NoDakSota drafted like someone who showed up with a very specific shopping list and refused to deviate from it regardless of price. The QB situation tells the whole story: Drake Maye at QB2 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 are both legitimate starters, but Maye was yanked 0.7 rounds before his market price and Hurts a full 1.4 rounds early, meaning NoDakSota paid a premium twice over at a position that only starts once. Sam LaPorta, a TE8, cost 2.6 rounds of overpay in round three. That is three of the team's four major reaches concentrated at positions where the format offers essentially no multiplier on value. The receiver group, where the real scoring upside lives in a positionless format, is anchored by Tee Higgins at WR19 and gets thin quickly, with Calvin Ridley at WR78 somehow getting drafted 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule as a late consolation prize. Coming off a 2025 that placed them in the first percentile of scoring, NoDakSota has not course-corrected so much as redecorated.

Rum Ham United arrives in Tecmo Bowl 2 carrying the quiet desperation of a team that drafted its way into a corner. The roster sits at the 5th percentile tournament-wide, and the draft tendencies explain a lot: four major reaches, including Travis Etienne taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP and MarShawn Lloyd grabbed a staggering 5.7 rounds early, which means the manager was consistently surrendering future value to chase players who weren't worth the price. The top end is real, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 give this team a pulse, and Jefferson was actually a genuine value at 2.04. But the depth behind them grades out poorly, with projected starters like Romeo Doubs sitting at WR53, and the tight end room tops out at AJ Barner at TE24. A 58 percent win rate last season suggests this roster is capable of treading water, but the 2026 projection has them ranked 11th in the division, and there is no obvious move left to make up that ground.

There is no polite way to dress this up: examiners1 enters 2026 sitting 10th in Tecmo Bowl 2 and in just the 17th percentile of the field, and the roster does not suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The headliners are real, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give the team a legitimate foundation, but the gap between those two and the rest of the projected starters is steep and unforgiving. The QB room is where the draft went sideways, Bo Nix was pulled at pick 4.08 against an ADP of 6.03, a 1.6-round reach for a player projecting as QB15, and Kyler Murray came off the board nearly two rounds early as well. In a format where roster quality compounds across every matchup, burning early capital on QB15 and QB19 when the field was still loaded is the kind of decision that reverberates all season. Nix stacks with Jaylen Waddle, which helps, but this team looks like it is already playing from behind before a single snap is taken.

There is no flattering angle here. Jester388 sits ninth in Tecmo Bowl 2 and in the 31st percentile of the field, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might rescue a team from those numbers: zero steals on a 19-round board, and the most notable draft-room decision was spending a fourth-round pick on Mason Taylor, a TE35 who did not need to be secured four rounds ahead of schedule. The top of the roster is real, Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as WR3 and James Cook as RB5, but Carnell Tate, the WR29, is essentially betting that a new quarterback-receiver pairing in Tennessee clicks immediately, which is a lot to ask of a player who needs to carry lineup weight. The team that went 11-25 last season and scored in the 25th percentile did not overhaul itself enough to expect a different result. Sometimes a roster simply grades out near the bottom, and no amount of squinting at the back end changes that.

awkwardtastical enters 2026 sitting eighth in Tecmo Bowl 2 and hovering around the 43rd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The QB situation looks fine on paper, with Jayden Daniels projected at QB5 and Justin Herbert at QB8, but Herbert's upside is genuinely capped: Jim Harbaugh has turned the Chargers into a ball-control operation, Herbert's pass attempts have been sliding for years, and even the arrival of Mike McDaniel cannot fully fix a quarterback with just 15 career rushing scores to his name. Daniels required a major reach at 1.12 to land, a full round ahead of his ADP, so the cost of that QB room was steep. Beyond those two, the supporting cast grades out as average at best, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 providing a genuine anchor but the rest of the projected starters, including Hunter Henry at TE18, the team's weakest projected starter, offering little separation from the field. A 50 percent win rate and 40th-percentile scoring in 2025 was not a foundation, it was a warning.

Run CMC sits at the 51st percentile, seventh in the division, and that's exactly where the roster lives: a team built on a genuinely impressive top end that runs out of steam before it runs out of roster spots. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 are the kind of foundational pieces that win leagues, and the Brock Purdy / George Kittle stack gives this team a ceiling most managers at this level can't match, especially with Dallas Goedert, who quietly posted four touchdowns in a three-week playoff stretch last season, lined up behind Kittle as a secondary option. The problem is the margins. The draft leaned heavy on chalk with three major reaches, including Purdy taken nearly two rounds early and Jaxson Dart a round and a half ahead of consensus. When the top of the lineup hums, this team beats most of the field. When McCaffrey or Taylor has an off week and the receiver depth thins out past Davante Adams and Christian Watson, there's not much cushion. The margins decide this one, and right now they're a coin flip.

Called Play arrived at this draft with something to prove after an 11th-percentile scoring finish in 2025, and the board suggests they drafted like it. Zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and two major reaches, which is not the profile of a team threading needles. Yet the needle got threaded. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors a lineup that also projects Colston Loveland at TE3, and the Caleb Williams-Loveland stack gives this roster a genuine ceiling play when the stars align. The reaches are the interesting part. Rhamondre Stevenson was taken 2.4 rounds early and projects as the weakest starter on the roster, which is the reach that looks most like a tax. Chris Brazzell II was taken nearly seven rounds early at WR101, which looks either visionary or reckless depending on how the season unfolds. Sitting at 55th percentile and sixth in the division, Called Play is not a favorite, but this is a roster that was built with conviction, and conviction sometimes covers a multitude of draft-capital sins.

Superflex Tecmo Bowl sits at 67th percentile in the field and fifth in the division, which sounds modest until you look at who they actually have. Josh Allen at QB1, De'Von Achane at RB6, Saquon Barkley at RB8, Kyren Williams at RB15, and Matthew Stafford coming off a career-high touchdown season and a narrow MVP win at QB14, still effective even as the Rams groom his replacement. That is a genuinely elite top end, assembled in a draft where the board said this manager was reaching constantly: three major reaches, two minor ones, and not a single steal. Jacory Croskey-Merritt was taken 2.7 rounds early, Kaytron Allen nearly 3.5 rounds early, James Conner 2.7 rounds early. Every one of those moves looked desperate in the moment. The roster, sitting at 67th percentile, suggests most of them landed. Whether that is a sharp drafter trusting their own board or someone who got away with it is genuinely hard to separate, and that ambiguity is exactly what makes this team interesting.

pjhofe07 sits at 80th percentile in the field and fourth in Tecmo Bowl 2, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The receiver group is the centerpiece, a projected WR8 in A.J. Brown, a WR10 in George Pickens, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, all starters, all taken at or past their ADPs. That discipline carried through the back end of the draft too, where Tucker Kraft fell two full rounds past his ADP and landed as a TE5, and Marvin Harrison Jr. slipped to the ninth round despite projecting at WR33. Five values and two steals across the board is not an accident, it is a manager who knew what things were worth and waited. The one real blemish is Malachi Fields, taken nearly five rounds ahead of schedule at WR90. The one real question is Cam Ward, the projected QB23, who now has Carnell Tate and Wan'Dale Robinson running routes in Tennessee and considerably less runway for excuses. One soft spot does not undo a draft this clean.

Tecmo Bow did not build this roster on one bold gamble. They built it pick by pick, round by round, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 81st percentile with a receiving corps that would make most managers quietly close their laptop in defeat. Drake London at WR7, Nico Collins at WR9, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 are all projected starters, and London himself came as a value, slipping past his ADP to land at 2.10. Brock Bowers at TE1 was the one place Tecmo Bow paid a slight premium, going a few spots early at 1.03, but when the asset you are reaching for is the top tight end in the field, that is less a mistake than a statement of intent. The 2025 line, 72 percent wins and a 79th-percentile scoring mark, confirms this manager knows how to convert a well-drafted roster into actual results. Third in the division right now, but the construction here says that number should move.

Scott Fishbone Offense arrived at 84th percentile with a roster that looks like it was built by someone who simply refused to take no for an answer. The board fought them repeatedly, and they reached anyway, and somehow it worked. The clearest evidence is the receiving corps: CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Chris Olave at WR11, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are all projected starters, and Lamb himself was a genuine value, falling half a round past his ADP before this team pounced. Then there is the tight end group, where Trey McBride at TE2, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Travis Kelce at TE10 form a positional concentration that most managers would envy. The reaches came in the back half of the draft, where Ray Davis and Demond Claiborne were taken more than three rounds early apiece, gambles that either signal deep conviction or inspired recklessness. Alec Pierce, a projected starter at WR32, adds one more layer of uncertainty given his PUP list status and ankle recovery. This

team is legitimately good. Whether the manager is a genius or just lucky is the question Tecmo Bowl 2 gets to answer.

Last year was ugly. DrKJMurray finished in the 18th percentile in scoring, a forgettable 11-25 slog that left little to celebrate in Tecmo Bowl 2. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Puka Nacua at WR1 give this team a ceiling most managers in the field can only envy, and the draft discipline that assembled them is worth noting: Nacua slid half a round past his ADP, Harold Fannin came half a round late at TE6, and Dak Prescott fell nearly a full round before DrKJMurray scooped him up at QB7. Six values on one draft board is not luck, it is patience rewarded. Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Cam Skattebo at RB20 anchor a backfield with genuine upside, and the team currently projects first in the division and into the 97th percentile of the entire field. After what 2025 looked like, that number is not just a projection, it is a statement.
