There is a version of this draft that looks defensible from a distance, and then you check the reach log and the distance closes fast. Elchinocobos sits third in the division and in the third percentile of the field, and the draft record explains both numbers: five major reaches, zero steals, and a board that was consistently misread in the wrong direction. The most damaging example is Bucky Irving, taken 3.8 rounds before his ADP for a player projected at RB21, which is fine value at the right price and a ruinous overpay at the wrong one. Emeka Egbuka lands at WR18 after being drafted two full rounds early, and Elic Ayomanor, a WR95, was plucked six rounds before the market got there, which is the kind of swing that only looks smart if the player becomes something he currently is not projected to be. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the one number that stays clean, but one anchor cannot hold a roster that spent its middle rounds in a bidding war with itself.

JohnHampton sits 11th in the Tecmo Bowl division and in the 18th tournament percentile, and the draft sheet explains most of why. The roster produced zero steals and just one genuine value, while logging two major reaches that will haunt the margins all season. Matthew Stafford, taken nearly a round and a half early at pick 4.09, projects as only QB14, the kind of investment that makes sense if the return is a top-five finish at the position, not a mid-tier one. The other major reach, Tyquan Thornton at WR97, is essentially a roster filler taken three rounds ahead of schedule. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a legitimate anchor, and George Pickens at WR10 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give the lineup a few real weapons, but past that trio the drop-off is steep and unforgiving. Josh Downs projects as the weakest starter at WR46, a number that tells you exactly how little runway is left. Last season's 39 percent win rate was not a fluke, and nothing in this construction suggests the trajectory is changing.

Last year, @CLEGreene won 72 percent of their matchups and scored in the 92nd percentile of the tournament. Whatever they learned from that, they apparently unlearned all of it. The 2026 draft produced zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and five reaches, three of them major. Travis Kelce, projected TE10, was pulled 2.2 rounds early in round five, an aggressive price for a tight end who no longer profiles as an elite fantasy asset. Aaron Rodgers, projected QB29, was snatched at 11.02 despite an ADP of 13.12, which means @CLEGreene burned a mid-draft pick to secure the 29th-best quarterback. Rashod Bateman, projected WR92, was taken 3.5 rounds ahead of his market value, which is a remarkable commitment to a player most managers wouldn't feel urgency about in round 20. Patrick Mahomes stacking with Kelce provides some structure, but Mahomes himself was a minor reach at QB12, and the surrounding receiver group is thin enough that the stack may have nowhere

to land. This roster sits 10th in the division and in the 28th percentile of the field, and the draft ledger explains exactly why.

Last year, swigs77 ran through the Scott Fish Bowl like a house on fire, posting a 26-10 record and landing in the 93rd percentile of scoring. The 2026 version of this roster is asking you to trust that the fire is still there, but the smoke signals are faint. Josh Allen is the real anchor here, a genuine QB1, and the Tyler Shough / Chris Olave stack gives the team a legitimate secondary engine if Shough develops into his projection. But the draft process raises questions about whether swigs77 is building or coasting on reputation. Twelve chalk picks in a single draft is a lot of deference to consensus, and the one major reach on Omarion Hampton, taken nearly a full round early at RB9, suggests the manager chased the 2025 feeling rather than 2026 value. The tournament projection lands at the 46th percentile, roughly the dividing line between relevant and forgettable, and the division ranking of eighth compounds the concern. Reputation is a comfortable place to live until the standings prove otherwise.

Bo Knows Tecmo did almost everything right on draft day. Fourteen picks at chalk, three genuine values including Jayden Daniels falling nearly a full round past his ADP, and only two minor reaches on a roster that otherwise cost exactly what the market demanded. The cruelty is that the market, in this case, sold them a lopsided bill of goods. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, De'Von Achane at RB6, Derrick Henry at RB12, and a half-dozen more backs running behind them is an impressive collection of talent, and in a positionless format that talent is real. But when the best receiver on the roster is Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, and the format requires filling ten starting spots, even Taylor and Achane cannot carry the math alone. Kyle Pitts at TE7 helps, and the quarterback situation with Daniels is genuinely strong, but value is only as good as the floor it props up. Bo Knows Tecmo bought the groceries at discount prices and still came home without enough to make dinner.

The Original Cheat Code sits at 47th percentile and seventh in the division, which tells you everything about what this season requires: not a tear-down, not a coronation, just execution on the margins. The foundation is real. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Colston Loveland lands at TE3, and Justin Herbert comes in at QB8, all three slotted as starters and all three arriving at reasonable draft cost after Herbert fell a full round past his ADP. The concern is the tier immediately below that top line. Tucker Kraft is the most interesting variable here. He was pacing for 1,000 yards before an ACL ended his 2025 season, came off the preseason PUP list before August, and steps back into a Packers offense that lost more receivers than it added, which sets up a return to a starring role if he can recapture his pre-injury form. That is a significant if, and it lands squarely in the margin column. A healthy Kraft pushing toward his TE5 projection alongside Nacua and Loveland gives this team a puncher's chance. A Kraft who is still rounding back into form and this roster quietly becomes a spectator by October.

zdhaugen sits at the tournament's exact midpoint, 49th percentile, sixth in the Tecmo Bowl division, and the roster reads exactly like that number feels. The ceiling is real: Brock Bowers at TE1, Nico Collins at WR9, and Jalen Hurts as a QB9 who slipped to zdhaugen five picks later than his ADP suggested, that is genuine top-end value. But the margins that will decide this season live further down the board. Michael Pittman, the projected weakest starter at WR44, now finds himself in Pittsburgh catching passes from Aaron Rodgers at 43 years old, on an offense still searching for an identity under a new coaching staff. That is not a situation that inspires confidence in the final lineup spot. Garrett Wilson was taken 1.3 rounds ahead of his ADP at WR17, so the projected production there needs to materialize to justify the cost. Nothing about this roster screams disaster, and nothing screams contender. It is a team that wins when everything breaks right and quietly disappears when it does not.

G.A.T.Z. didn't build this roster by swinging for the fences on one marquee moment. They built it pick by pick, and the results speak quietly but clearly. Landing Lamar Jackson at 3.08 when his ADP sat at 2.03 is the kind of thing that looks like luck until you realize the manager was simply willing to wait while the rest of the room panicked. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchor a backfield corps that gives this team a high floor on almost any given week. The receiver group is more of a managed risk than a guarantee, and Rashee Rice is the clearest example of that: if he gets through his legal situation, shakes off the knee procedure, and stays healthy, he's a genuine difference-maker at WR13. If he doesn't, that projection evaporates fast. Still, a 64 percent win rate last season and a 65th percentile tournament projection suggest this is a team that simply does things right more often than not.

The_Dude_Hudson arrives in the Tecmo Bowl division sitting at 70th percentile in the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: nineteen chalk picks, zero steals, and almost nothing reached. That sounds like a roster built on restraint until you realize the chalk includes CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchoring the top of the lineup, with Harold Fannin at TE6 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 giving the team a tier of tight end production most managers can't touch. Dak Prescott slots in as a QB7 with a ready-made connection to Lamb already baked in as a stack, which only sweetens the foundation. The one genuine question mark is Brian Thomas Jr., a WR31 projection who has to prove that his 2025 injuries and a shaky rapport with Trevor Lawrence are behind him rather than a new baseline. Hudson's 2026 outlook is less about any single brilliant move and more about a draft that found no bad beats, just correct answers at nearly every turn.

taxmandyno didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by showing up to work on every round. The receiver group is the clearest evidence: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, Malik Nabers at WR12, Jameson Williams at WR21, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 all project as starters, and Waddle himself came at a genuine discount, sliding more than a round past his ADP to land at 6.07. That kind of patient accumulation at the top end of the position is how you build a team that doesn't need to get lucky in the right week. The draft chart backs it up: 17 picks at chalk value, one minor reach in Braelon Allen, and zero blown swings. Third in the Tecmo Bowl division and sitting at the 77th percentile of the field, taxmandyno arrives in 2026 looking like a team that understood exactly what it was doing, pick after pick, round after round.

GemmaMartinez didn't make one transcendent move and then coast. This draft was built pick by pick, and the cumulative edge is real. The clearest example is Drake Maye, a QB2 projection snagged nearly two full rounds after his ADP, and the stack with A.J. Brown makes that value compound in a hurry. Brown landed in New England via trade this offseason, and the pairing of his talent with Maye's arm, fresh off an MVP runner-up season, gives this team a ceiling that most managers in the Tecmo Bowl division would envy. Trey McBride at TE2 anchors the lineup as one of the most reliable starters in the field. Meanwhile, four wide receivers in Zay Flowers, Terry McLaurin, Rome Odunze, and Jakobi Meyers all project as starters, with Meyers himself arriving as a late-round value. GemmaMartinez sits second in the division and in the 80th tournament percentile, and nothing about this roster looks like luck. It looks like a manager who kept winning small battles and let the math do the rest.

Touchdown! Bo Jackson sits atop the Tecmo Bowl division and in the 95th percentile of the entire field, and nothing about this roster invites argument. The draft was a masterclass in patience rewarded: Joe Burrow, a QB4, slid a full round and a third past his ADP before this team quietly scooped him up in the third round, and Jadarian Price fell two complete rounds to become one of the cleanest late-round wins in the tournament. Pair Burrow with a receiving corps anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and DeVonta Smith at WR14, both projected starters, and the top of this lineup looks like a finished painting. The backfield is equally composed, with James Cook at RB5 and Breece Hall at RB14 giving the team a foundation that most managers would trade their best pick to own. Even the Kyler Murray situation, complicated as it is after a lisfranc injury derailed his Arizona tenure, carries upside if he wins the Vikings job outright. Fifteen chalk picks, two steals, zero reaches. The process was immaculate.
