneath this team is genuinely difficult to rattle. The 2025 season was a rough one, 26th percentile in scoring, but the 2026 roster projects as a different animal entirely, currently sitting third in the Super Mario Bros. division and at the 80th percentile of the field. luvtractor3 built this thing the quiet way, and quiet tends to age well.

newboldj sits at 83rd percentile in the field and second in the Super Mario Bros. division, and the draft tells you exactly why. This is a clean sheet of work: five values, one steal, thirteen chalk picks, and just a single minor reach across the entire roster. The steal is Woody Marks, grabbed at 18.09 when his ADP sat at 15.02, a three-and-a-half-round gift that fills out the back end of the roster with genuine upside. Up front, the lineup is anchored by Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Puka Nacua at WR1, two projected starters who give this team a ceiling most managers would trade their lunch money for. Jayden Daniels at QB5 rides shotgun, meaning newboldj is carrying two top-five quarterbacks while the rest of the division scrambles. The weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, which is less a flaw than a testament to how well the top of this roster was constructed. There is not much to pick apart here, and that is the whole story.

theValleyFF does not build rosters and then hope correlations emerge. The correlations are the blueprint. Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase sit at the center of everything, a QB4 and WR2 tethered at the hip, meaning when Cincinnati's offense erupts, this roster does not just benefit, it compounds. The stack is not a hedge or a happy accident, it is the engine. Surrounding that core, Kyle Pitts arrives as a TE7 projection after a 2025 that finally quieted the "this is his year" crowd, and his production has shown enough independence from quarterback chaos in Atlanta that whoever lines up under center should not derail him. Colston Loveland at TE3 adds another premium piece that reinforces the same principle: theValleyFF wants players whose ceilings climb together, not in spite of each other. Division-leading and sitting in the 92nd percentile of the field, this roster's fate is not a mystery. It rises exactly as far as Burrow and Chase take it, and that is a very deliberate gamble on a very scary offense.
