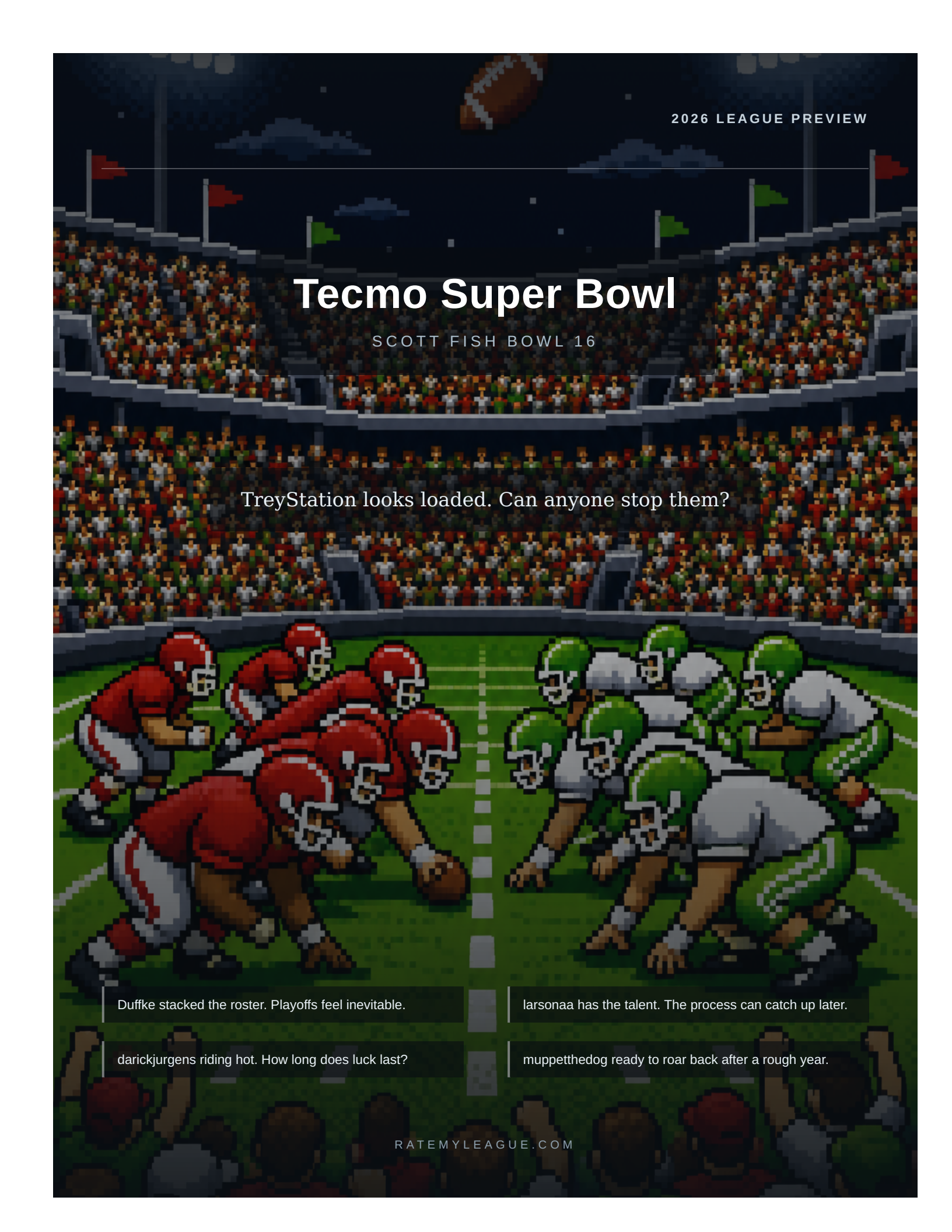

There is no painless way to say this: mdfields27 is sitting at the bottom of the Tecmo Super Bowl division and projects in just the 6th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record does not offer much hope for a turnaround. Four major reaches dot this roster, and the most damaging may be RJ Harvey, grabbed more than three rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 6.12. Harvey spent last season trailing veteran Javonte Williams in Denver's backfield, and now the Broncos added another competitor to the mix, leaving Harvey's path to meaningful touches genuinely unclear. Rhamondre Stevenson grades out as the projected weakest starter, which tells you something about the depth of the problem below the top of the lineup. Josh Allen at QB1 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give mdfields27 a real ceiling, but in a positionless format where roster quality across all playable spots determines outcomes, leaning on two stars while the rest of the roster grades out this thin is less a strategy than a prayer.

There is no sugarcoating what the numbers say about forno08 in 2026: this roster sits 11th in the Tecmo Super Bowl division and in the bottom 10 percent of the entire field, and the draft did nothing to change the trajectory. The manager overpaid at every turn, producing zero steals and zero values across the entire draft while reaching on 18 of 20 picks. The most damning example is Kenneth Walker III, a WR10 projection grabbed nearly a full round and a half early, a price tag that forecloses the kind of surplus value that bottom-tier rosters desperately need to climb. Joe Burrow projects as a QB4 and Chris Olave checks in at WR11, so the ceiling exists in flashes, but those names carry the whole operation on their backs while Tony Pollard, the projected weakest starter, grades out at RB30. A 39th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 offered a warning, and this offseason only confirmed it: there is no cavalry coming, and forno08 looks like a team already out of answers before the season begins.

The Wyoming Rattlers drafted like someone who made up their mind before the board was even set, and the results are sitting there in the data like a confession. The most damning evidence: Patrick Mahomes and Bo Nix cost this team third-round and fourth-round capital in a positionless format where quarterback scarcity simply does not exist at that price. Mahomes came off the board 1.7 rounds early at QB12, and then, almost immediately, Nix followed at QB15 with a 2.2-round premium attached to him. That is two premium picks spent manufacturing a position that did not need manufacturing, and the rest of the roster absorbed the damage. Pat Bryant landed at WR86 after a 3.6-round reach, the single ugliest number on this sheet. The Rattlers finished 56th percentile in scoring in 2025 and are projected 11th percentile in the tournament now, which is what happens when a draft plan becomes a liability. There is no favorable angle here. The Rattlers reached, overpaid, and landed somewhere near the bottom of the Tecmo Super Bowl division for their trouble.

There is no polite way to say this: PunkerDad is sitting at 26th percentile and ninth in the Tecmo Super Bowl division, and the roster does not hide why. The draft was almost entirely chalk, with zero steals and two major reaches headlining the haul. Drake Maye going in the first round is defensible on talent, but PunkerDad paid a QB2 price for a player being drafted nearly a full round ahead of consensus, and the Maye / A.J. Brown stack only pays off if both are healthy and clicking, which is a lot of faith to anchor a season to. Brown grades out at WR8 and is legitimately dangerous, but after him and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, the receiving corps gets thin fast, with Romeo Doubs at WR53 as the next option. The projected lineup is decent without ever being scary, and the weakest projected starter is Rico Dowdle at RB32, which tells the whole story: this team is built around a competent middle, not a dominant top end, and in a field like this, competent middle tends to go home early.

Last year darickjurgens finished in the 97th percentile of scoring, and the 2026 roster feels like someone handed that trophy to a different team. The receiver group is genuinely elite, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and CeeDee Lamb (WR5) anchoring a starting core that few managers in the field can match, and Lamb arriving as real draft value at pick 2.04 only sharpens the case. But the structure underneath that ceiling is shaky. Three major reaches in the draft, including Jameson Williams at WR21 pulled more than a round before his ADP and James Conner at RB56 grabbed nearly four rounds early, suggest a manager who was drafting his preferences rather than the board. The result is a team projected 8th in the Tecmo Super Bowl division and in the 36th percentile of the tournament, a long way from where that 2025 résumé would have you expect. St. Brown and Lamb are real. The gap between what this team was and what it currently projects to be is just as real.

Marcasg finished 2026's preview season the same way it ended 2025: near the bottom, with a 41st-percentile roster and no obvious path to climbing out. The draft did not help matters. Of 19 picks with a meaningful ADP comparison, marcasg logged zero steals, and the two genuine values were late-round fliers in Omar Cooper Jr. and Zachariah Branch, a pair of WR60-and-below dart throws that are not going to move the needle. Meanwhile, the damage was done earlier, where Josh Jacobs was taken 1.6 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 4.05 and Tyler Allgeier was grabbed a full three rounds early at pick 12.05. Allgeier projects as RB46, which means marcasg spent premium draft capital on a player who grades out as barely startable. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 are real, but they need support, and right now this roster is asking two stars to carry a sled with a cracked runner.

natemarcum didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. He won it by being right more often than he was wrong, and the numbers back that up. Four values against zero steals tells the story of a manager who let the board come to him rather than forcing anything. The headliners are legitimately good: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster a ceiling most teams in the Tecmo Super Bowl division can't touch. But the quieter wins matter just as much. Chase Brown fell a full round past his ADP and landed as the RB11. Tucker Kraft slid nearly two rounds and projects as a TE5 sitting behind Bowers with real lineup flexibility. The 2025 result, 36 percent wins and 28th percentile scoring, is a number worth acknowledging, but a roster this consistently assembled suggests the foundation was shakier then than it is now. Sitting sixth in the division at the 61st percentile, natemarcum isn't the favorite, but this team belongs in the conversation.

Last year was rough for muppetthedog, a bottom-17-percent scoring effort that left little to celebrate when the final whistle blew on 2025. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine course correction. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as the overall RB1, and pairing him with Jeremiyah Love (RB13) and Cam Skattebo (RB20) gives this lineup a backfield foundation that most managers in this tournament would envy. Colston Loveland slots in as the TE3 and runs with Caleb Williams, who projects as the QB6, creating a stack that adds a meaningful floor to the passing game. Williams was taken slightly ahead of his ADP, but at QB6 the price is easy to justify. The receiver group is the quieter part of this story, with Brian Thomas Jr. projecting as the WR31 after a difficult 2025 that included injuries and some unresolved chemistry questions with Trevor Lawrence, meaning his upside may hinge on how that relationship develops. Still, the trajectory here is hard to argue with. This is a 77th-percentile roster, and muppetthedog has earned a much better year.

larsonaa arrives in the Tecmo Super Bowl division sitting at 77th percentile and looking, frankly, better than the draft board has any right to explain. The story of this roster is conviction dressed up as chaos. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 form a foundation that most managers would mortgage their middle rounds to secure, and larsonaa did exactly that, reaching for pieces like Daniel Jones and MarShawn Lloyd well before the market agreed. Jones went nearly three rounds early. Lloyd went over three rounds early. Both are reaches by any reasonable accounting, and yet the roster that emerged from those gambles projects as a genuine contender because the core holds. DeVonta Smith at WR14 fell over a round past his ADP and slots in as a starter alongside Ladd McConkey at WR20. Jayden Daniels at QB5 anchors the passing game. The 2025 campaign went 50-50 and finished in the 70th percentile scoring-wise, which is the biography of a team that was close but not there. Whether larsonaa crossed that threshold in 2026 depends entirely on whether those reaches were vision or variance.

Duffke entered the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a plan and left with proof it worked. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a starting group that projects as genuinely elite, and the supporting cast behind him, George Pickens at WR10, Zay Flowers at WR16, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, was assembled without a single reach on the board, fourteen chalk picks and five values against zero reaches in either direction. That kind of discipline is rarer than it sounds. The values are not flukes, either. Carnell Tate at WR29 came nearly two rounds late, and Denzel Boston at WR58 slid over a round past his number. Meanwhile, Mike Evans, coming off an injury-shortened season in Tampa and now landing in San Francisco, represents exactly the kind of upside dart Duffke was smart enough to grab. The weakest projected starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, which tells you everything about the floor here. Third in the division, 87th percentile in the field: this roster was built to go the distance.

btvoytko lands at 89th percentile in the field and second in the Tecmo Super Bowl division, and the draft that built this roster explains exactly why. The secret is not one spectacular swing but a steady accumulation of small advantages: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 slipped to pick 1.07 despite an ADP of 1.02, Justin Jefferson at WR6 fell nearly half a round, Ashton Jeanty at RB7 dropped almost a full round past his ADP, and Travis Kelce landed a round later than the market expected. Four values, zero steals, and yet the roster reads like someone who simply refused to lose a pick. The Kyler Murray reach at round six is the one moment where btvoytko got out over their skis, but Murray stacks with Jefferson, which at least turns the premium into a calculated bet rather than a vanity pick. After a 36th-percentile finish in 2025, the upgrade is dramatic, and it traces back to a draft that kept winning small without ever needing to win big.

TreyStation is not here to make things interesting, it is here to win, and those are very different mandates. Division-leading, 93rd-percentile rosters are built on exactly the kind of discipline this draft reflects: fifteen chalk picks as the foundation, and then the patience to let value come to you rather than chasing it. Nico Collins at WR9 sliding to the fourth round is the kind of gift that wins tournaments, and Javonte Williams landing at RB17 a full round and a half after his ADP suggests a manager who stayed at the table while others panicked. Stack that foundation under Trey McBride at TE2 and Tyler Warren at TE4 both projecting as starters, and TreyStation is fielding elite production at a position where most of the field is settling for far less. The weakest projected starter is Quentin Johnston, who comes in at WR41 and arrived as the roster's biggest steal. When your floor is someone else's value pick, the whole enterprise starts to look less like a draft and more like a verdict.
