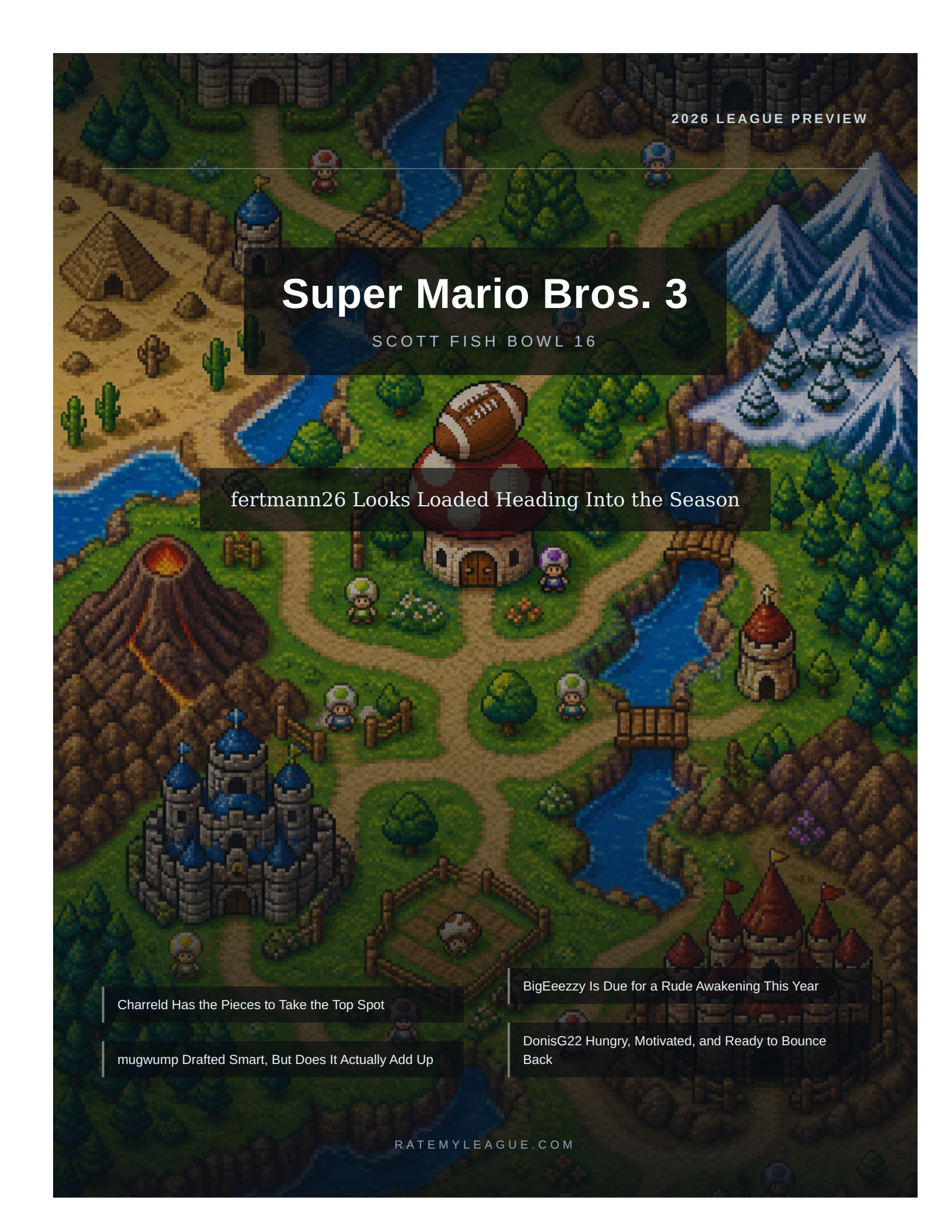

Last year BigEeezzy finished in the 88th percentile, and whoever is handing out reputations in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division apparently did not get the memo that this is a different team now. The 2026 version projects 12th in the division and in the bottom 12th percentile of the tournament, a freefall that deserves some honest accounting. Jahmyr Gibbs as RB1 is a genuine foundation, and Drake Maye projecting as QB2 gives this roster a ceiling, but the supporting cast thins out fast. The wide receiver group is classified as weak, and the projected starters top out at DJ Moore as WR26, Jordyn Tyson at WR34, and Jayden Reed at WR48, none of them building-block pieces. The draft did not paper over those concerns, either. BigEeezzy reached over four rounds early on Chris Bell, a WR87, and paid a round and a half early for Sam LaPorta when a TE8 at that price makes more sense later. The gap between what this manager accomplished in 2025 and what the numbers say is coming in 2026 is not small. It is the whole story.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and Wiz24 probably spent the offseason staring at it, finding comfort in the names. Justin Jefferson at WR6, Drake London at WR7, George Pickens at WR10, all projected starters, all legitimate weapons. The problem is that a fantasy roster is not a highlights reel, and once you squint past that receiver group, the picture gets bleak in a hurry. The backfield grades out weak, topped by Jonathon Brooks at RB37 and Chris Rodriguez at RB48, neither of them inspiring much confidence. The draft did not help matters: two major reaches and several minor ones inflated a roster that needed bargains, not premiums paid early. Wiz24 did land Tyler Shough three rounds past his ADP, which qualifies as a win, but a QB20 is a ceiling, not a salvation. At 14th percentile in the field and 11th in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division, this team is not rebuilding toward something. It is already there, and there is not much left to do about it.

AsyanSensation finished last season in the 82nd percentile of scoring, which makes what happened in this draft so much harder to watch. The headline number is damning: zero steals, zero values, nine chalk picks, and eight reaches ranging from minor to embarrassing. The worst offenders are Jerry Jeudy, taken four-plus rounds ahead of his WR66 projection, and AJ Barner, a TE24 snagged two full rounds early who projects as the weakest starter on the roster. That is the kind of draft capital destruction that reverberates. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 is a genuine anchor, and De'Von Achane at RB6 keeps this from being a complete write-off, but the back end of this roster is a graveyard of overpaid assets at positions that needed the rounds spent elsewhere. AsyanSensation sits 10th in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division and in just the 23rd percentile of the field. Last year's success now reads less like a foundation and more like a receipt for how badly this draft squandered the goodwill it earned.

Mugwump did almost everything right on draft day. Thirteen chalk picks, two genuine steals, and a philosophy of patient value hunting that would look responsible in any film room, yet the roster lands in the bottom half of the tournament at the 38th percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes a manager question every life choice up to and including fantasy football itself. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Derrick Henry at RB12, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this team a legitimate top tier, but the players projecting around those names thin out quickly, and the steals that were supposed to provide surplus value are both quarterbacks: Sam Darnold at QB21 and Daniel Jones at QB25, two late-round fliers who fell two-plus rounds past their ADPs for reasons that were not exactly mysterious. Falling past ADP is only a steal if someone else wanted the player. Mugwump played the value game correctly and still ended up here, sitting ninth in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division, which is the cruelest thing a draft can do to a careful manager.

DynastyBG lands eighth in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division and sits at just the 52nd percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change that trajectory. The most glaring issue is that four of the team's picks qualified as major reaches, including Michael Mayer at TE39 taken nearly five rounds early and Tyquan Thornton at WR97 taken more than three rounds ahead of his price. When you are burning premium draft capital on players projected at the bottom of their position, you are essentially trading future flexibility for fringe contributors. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are legitimate pillars, but the drop-off is steep and the projected starter pool is thin on upside. Jordan Love slots in as QB17 and his context tells the whole story: he is a winning NFL quarterback who has never cracked the top 10 in fantasy scoring, and the Packers still lack the weapons to change that math. DynastyBG finished at 54th percentile in scoring last year and is projected to tread the same disappointing water in 2026.

chicagaero lives in the margins, and the margins in Super Mario Bros. 3 are unforgiving. The receiver group is genuinely elite at the top, with Nico Collins (WR9), Chris Olave (WR11), and Garrett Wilson (WR17) all projecting as starters, giving this team a ceiling that most division rivals cannot match. But ceilings only matter if the floor holds, and that floor gets tested quickly. Geno Smith checks in at QB30, acquired in round 17 as the draft's marquee value, which tells you everything about the position's depth and nothing reassuring about it. The rest of the roster is almost entirely chalk, which means chicagaero built exactly what the consensus expected, no surprises in either direction. Last season's 84th-percentile scoring output proves the manager can squeeze points out of a roster, and that competence matters here because this team does not win by overwhelming anyone. It wins or loses on the small decisions, the right starts in the right weeks, the margins that separate 7th in the division from something worth talking about.

Last year was rough for DonisG22, a 9-27 slog that landed in the bottom 13 percent of the field in scoring, the kind of season that makes a manager question every decision from August onward. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine course correction. Josh Allen at QB1 is the sort of foundation that makes everything downstream easier, and the receiving corps around him features Malik Nabers at WR12 and DeVonta Smith at WR14, both of whom fell past their ADP and landed here at genuine value. Tyler Warren at TE4 was the one mild reach on the board, taken about a round early, but at that projection it is hard to argue with the instinct. The one real cloud hanging over this roster is George Kittle, a projected TE9 starter who tore his Achilles late in 2025 and whose Week 1 availability is genuinely uncertain despite his optimistic offseason comments. If Kittle is healthy, this roster sits comfortably at the 58th percentile and climbs. If he is not, the margin for error tightens fast.

Jgolds didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't gamble on upside and pray. They just kept winning exchanges. The centerpiece is a receiver group that genuinely belongs in any conversation about the best in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, A.J. Brown at WR8, Tee Higgins at WR19, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are all projected starters, and that kind of sustained quality across four spots is the product of a draft that stayed disciplined. Justin Herbert at QB8 arriving with a McConkey stack built in gives the offense a connective tissue most managers would envy. Yes, Herbert cost about three-quarters of a round more than market price, and the Colby Parkinson reach at pick 12.12 is a late-round quirk worth monitoring, but those are minor friction points on a ballot that otherwise reads clean. Sitting 58th percentile in the tournament and sixth in the division isn't a victory lap, but it reflects a team built the right way, quietly and correctly.

After a 2025 season that left WATOffb scraping the bottom of the scoring barrel at the 15th percentile, this roster looks like a genuine comeback story. The foundation is a backfield that would make any manager jealous, anchored by Bijan Robinson (RB2) and James Cook (RB5), with Josh Jacobs (RB16) and Javonte Williams (RB17) providing serious depth behind them. In a positionless format, that kind of top-end running back talent translates directly into weekly ceiling, and WATOffb has it in abundance. The draft also showed some savvy: Travis Kelce (TE10) fell a full round past his ADP, Javonte Williams came at a discount, and Fernando Mendoza (QB27) slid more than three rounds before WATOffb pounced at 16.07. The one eyebrow-raiser is the early commitment to Trevor Lawrence (QB10), taken 1.4 rounds ahead of ADP, but Lawrence projects as a top-ten signal-caller, so the premium is defensible. Sitting 59th percentile in the tournament and fourth in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division, WATOffb has real ammunition to turn last year's disappointment into a legitimate run.

Team chrisk55374 didn't need a miracle pick to build something worth respecting in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division, just a draft that kept grinding out small edges until the edges added up. The clearest example is Puka Nacua, a projected WR1 taken fifth overall when the board had him going first, a quiet discount on the best receiver in the pool. Then in the back half of the draft, C.J. Stroud fell three full rounds past his ADP and landed at 12.08, giving this team a projected QB22 for essentially free. Pair those values with a starting core that includes Ashton Jeanty at RB7, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and a receiver room anchored by Nacua alongside Luther Burden at WR22 and Mike Evans at WR27, and you have a lineup built on accumulation rather than luck. The draft sheet shows one steal, two genuine values, and only minor reaches throughout, which is exactly what quiet competence looks like on paper. Sitting third in the division and at the 63rd percentile tournament-wide, chrisk55374 has the foundation to climb.

fertmann26 lands at 78th percentile in the field and second in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: five values, fifteen chalk, and not a single reach anywhere on the board. That is not luck, that is discipline. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Joe Burrow at QB4 give this roster a ceiling that most managers are still dreaming about, and the value column adds real texture underneath them. Isaiah Likely fell a full round past his ADP and slots in as a projected starter at TE13, which is the kind of quiet win that separates a good SFB draft from a great one. Tony Pollard at RB30 draws the label of weakest projected starter, but a team that starts McCaffrey and Breece Hall alongside him is not losing sleep over that distinction. After a 23rd-percentile finish in 2025, fertmann26 came back with a tighter pen and a sharper eye, and this roster looks like the result.

Charreld sits first in the Super Mario Bros. 3 division and in the 84th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: mostly chalk, a few values, and almost nothing given away. The headline is the quarterback group, where Lamar Jackson at QB3 slid nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.10, a small but meaningful edge at the position that matters most in a positionless format. Chase Brown at RB11 followed the same pattern, falling over a round before Charreld scooped him at 4.10. That kind of consistent, low-drama accumulation is how you build a roster that holds up across a long tournament. The one genuine question mark is Matthew Golden at WR52, who enters 2026 with the Green Bay receiving corps thinned around him but without yet proving he belongs at the top of it. If Golden stagnates, the margin he represents gets eaten up fast. The rest of this roster, though, was constructed with the quiet discipline of a team that simply refused to lose its own picks.
