JamesFHT sits 12th in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The top end is real, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 are legitimate anchors, but the draft leaned heavily on instinct over discipline, producing seven minor reaches and two major ones against zero steals. Those major reaches are the quiet killers: Ted Hurst at WR85 cost nearly three rounds of draft capital above his market price, Elijah Sarratt at WR98 cost nearly four, and neither projects to start. Meanwhile the QB room of Daniel Jones at QB25 and Deshaun Watson at QB34 offers almost nothing in a positionless format where quarterback production can quietly drag down a lineup week after week. Rico Dowdle, the projected weakest starter at RB32, is the floor this team is standing on. Chase and Pitts can carry a bad week, but they cannot carry a bad roster, and right now that is exactly what they are being asked to do.

There is no sugarcoating what @ffLarryMonkey is working with in 2026: this roster sits 11th in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and in just the 28th percentile of the field, and the draft did almost nothing to improve the outlook. Of 19 selections, not a single one qualified as a steal, and the one player who fell past his ADP, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, was mostly offset by a draft board full of chalk and a few questionable reaches, most notably Jack Bech at WR94, taken more than three rounds early. The deeper problem is that the position-agnostic format rewards having elite players anywhere on the roster, and outside of Brock Bowers at TE1 and Drake London at WR7, the projected starters include names like Malik Willis at QB24 and Darnell Mooney at WR82. After a 2025 season that landed in the second scoring percentile, there is no obvious lever left to pull here, just hope, and hope does not show up on a depth chart.

There is not much to sugarcoat here for KillerTofu17, who sits 10th in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and projects at just the 30th percentile of the field. The roster grades out as average across the board, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over thin projections: 16 chalk picks, one major reach in Tyquan Thornton (WR97) taken more than five rounds early, and just two genuine values across the entire board. The brightest light is Tucker Kraft (TE5), who is coming off an ACL injury but departed the preseason PUP list ahead of schedule and steps back into a Packers offense that shed more receivers than it added, meaning his path to a starring role remains clear if he can recapture his pre-injury form. The problem is that one elite tight end projecting as a starter cannot carry a lineup when the depth grades out average everywhere else. KillerTofu17 is essentially betting on Kraft's recovery with no obvious backup plan if that bet goes sideways.

PeteLaw22 finished 13-23 last season and ranked in the 14th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 outlook sitting at 36th percentile tournament-wide and ninth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division suggests the calendar has not been kind. The draft tells a lot of the story. Tyler Warren (TE4) is a legitimate asset, but reaching 1.2 rounds early for him in the second round meant PeteLaw22 was already playing catch-up on value before the third pick was in. The situation compounds with AJ Barner (TE24) pulled 4.6 rounds ahead of his ADP in round eight, a move that would look visionary if Barner were projected closer to Warren's tier and looks like a costly miscalculation given he isn't. The backfield has real depth with Omarion Hampton (RB9) and Chase Brown (RB11) as projected starters, but Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) is carrying the receiver group largely alone, and the projected lineup bottoms out at Aaron Jones (RB38). There is no obvious trade chip surplus, no late-round sleeper haul to brag about, and no clear fix on the horizon.

danpizzuta is sitting at 42nd percentile in the field and eighth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division, and the draft log doesn't offer much comfort. The quarterback shelf is legitimately strong, with Drake Maye projecting as QB2 and Caleb Williams as QB6, but in a positionless format those arms only carry so much weight when the rest of the roster grades out average at best. The real damage shows up in the wide receiver projections, where Ladd McConkey anchors the group at WR20 and the depth falls off a cliff from there, a collection of WR63-and-worse options that were repeatedly drafted ahead of their ADP. Javonte Williams cost danpizzuta a round and a half of draft capital to land at RB17, and Rhamondre Stevenson, projected at RB31, is the weakest projected starter on the entire roster. With twelve chalk picks and four reaches of consequence, there were few clever moves to offset the thin projections, and right now there isn't an obvious lever left to pull. This team is hoping for a lot to break right, and hoping isn't a strategy.

fieldy38 is a 52nd-percentile team in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division, and that number is doing a lot of honest work. The ceiling is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a top end that most managers in this tournament would trade for, and the Baker Mayfield-Emeka Egbuka stack adds a connective tissue that can spike a week when everything clicks. But the floor is where fieldy38 will live or die. The draft logged two major reaches, including Stefon Diggs at WR56 taken more than two rounds early, and those are the kinds of bets that quietly drain a roster's margin for error. Dallas Goedert arrives with genuine upside, having been the steadiest piece of that Eagles passing game last season, but he's a TE15 projection, not a difference-maker. Xavier Worthy, the projected weakest starter, is the name you'll be staring at in a close week wondering if you needed one more elite piece instead of another flier. Seventh in the division feels about right. Every week will be decided at the edges.

Heroes in a Half PPR didn't chase fireworks in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft, and that's precisely what makes this roster worth watching. The foundation is genuinely strong: Trey McBride checks in as TE2, George Pickens projects as WR10 and fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 round out a receiver group that keeps punishing opponents week after week. Joe Burrow at QB4 handles the most important position at an elite level. What ties this together is the draft discipline, fourteen chalk picks, two values, and a steal in Aaron Rodgers, who slid more than three rounds past ADP to land at pick 17.10 as a sensible depth piece. The floor here is genuine, the ceiling is real, and the 2025 squad finished at 47th percentile scoring, meaning this isn't a team reinventing itself so much as one that quietly upgraded. Sitting sixth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and in the 61st tournament percentile, Heroes in a Half PPR is the kind of team that beats you before you notice you're losing.

There was no single lightning-bolt pick here, no hero moment where @godfatherleague reached into the fifth round and pulled out a league-winner. What this draft has instead is something harder to appreciate in the moment: consistent, grinding value from top to bottom. Josh Allen at QB1 went one pick before his ADP, barely a reach, and Jayden Daniels as a projected QB5 gives this lineup a quarterback depth that most managers simply don't have. Kyren Williams fell nearly a full round and a half past his ADP before landing at 6.12, and Woody Marks slipped almost two rounds before @godfatherleague scooped him up at 16.12. Neither pick wins a headline, but both represent the kind of patient accumulation that builds a 61st-percentile roster into something better by the time weeks matter. Harold Fannin projected at TE6 rounds out a starting group with no obvious soft underbelly. A 22-14 record and 78th-percentile scoring in 2025 suggests this manager knows how to convert a good paper team into actual wins. Fifth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

hayeb3 is sitting third in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and the 62nd percentile overall, but those numbers undersell what this roster actually is: a concentrated bet on elite skill-position talent paying off at exactly the right moment. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3 in the entire field, and hayeb3 surrounded him with a murderers' row of supporting pass-catchers, including Luther Burden (WR22), D.J. Moore (WR26), and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), the last of whom slid a full 1.2 rounds past his ADP before hayeb3 pounced. Add Colston Loveland at TE3 alongside Dak Prescott at QB7, and you have a roster where five projected starters rank inside the top third of their respective positions. In a positionless format where the only question is how many elite players you can line up at once, hayeb3 answered it loudly. Jordan Addison fell 1.3 rounds past his ADP and landed here too, a quiet reminder that this draft had both volume and vision behind it.

Sporting PA sits at 62nd percentile in the field and fourth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division, which sounds middling until you look at the roster and realize they drafted their way to genuine quality despite a habit of jumping the gun. Three major reaches populate the board, including Trevor Lawrence at QB10 taken nearly two rounds early and Kaytron Allen at RB61 grabbed more than three rounds before consensus said to. On paper, that is a lot of conviction spending. In practice, Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Nico Collins as WR9, and Lawrence sits at QB10 alongside a starting backfield anchored by Derrick Henry at RB12, a player they actually caught value on. The question hanging over this team is whether those reaches cost them elsewhere or whether they simply trusted their board while everyone else waited. The roster suggests the former is not obviously true. Sporting PA looks like a real contender here, built on instinct as much as process, and that is either a warning or a compliment depending on how the season unfolds.

racecardriver23 didn't win the draft with one flashy swing. They won it by being right over and over again. The foundation starts at receiver, where CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) give this team a top-end that most managers in the Scott Fish Bowl simply cannot match, and Zay Flowers (WR16) and Jameson Williams (WR21) extend that quality well past the obvious starters. Williams is a particularly telling detail: taken at 6.01 with an ADP of 5.01, he was one of three players racecardriver23 landed at genuine value relative to the field, a quiet running theme across a draft that logged 15 chalk picks against just one minor reach. Jalen Hurts (QB9) anchors the quarterback situation alongside Brock Purdy (QB13), who runs a stack with George Kittle (TE9) that adds a bonus layer of upside on big Purdy weeks. When your weakest projected starter is Chris Godwin at WR38, the draft didn't just go well, it went consistently, relentlessly well. Division rank of second confirms it.

lewinjim sits first in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and checks in at the 72nd percentile tournament-wide, and the draft tells you exactly why: this roster was built through quiet discipline rather than one flashy moment. The foundation is genuinely elite, with Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Jonathan Taylor (RB4) anchoring a starting group that would make most managers envious, and Taylor himself arrived as a good value, slipping to pick 2.06 despite an ADP of 2.01. A.J. Brown (WR8) followed the same pattern, falling nearly a full round past his ADP and landing as a projected starter. The draft charted mostly chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk means lewinjim kept winning the picks it was supposed to win. Tee Higgins (WR19), Terry McLaurin (WR24), and Rome Odunze (WR30) round out a starting corps with genuine week-to-week upside. One reach on Tory Horton (WR93) is easy to forgive when everything else in the top half of the draft landed on or ahead of schedule.
