There is no charitable read available for MestreDan in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl, and the numbers make that case without much prodding. The draft tells the real story: four major reaches across the board, with three of them concentrated at tight end. Dalton Kincaid at TE11 cost a full 2.6 rounds of premium draft capital. Oronde Gadsden at TE16 cost another 2.8. Juwan Johnson at TE20 cost 2.3 more. That is three consecutive rounds of overpaying for players who combine to project as the TE11, TE16, and TE20, and in a positionless format where you play your best regardless of position, the opportunity cost of those misses ripples through every other decision on the board. The receiver group, led by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Chris Olave at WR11, is genuinely good, and it deserved better support than this draft gave it. Instead, MestreDan is sitting third in the Tele Sena division and in the 3rd percentile of the field, which is where rosters built on enthusiasm rather than discipline tend to land.

KauEdelman11 sits 11th in the Tele Sena division and projects in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason to expect a reversal of fortune. The roster's ceiling rests almost entirely on Josh Allen, a legitimate QB1, but after Allen the optimism dries up fast. Six minor reaches and a major reach on AJ Barner, taken 2.2 rounds before his ADP, suggest a manager who was chasing upside that the market had already priced out. Bryce Young projects as a QB26, which is a hard ask for a starting spot in any format. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Rashee Rice at WR13 are genuine contributors, but they represent islands of competence in a roster that grades average across the board at every other position. There is no late-round steal here, no hidden gem quietly humming along in the depth chart, nothing to suggest the projections have dramatically undervalued this group. Sometimes a roster just is what it is, and this one is a long climb from a bad starting position.

There is no diplomatic way to say this: FeBarbosa is in trouble. Sitting 10th in the Tele Sena division and projected at just the 17th percentile of the field, the roster's ceiling is simply too low to manufacture optimism from. The QB situation is the clearest symbol of the problem: Jordan Love checks in at QB17 and Cam Ward at QB23, which means FeBarbosa is essentially waiting on a miracle from a position that rarely delivers one. What makes this sting is the draft process that built it. Chris Godwin was taken nearly three full rounds before his ADP, and Khalil Shakir, the projected weakest starter on the roster, was grabbed almost four rounds early at WR51, a price that would have been steep for a WR11. Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine asset and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 gives the team a pulse, but those two bright spots cannot compensate for the reaches that consumed the middle rounds. FeBarbosa is not rebuilding toward something. It is simply hoping the projections are wrong.

There is no polite way to say this: dariocsilva enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Tele Sena division and in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The draft board tells part of the story. Three major reaches in a single draft is a meaningful hole in the foundation, and two of them arrived at the exact wrong moments. Pulling Jaylen Waddle at 4.01 when his ADP sat at 5.05 meant sacrificing premium equity early, and spending a seventh-round pick on Hunter Henry, a projected TE18, is the kind of decision that quietly bleeds a roster dry. Henry is also the projected weakest starter on this team, which means the cost was too high and the return is not enough. James Cook at RB5 is a genuine anchor and the WR trio of Waddle, Jameson Williams, and Zay Flowers projects to be competitive, but when your floor is set by a TE18 you overpaid for and your draft generated zero steals, the ceiling has a way of looking a lot lower than it should.

jperocco played the draft about as patiently as anyone in the Tele Sena division, collecting five steals and landing nearly every pick at or after ADP, and the reward for all that discipline is a team sitting eighth in the division and at just the 45th percentile of the field. The skeleton of the strategy is easy to read: load up on receivers at small premiums, then let the market bring the remaining positions to you. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Drake London at WR7 anchor a genuinely impressive top end, and Ladd McConkey, Luther Burden, Brian Thomas Jr., and Marvin Harrison Jr. round out a projected starting group that looks formidable on paper. The problem is that the players who were supposed to arrive cheaply and balance the roster simply did not. Trevor Lawrence fell to round 8, Jared Goff to round 10, and Bhayshul Tuten, the projected weakest starter at RB25, required a reach into round 11 just to

get there. jperocco did everything right by the numbers and still ended up with a team the projections treat as squarely mediocre, which is the specific kind of draft karma nobody talks about.

derickbd is a team built to nibble its way to a playoff spot rather than bludgeon anyone into submission, and in the Scott Fish Bowl's margins-decide-everything reality, that's either a perfectly calibrated strategy or a very slow way to finish seventh in the Tele Sena division. The bones are real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this roster a legitimate ceiling, and the draft showed genuine patience, with Jackson falling 1.2 rounds past his ADP and Matthew Stafford sliding all the way to a 9.05 pick despite projecting as QB14. That's the kind of quiet competence that builds rosters. The concern is that derickbd also reached nearly three rounds early for Travis Kelce, who projects as TE10, suggesting the manager panicked somewhere around pick four and decided to mortgage draft capital on a name rather than a value. A 2025 finish in the 16th percentile of scoring is the ghost haunting this whole exercise. The roster is better now, but "better" only cashes a check if Jordan Addison, the projected weakest starter, doesn't become the weekly ceiling killer he occasionally promises to be.

After a 2025 campaign that landed in the bottom 10 percent of the field in scoring, LucasdosAnjos enters 2026 looking like a genuinely different operation. The foundation is hard to argue with: Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Derrick Henry (RB12) anchor a backfield that projects among the best in the tournament, and Tyler Warren (TE4) paired with George Kittle (TE9) gives this roster an elite look at that position. The real intrigue, though, is the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack. Dart projects as QB11 and was a steal, falling three full rounds past his ADP, and Nabers, after a torn ACL wiped out his 2025 season, showed enough quick-twitch explosiveness in training camp to dodge the PUP list and watch his redraft value climb back toward his ceiling. If Nabers is a full-go and builds chemistry with Dart, this stack alone could turn last year's scoring disaster into something unrecognizable. The rebound is real, and the 67th percentile projection feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

SanLobera didn't need a headline moment to build something worth watching. The secret is in the pattern: Patrick Mahomes at QB12 fell nearly three and a half rounds past his ADP, Brock Purdy at QB13 fell more than three rounds, and David Montgomery at RB23 slipped nearly three rounds as well. That's not luck, that's a manager who kept their head while others chased names. Layer in Ja'Marr Chase projecting as WR2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchoring the top of the lineup, and the floor here is already higher than most teams in the Tele Sena division. The Purdy and Evans stack gives SanLobera a connected scoring upside that can erupt on any given week. Yes, the late-round wideout group thins out quickly past Mike Evans, and Parker Washington projects as the weakest projected starter at WR35, but the studs at the top of this roster carry enough weight to cover that. Fifth in the division feels conservative. This team finished 68th percentile in scoring a year ago and the draft just got better.

hellison999 landed at 75th percentile in this field and sits fourth in the Tele Sena division, and the draft sheet is a little uncomfortable to look at: three major reaches, three minor reaches, and only a handful of genuine values. The thing is, the roster does not care. Blake Corum cost three-plus rounds of premium, but Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 give this team a backfield foundation most managers in this tournament would trade for. The receiver group is thin on star power, with D.J. Moore at WR26 as the projected top option after hellison999 paid a round-and-a-half of draft equity to grab him early. But then Jalen Hurts fell nearly three-and-a-half rounds past his ADP, landing as a projected QB9 starter alongside Joe Burrow at QB4, and suddenly the draft chart looks less reckless and more like someone who knew exactly what they wanted and bet on the board to deliver the rest. Conviction or luck, the talent is real.

Markenhos came to the Scott Fish Bowl 2026 with a plan and executed it cleanly. The headline is a quarterback haul that looks almost unfair in hindsight: Dak Prescott, a QB7 projection, slid nearly five full rounds past his ADP before Markenhos scooped him at 8.05, and Geno Smith fell over four rounds to land at 18.05. That kind of patience at a position most managers either overpay for or ignore entirely is how you build structural advantages without burning premium capital. That capital instead went toward a receiving corps anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and A.J. Brown at WR8, both projected starters, both capable of carrying a lineup on their own. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Breece Hall at RB14 round out a starting core with genuine upside at every slot. The draft sheet shows three steals, three values, and zero major reaches, which is about as tidy as these boards get. Sitting third in the division and at the 76th percentile overall, Markenhos is not a team chasing its ceiling. It already found it.

rafaeltobarbosa didn't need a single flashy gamble to land at second in the Tele Sena division and the 77th percentile of the field. The foundation is genuinely difficult to argue with: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this roster a top-end that most managers would trade their best picks to acquire, and Puka Nacua at WR1 adds a projected starter who leads his position outright. What makes the draft quietly impressive, though, is the efficiency underneath those headliners. Caleb Williams fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed here at QB6, a starter-quality quarterback acquired at a meaningful discount. Bo Nix then fell three full rounds and came aboard at QB15, giving the roster a credible backup at a price that barely dented the capital. Fourteen chalk picks out of a full draft might sound unexciting, but chalk at the right spots is just another word for not blinking when the board hands you exactly what you came for. This team was built with patience, and the standings reflect it.

asalmeida79 didn't need a single lottery-ticket moment to build one of the stronger rosters in the Tele Sena division. This is a draft that simply kept coming out ahead, pick after pick. Brock Bowers dropped nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.03 as the TE1 in the field. Justin Herbert slid more than four rounds before asalmeida79 scooped him at 7.10, giving the team a QB8 at a price that would make most managers wince with envy. Jayden Daniels at QB5 adds genuine firepower to that pairing, and Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors a receiver group with real upside. Harold Fannin projects as TE6 and draws in as a starter alongside Bowers, meaning this team fields two tight ends who rank among the position's elite. The minor reaches scattered through the mid-rounds are a reasonable price to pay when the foundational pieces came in so far under market. First in the division, 92nd percentile overall, and it was not an accident.
