Roy finished 22-14 last year and cracked the top 35 percent of the field in scoring, so this is not a program built on vibes. But 2026 looks genuinely grim. The roster grades out near the bottom of the tournament, Roy sits 12th in the Super Smash Bros division, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that could paper over a thin projection. Three major reaches define the haul: Tyler Warren was grabbed a full round early, Jayden Higgins was pulled nearly three rounds before consensus, and Darnell Mooney was taken well ahead of his market price. Warren projects as TE4, so that one may hold up. But Higgins grades out at WR54 and projects as Roy's weakest starter, which is a rough return on a ninth-round pick, and Mooney comes in at WR82. Justin Jefferson at WR6 is a genuine anchor, and the Baker Mayfield and Emeka Egbuka stack adds some ceiling, but when your most aggressive draft swings produced your two weakest projected contributors, there is not much left to feel good about.

King Dedede won 89 percent of their matchups last season and finished in the 98th percentile, and whoever is responsible for this roster is apparently done proving things. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Drake Maye at QB2 are genuine pillars, and Garrett Wilson, Tucker Kraft, and Rome Odunze round out a starting lineup that projects well on paper. But the draft tells a quieter story: zero steals, two values, and a pattern of reaching, including Hunter Henry taken 2.4 rounds before his ADP and Chris Bell pulled 3.5 rounds early, a level of aggression that rarely pays off at those margins. The values the manager did find, Jared Goff and Isiah Pacheco, landed late and rank QB16 and RB52 respectively, which is fine depth but not the kind of surplus that defends a championship. The gap here is simple: a 98th-percentile reputation now sits atop a roster projecting 12th percentile, and reputation does not show up in the weekly scoring. Dedede arrives in 2026 wearing last year's crown and fielding a team that hasn't earned it yet.

There is no polite way to say this: billksims is staring down a rough 2026, and the draft did not do much to change the math. The most glaring problem is at quarterback, where Tyler Shough checks in at QB20 and the backups fall off a cliff from there, meaning the position is essentially dead weight in a format where you need at least one viable signal-caller to stay competitive. The wide receiver group offers a flicker of hope, with Zay Flowers at WR16 and Jameson Williams at WR21 giving the team a legitimate top end, but Ryan Flurnoy was reached for by 3.5 rounds, which is a lot of draft capital to spend on a WR69. The one genuine bright spot is a tight end group anchored by Brock Bowers at TE1 and Colston Loveland at TE3, which is elite, but strength at one position cannot carry a squad that grades out in the 16th percentile of the field. billksims sits 10th in the Super Smash Bros division, and right now there is no obvious lever left to pull.

There is no painless way to say this: nelsonthepetitedood is sitting at the 22nd percentile and ninth in the Super Smash Bros division, and the roster does not offer an obvious path out. The receiver group is legitimately elite, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), Nico Collins (WR9), and DeVonta Smith (WR14) anchoring a corps that most managers would trade their firstborn for, and Kyle Pitts (TE7) and Travis Kelce (TE10) give the tight end spot real credibility. The problem is that when you scroll past those names, the draft capital spent to fill out the depth tells a grim story: three major reaches, including Skyler Bell (WR103) taken six full rounds ahead of his ADP. That is not aggressive roster-building, that is paying premium prices for discount goods. Worse, the quarterback situation projects as a genuine anchor, with Kyler Murray (QB19) and Sam Darnold (QB21) as the likely starters. All the Chase in the world cannot compensate for substandard quarterback play dragging down the weekly ceiling. nelsonthepetitedood has real pieces, just not enough of them.

Hail2DaVictors2 sits eighth in the Super Smash Bros division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster's best hope rests on a top-heavy upper tier: De'Von Achane at RB6 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 are genuine difference-makers, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 was the clearest win of the draft, slipping a full round-plus past his ADP to land at 4.04. But after that small constellation of stars, the drop-off is steep and the draft process compounded the problem. Rashid Shaheed, projected WR57, was taken nearly three rounds early at 10.04, a reach that cost real draft capital at a spot where better value was almost certainly available. The projected starters grade out reasonably at the top, but the floor underneath them is thin, and with 11 chalk picks and five minor reaches padding the rest of the roster, there is no late-round upside waiting to bail this team out if Achane or St. Brown stumbles.

JFensterman sits at the tournament's exact midpoint, 50th percentile, and the roster reads the same way: genuinely dangerous at the top, quietly thin where it matters most for the margins. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this team a ceiling that can beat anyone on a given week, and Kenneth Walker III landing at RB10 after falling nearly a full round past his ADP is the kind of quiet draft win that separates median teams from good ones. The problem is that the depth supporting those stars thins out fast. Courtland Sutton at WR37 is a projected starter, and that number tells you something about how much this team will lean on its backfield to carry scoring weeks. Last season's 16th-percentile finish is a reminder that a strong top end does not guarantee results when the margins go sideways, and in a format this competitive, they always do. JFensterman has the pieces to win the weeks it needs to. The question is whether it has enough to win the ones it does not expect to lose.

Bulldog14 didn't land any singular headline-grabbing steal, but eight values across the board tells a story of a manager who consistently let the draft come to them. The foundation is real: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give this roster a top-end that most teams in the Super Smash Bros division can't match, and Taylor himself slid nearly half a round past his ADP before Bulldog14 quietly claimed him. Brock Purdy fell almost two full rounds before being scooped at QB13, and while Herbert and Purdy project as QB8 and QB13 respectively, having two viable options at the position without overpaying for either reflects the same patient philosophy that ran through nearly every pick. The one blemish is Troy Franklin, a reach of more than four rounds that stands out in an otherwise disciplined draft. It's not enough to sink the ship, but it's the kind of swing that tends to look worse as the season wears on. At the 70th percentile, Bulldog14 has built something worth watching.

Incineroar didn't win the draft with one flashy swing, they just kept winning the individual battles, and the cumulative effect is a roster sitting at the 72nd percentile of the field. The backfield is the obvious foundation: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are both projected starters, and the depth behind them, Kyren Williams, David Montgomery, Bhayshul Tuten, and Jadarian Price, means this team should weather the attrition that always comes by November. Joe Burrow at QB4 adds another projected starter near the top of his position, and Dak Prescott at QB7 was the clearest draft win on the sheet, a legitimate starter who slipped nearly a full round past his ADP. The receiver group is thinner in projection, with Davante Adams the headliner at WR25, but the format is positionless and this roster's best players can carry the weight. Incineroar didn't need a lottery ticket. They just needed to not miss, and largely, they didn't.

Donkey Kong didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept making the right call, round after round, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits comfortably at the 77th percentile of the field. The foundation is real: Drake London at WR7, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Trey McBride at TE2 give this team a ceiling most managers would trade a kidney for. Jalen Hurts at QB9 adds another layer, though the offseason departure of AJ Brown to New England introduces genuine uncertainty around whether Hurts can sustain five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes without his best weapon. That's not a reason to panic, it's a reason to watch. Where Donkey Kong really separated itself was in the middle and late rounds, finding Bo Nix at QB15 when he fell past his ADP, and landing Mark Andrews at TE14 more than a round after the market expected. Five values against zero steals is the profile of a manager who doesn't need to gamble, because they read the board and let the draft come to them.

JesseReevesFS didn't build this roster with one splashy move. They built it by being right, over and over again. The receiver group is the clearest evidence: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, George Pickens at WR10, Chris Olave at WR11, Tee Higgins at WR19, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are all projected starters, and that collection didn't happen by accident. Olave was the one reach in that group, taken a full round early at 2.10, but the rest came at or past their ADP, including TreVeyon Henderson sliding nearly two rounds to 8.10 and Dallas Goedert falling over a round and a half to 10.10. That patience shows up in the overall draft profile: four values, thirteen chalk, and only two reaches across the whole board. The 2025 résumé backs the process, a 26-10 record that landed in the 91st percentile in scoring. Third in the Super Smash Bros division and 77th percentile tournament-wide, JesseReevesFS arrives in 2026 looking like a team that earned its spot.

There are clean drafts, and then there is what reedz put together in 2026. The headline is the wide receiver group: Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Rashee Rice at WR13 are all projected starters, and reedz stacked both Nacua with Matthew Stafford and Rice with Patrick Mahomes, doubling the ceiling on big-game explosions. Mahomes himself was a good value, slipping 1.7 rounds past his ADP to land in round seven. Derrick Henry at RB12 fell nearly a full round as well. The draft ledger reads one steal, four values, thirteen chalk picks, and just two minor reaches across the entire board, which is the kind of profile you see when a manager keeps their head while everyone else chases names. Coming off a 27-9 record and an 85th-percentile scoring season in 2025, reedz sits second in the Super Smash Bros division and in the 83rd percentile of the field. The discipline is not new here. It is just showing up again, on schedule.

ryanrichard04 sits first in the Super Smash Bros division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This was not a roster built on one spectacular swing but on a series of small edges that compounded round after round. James Cook arrived at pick 2.12 despite an ADP sitting nearly a full round earlier, and Trevor Lawrence fell all the way to 6.12 despite projecting as QB10, turning a late-round flier into genuine starter-caliber production. Josh Jacobs, projected at RB16, slipped more than a round past his ADP and landed at 7.01. Three players taken ahead of ADP, thirteen taken at fair value, and not a single major reach on the board. The weakest projected starter, Quentin Johnston at WR41, is a real name on a real roster, not a placeholder. When a manager builds like this, patient and disciplined without sacrificing upside, first place in the division tends to be less of a surprise and more of an inevitability.
