As the 2025 season looms, SteveyH6 faces a daunting challenge after last year's impressive high point. Despite riding high in 2024 with a stellar 91 percentile finish and an 83% winning rate, this year promises to be a struggle. The team is already languishing at the bottom of the division rankings, holding the 12th spot, and sitting in the dismal 11th percentile overall. While the running back corps remains the squad's strongest asset, featuring stalwarts like Jahmyr Gibbs and Derrick Henry, the wide receiver lineup is far from competitive, ranked ninth in the division. Rashid Shaheed, a projected starter, is particularly concerning as the weakest link in the team. The questionable draft strategy hasn't helped either; reaching significantly for players like Jake Ferguson could haunt them as the season progresses. While they found some value late in the draft with Cooper Kupp, their decisions elsewhere, such as Tua Tagovailoa drafted well ahead of expectation, could spell trouble.

With a rocky road ahead, SteveyH6 might find that the heights of last year are out of reach, as they struggle to find footing in both the division and overall standings.

Even the small stack bonus derived from Caleb Williams and Tyler Warren can't mask the sense of impending doom that envelops this team, as they brace for yet another challenging and tumultuous season.
