There is no charitable read available for Tikinho Seahawks, and the draft sheet does not lie. The manager posted zero steals and zero values across the entire board, nine chalk picks, and then compounded the damage with five major reaches and five minor ones, a demolition-derby approach to draft capital that left the roster looking like someone panic-bought every player they were afraid of missing. The most glaring wounds are at the tight end position, where Mark Andrews came off the board at 6.01 despite an ADP of 8.12, and Elijah Arroyo was seized at 18.01 when his ADP sat at 22.08, bleeding a combined seven-plus rounds of surplus value into a position group that projects Andrews at TE14 and Arroyo at TE40. Meanwhile, the RB situation is thin enough to matter in a positionless format, with James Cook projecting as RB5 and Jaylen Warren as RB27, while Emmett Johnson sits at RB54 and was somehow taken 3.2 rounds before his ADP suggested anyone needed to worry. The Seahawks

finished in the 81st percentile in 2025 scoring. The 2026 projection has them parked at 2nd percentile. That is not a regression, that is a collapse, and this draft is the reason why.

Washington Denzell sits 11th in the Tigrinho division and in the eighth percentile of the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. Six major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and that philosophy cost this roster dearly. Chris Brazzell II, a WR101, was taken more than eight rounds before his ADP. Elijah Sarratt, a WR98, went nearly five rounds early. Ja'Kobi Lane, a WR89, went three rounds early. The returns on those gambles are projected to be almost nothing, which means Washington Denzell burned the late rounds chasing names that are not coming through. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is genuinely elite, and Harold Fannin at TE6 offers real upside if the Browns offense takes any step forward, but both men are surrounded by a supporting cast built on optimism that the market had already priced out. The best quarterback on this roster is Bo Nix at QB15. Denzell is not unlucky. Denzell reached, repeatedly and enthusiastically, and the standings will reflect it.

There is something genuinely sad about watching a team wear its 2025 reputation like a badge it no longer quite earned. FelipeFelix went 30-6 last season, scored in the 88th percentile, and arrived at the 2026 draft carrying that credibility into a room where it apparently did more harm than good. The headline asset, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Malik Nabers at WR12, is real, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 keeps the ceiling honest, but McMillan was a major reach at pick 2.02 against an ADP of 4.04, which means FelipeFelix paid a round-and-a-half premium for a player they could have had considerably later. That pattern compounds. T.J. Hockenson, taken two rounds early, is now a TE23 showing the market already had doubts. Meanwhile, KC Concepcion landed in Cleveland, a franchise still sorting out its quarterback situation, making that WR50 projection feel like the floor, not the ceiling. The result is an 11th-percentile tournament projection and a division rank of 10, a long, uncomfortable fall from a team that, just one year ago, looked like it knew what it was doing.

Butt Fumble did almost everything right and still landed in the 17th percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole enterprise. Puka Nacua fell to WR1 at pick 1.05, Oronde Gadsden slid nearly two rounds to become a projected starter at TE16, and Sam Darnold arrived three and a half rounds late at QB21. The value was real. The problem is that value only matters when the players attached to it are good enough, and a roster projecting ninth in the Tigrinho division suggests this one is not. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Nacua, Chris Olave, Rashee Rice, and Luther Burden all projecting as starters, but the rest of the lineup keeps cashing bad checks. Darnold at QB21 is the floor, not the ceiling, at a position where the ceiling barely clears the doorframe. Getting price right and still finishing here is not a draft failure, exactly. It is something worse: confirmation that the prices were fair.

ShazamCarai sits at 45th percentile heading into 2026, which is exactly as comfortable and uncomfortable as it sounds. The roster is built around a legitimate star in Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and a strong supporting cast of wide receivers, but the margins that determine a 56-win season from a 45-win season live in the draft decisions at the edges. Pulling Lamar Jackson (QB3) at pick 5.01 when his ADP sat at 2.03 was the kind of patient opportunism that wins leagues quietly, and stacking the receiver depth with Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) at or past their ADPs gives the lineup real options. What cuts the other way is the Sam LaPorta reach, taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP at 3.01, a price that constrains the early-round foundation. C.J. Stroud projects as the weakest projected starter at QB22, and in a field this competitive, that position matters when Chase has a quiet week. Nobody fears this team on sight. Nobody dismisses it either. The season lives in the gap between those two things.

Beetinho enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Tigrinho division and right around the tournament median, which is a polite way of saying the floor and the ceiling are uncomfortably close together. The top of the roster has real names: Drake Maye projects as a QB2, Ashton Jeanty as an RB7, and Trey McBride as a TE2, so this is not a team without assets. The problem is the draft board tells a discouraging story about how those assets were assembled around. Beetinho reached three rounds early on Tyjae Spears, a projected RB47, and four rounds early on Dontayvion Wicks, a projected WR96. Those are not aggressive bets, those are spots where the market was sending a clear message and the manager talked himself out of listening. The receiver group grades weak, and the best available names there, Jordyn Tyson and Parker Washington, project at WR34 and WR35. Maye and McBride keep the lights on, but a team with three major reaches on its ledger and no steals has already spent the goodwill it needed to compete.

Fabeta did not build this roster with one bold swing. They built it by consistently finding players after the rest of the room had moved on. Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection, slid to pick 5.10 when his ADP put him nearly three rounds earlier, and Fabeta was there. D'Andre Swift, projected RB24, fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed the same way. Those are not lottery tickets, they are real starters acquired at a discount, and they stack neatly alongside a receiver corps anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and a tight end room where Colston Loveland projects as TE3. The Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds a correlation bonus that could spike the ceiling on a good week. Six in the Tigrinho division and 60th percentile in the field are fine starting points for a team that projects to have more upside than those numbers suggest. The draft was not flashy. It was just frequently right.

TorontoSupersonics finished 2025 in the 18th percentile and came back swinging, which is either the sign of a manager who learned something or one who got very lucky with a stubborn draft board. The evidence leans toward the former. Four major reaches dot this draft sheet, and yet the roster that emerged sits at the 61st percentile in the field, built around a core that is genuinely difficult to argue with. Kyle Pitts, taken 2.4 rounds early at TE7, and Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchor a squad that has real upside at the top. Joe Burrow fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP and landed here as a QB4, which is the kind of gift that makes aggressive drafting look retroactively brilliant. The one thread worth pulling is Jalen Hurts, a projected QB9 who now faces his first season without AJ Brown, raising real questions about whether five consecutive top-10 finishes become six or quietly stall. The reaches did not sink this team. Whether the conviction behind them holds is what 2026 will actually answer.

lorenzo came to the Scott Fish Bowl 2026 with a plan and executed it cleanly. The steals alone tell the story: Justin Herbert at QB8 didn't come off the board until 6.05 despite an ADP of 3.09, and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 followed at 7.08 against an ADP of 5.08, meaning lorenzo landed two legitimate starting-caliber quarterbacks at a combined discount of nearly five rounds. That kind of board management doesn't happen by accident. The foundation underneath those picks is equally sound, with Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchoring a lineup that finished in the 96th percentile in scoring in 2025, and Drake London at WR7 and George Kittle at TE9 rounding out a starting core that is genuinely hard to attack. Across the whole draft, lorenzo logged two steals, five values, and zero major reaches. That is a disciplined process producing a clean outcome, and at the 83rd tournament percentile heading into 2026, the results back it up.

Rui sits at 86th percentile in the field and third in the Tigrinho division, and looking at this roster, the ranking feels almost conservative. The foundation is immaculate: Brock Bowers at TE1, Jeremiyah Love at RB13, Breece Hall at RB14, and Nico Collins at WR9 give this team a starting core that most managers would trade their best picks to assemble. What separates Rui from a merely talented team is the discipline behind the construction. Seven picks landed as values or better against ADP, with Jaxson Dart sliding to QB11 nearly three full rounds past his consensus price and Josh Jacobs arriving at RB16 well after the market expected him to go. The one legitimate question is Brock Purdy, a projected QB13 whose weapons in San Francisco carry more uncertainty than a weather forecast, but Dart and Baker Mayfield are both waiting in reserve. The weakest projected starter is RJ Harvey at RB28. That is the complaint. One player at RB28. This roster was built with intention, and it shows.

Atalaia Danoneiros sits second in the Tigrinho division and in the 93rd percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why. The manager extracted real value across the board, landing De'Von Achane at RB6 a full round after his ADP, Omarion Hampton at RB9 a round and change late, and David Montgomery at RB23 at a steep discount too. That is three high-upside contributors acquired below market price, which is how clean drafts are built. At the top, Josh Allen anchors the lineup as QB1, and the Dak Prescott and George Pickens stack layers genuine upside on top of already reliable production, with Prescott falling two full rounds past his ADP. The four minor reaches, including Pickens himself taken just over half a round early, are the kind of controlled aggression that reflects conviction rather than recklessness. There are no major reaches anywhere on this roster. With a 90th percentile scoring season already on the books from 2025, Atalaia Danoneiros does not look like a team chasing something. It looks like a team that already knows how to find it.

There are clean drafts, and then there are statements. vbacchin made a statement. The foundation starts at the top: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchor a roster that would make most managers weep quietly into their draft sheets, and Taylor himself was a steal, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP before vbacchin quietly scooped him up at 2.09. Then came the quarterback market, where the board handed over Caleb Williams at QB6 more than three rounds late and Matthew Stafford at QB14 more than two and a half rounds late, the latter arriving pre-stacked with Davante Adams at WR25. Three steals, two values, zero major reaches across the entire draft, and a division rank of first with a tournament percentile in the 99th. The floor here is high, the ceiling is higher, and the construction shows the kind of patience and board awareness that separates a real contender from someone who just got lucky. vbacchin did not get lucky.
