Despite getting marginally good value with Chris Godwin, their overall strategy has done little to improve their

standing, with questionable draft choices like Elijah Mitchell further compounding their woes. As they watch their tournament prospects dwindle in the 17th percentile, DrakeFantasy faces an uphill battle this season, struggling to escape the shadows of mediocrity.


