Chaz322 went into this draft and somehow found a way to make every decision worse than the last one. The headliner is the QB group, where Brock Purdy, Malik Willis, and J.J. McCarthy were all taken well before the market said to, a combined three major reaches on a position tier that ranks out at QB13, QB24, and QB37. None of those are starting quarterbacks on good teams, and Chaz paid premium pick capital to collect all three of them early. Willis is the most interesting of the bunch, a dual-threat type with a real contract in Miami, but a \$45 million investment from a franchise that has not exactly been a fantasy factory is not the kind of safety net that justifies reaching 2.7 rounds. Meanwhile, the team lands in the 6th percentile of the field with Jalen Coker projected as the weakest starter, a WR55 taken two and a half rounds before his number was called. Zero steals, zero values, five major reaches. This is not a rebuilding project. It is the draft equivalent of a long, slow exhale.

ScottRyan90 finished 28th percentile in scoring last year and somehow responded by drafting like a manager trying to outrun their own instincts. The most damning evidence is what happened at quarterback: three of the four major reaches on this roster were signal-callers, with Bryce Young taken 3.3 rounds before his ADP, Cam Ward grabbed 2.8 rounds early, and Fernando Mendoza scooped up 2.5 rounds ahead of schedule. In a positionless format where those draft slots could have reinforced the top of the board, ScottRyan90 instead burned them on QB26 and QB27, players who won't even crack the starting lineup. The one legitimate piece here, James Cook at RB5, was drafted at chalk, and George Pickens at WR10 represents the lone value on the sheet, taken just under a round past his ADP. That is a thin foundation for a team sitting 11th in the division and at the 23rd percentile of the field, and nothing else in this roster suggests the gap is about to close.

There is no graceful way to spin a 23rd-percentile roster sitting tenth in The Golf Club division, so let's not bother trying. The foundation here is genuinely strong: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and De'Von Achane slots in at RB6, giving DUUUVALLL DEMOLITION as much backfield firepower as almost anyone in the field. The problem is that the draft did almost nothing to build around that core. Of 20 picks, the team recorded zero steals, and the manager burned three of those selections on major reaches, all at quarterback. Trevor Lawrence, reached 1.6 rounds early, projects at QB10. Tua Tagovailoa, pulled nearly 3.5 rounds before his ADP, lands at QB31. Michael Penix Jr., the most aggressive overpay of the draft at 4.8 rounds early, projects at QB33. Those three picks represent a substantial chunk of early draft capital spent chasing a position that never materialized in quality, leaving Xavier Worthy, projected at WR49, as the weakest projected starter. Gibbs and Achane deserve better than this.

The bad news for I like Twix is that the roster grades out at the 26th percentile and sits ninth in The Golf Club, and the draft process offers little comfort. Three major reaches dot the board, including Jordan Love at QB17 pulled four-plus rounds before the market agreed and Kayshon Boutte at WR76 taken nearly three rounds early, the kind of aggressive early commitments that tend to look worse as the season unfolds rather than better. The floor here is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give the team a legitimate top-end punch, but the supporting cast fades quickly, and the projected starting lineup bottoms out at Hunter Henry at TE18, a player who represents the weakest link on a chain that wasn't especially strong to begin with. When your two clearest draft wins are players who simply fell to you rather than anything you manufactured, and your most aggressive swings missed the consensus by multiple rounds, there is no obvious lever left to pull. This team is not broken, just built without much margin for error in a field that will punish exactly that.

JBMajor enters 2026 sitting eighth in The Golf Club division and inside just the 34th percentile of the field, and the draft did little to improve the outlook. The roster has real pieces, Amon-Ra St. Brown projects as a WR4 and Lamar Jackson pairs with a TE4 in Tyler Warren for one of the better stacks in the tournament, but the depth behind those names falls off quickly and the draft process made things worse rather than better. JBMajor reached two full rounds early for C.J. Stroud, who projects as a QB22, and then burned a mid-round pick on Kirk Cousins at QB35 when the market said both players would have been available later. That is three picks spent on quarterback depth that grades out as thoroughly mediocre, and the draft produced zero steals against three major reaches. The ceiling here is real but narrow, entirely dependent on Jackson and St. Brown playing at or above projection, and there is no obvious secondary lever to pull if they disappoint.

Kylepaben's 2026 squad sits at 52nd percentile and seventh in The Golf Club, which is precisely the kind of position where a season turns on two or three players performing at the edge of their projection rather than the middle of it. The strength here is real: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 give this roster a legitimate top end, and the Herbert-McConkey stack adds a correlation bonus that could inflate a big week into a monster one. But the margin question lives with Bhayshul Tuten. With Travis Etienne gone to New Orleans and Chris Rodriguez as the only credible competition in Jacksonville, Tuten has a genuine path to bell-cow work, and if he seizes it, the RB picture improves considerably. If he doesn't, the back end of this roster leans hard on Ray Davis and Demond Claiborne, who project at RB62 and RB63. Those aren't names that win close weeks. Kylepaben isn't a pretender, but the ceiling and the floor are closer together than the top of the roster suggests.

zachdotwags finished this draft with 15 chalk picks, two minor reaches, and two major reaches, which sounds like a manager who kept overshooting their range and hoping for the best. The roster, though, tells a different story. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a genuinely strong group, and the supporting cast, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, Breece Hall at RB14, and Bucky Irving at RB21, reads like someone who drafted with a plan rather than desperation. The one reach that will get scrutinized is Jaxson Dart, pulled 2.5 rounds ahead of his QB11 projection in round two, a price that only looks reasonable if Dart takes a significant leap. The one that quietly looks smart is Brian Thomas Jr., who fell nearly a round and a half past his ADP right into zachdotwags's lap at pick 9.01. The reach on Dart could age poorly or look visionary. That tension, conviction versus fortune, sits at the center of everything here, and at 57th percentile, this roster has the talent to climb if the bets land.

stheriault didn't need a miracle pick to build something worth watching in The Golf Club. The draft was quiet in the best possible way: three values, fourteen chalk, and zero major reaches, the kind of card you play when you know what you're doing. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, and the double stack with D.J. Moore (WR26) and Dalton Kincaid (TE11) means Allen's production has real places to land on this roster. Kincaid is the one name worth watching closely, a reliable contributor when healthy but coming off a knee issue that Bills GM Brandon Beane described as too early to call heading into 2026, and that uncertainty alone keeps this from being a clean story. Still, Jordan Addison at WR43 is the projected weakest starter, which is the kind of problem you want to have. Sitting at 66th percentile and fourth in the division, stheriault didn't do anything flashy. They just didn't make mistakes, and in a field this competitive, that counts for a lot.

michaeldale150 did not win the 2026 draft on one splashy pick. They won it by consistently being in the right place at the right spot, round after round. The clearest examples are sitting right in the projected starting lineup: A.J. Brown at WR8, grabbed nearly a full round after his ADP, and DeVonta Smith at WR14, snagged more than a round late, giving this roster a receiver duo that would make most managers in The Golf Club quietly jealous. Anchor those two with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Jayden Daniels at QB5, and michaeldale150 has built a core that is genuinely hard to argue with. The draft was not flawless, Christian Kirk is a notable overpay at WR100, and Quentin Johnston projects as the weakest starter at WR41, but a 66th percentile tournament projection is not built on perfection, it is built on cumulative good decisions. That is exactly the receipt this roster is carrying into 2026.

HotMessMC didn't stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The spine of this roster runs through two stacks that could genuinely carry a tournament week: Joe Burrow paired with Tee Higgins, and Patrick Mahomes doubled up with both Rashee Rice and Travis Kelce. When those connections fire together, the ceiling isn't just high, it's the kind of score that wins charity tournaments outright. The draft execution backs up the vision, too. Marvin Harrison Jr. fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP before HotMessMC scooped him, and Christian McCaffrey came at a half-round discount despite projecting as RB3. That's a team that knew what it wanted and stayed patient enough to get it at fair prices. Sitting third in the division and at the 66th percentile heading in, this isn't a roster that needs to get lucky, it needs Burrow and Mahomes to have the same big week simultaneously. When that happens, HotMessMC won't just compete, they'll be difficult to beat.

BrettLPape didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's kind of the point. Sitting at the back of the first round, this team turned a late pick into Trey McBride, TE2, a full round after the board had him priced. Then at 3.12, Saquon Barkley, RB8, slid nearly a round past his ADP and landed right in BrettLPape's lap. Neither move required genius, just patience and a willingness to take what the draft was offering. The same discipline showed up again in the middle rounds, where Mike Evans, WR27, and Makai Lemon, WR40, were collected at discounts, building out a starting group that projects well above its draft cost. The late rounds produced more value in Zach Charbonnet and Jayden Higgins, both of whom fell past their ADPs. The roster isn't built around one bold swing, it's built around a dozen small advantages that compound. At 88th percentile and sitting second in The Golf Club, BrettLPape looks like exactly the kind of quiet, well-constructed team that's still playing in December.

SkolSisters sit atop The Golf Club division and in the 94th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: five values, fourteen chalk picks, and not a single major reach across the entire board. This team did not bet big on one flashy swing, it just kept coming out ahead on nearly every pick. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this roster an elite ceiling at two positions, and both were acquired at or near fair market. The values add up quietly but convincingly: Kenneth Walker III slid a full round past his ADP and landed at RB10, George Kittle fell 1.3 rounds to give SkolSisters a TE9 behind Loveland, and Alec Pierce drifted to WR32 well after his ADP. Even the one minor reach, Tyler Shough at QB20, cost less than a round and a half. Coming off a 64 percent win rate and 81st percentile scoring in 2025, this roster looks built to do more of the same and then some.
