Jordan Addison, Cooper Kupp, and Rashod Bateman form a trio that leaves much to be desired, each struggling to crack even the top 30. On the ground game front, things are no rosier with Jaydon Blue—the weakest among them—being a projected starter alongside an underwhelming mix of James Cook, Brian Robinson, and Rhamondre Stevenson. While their tight ends remain the shining beacon of hope,

even possessing the best in the division might not be enough to salvage the season. George Kittle, T.J. Hockenson, and Sam LaPorta will need to carry a heavier load than ever as this team languishes at 12th place in their division and sits in the dispiriting 2nd percentile overall. Drafting missteps and an inability to capitalize on past successes have left Jonnytiz staring into the abyss, with visions of glory all but extinguished.
