Hyrule Heroes finished 4th percentile in scoring last year and somehow drafted like the lesson didn't take. The headline crime is Isaac TeSlaa, a WR68 snagged in round 8 when the field wasn't touching him until round 16, a 7.4-round reach that is less a draft pick and more a public confession. Colby Parkinson, a TE31, went in round 9 against an ADP of round 15. These aren't aggressive bets on upside, they're a manager outrunning their own board and paying full price for the privilege of owning players the rest of the field correctly deprioritized. The saving grace is supposed to be Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, and he is genuinely elite, but one anchor cannot hold a roster that logged six major reaches across 19 picks and found zero steals. Hyrule Heroes currently sits 12th in the division and in the 2nd percentile of the tournament, and with Travis Etienne reached nearly two rounds early and Rashod Bateman a WR92 eating a late roster spot, nothing in this construction suggests those numbers are about to move in the right direction.

There is a particular exhaustion that comes with defending a legacy you are no longer sure you can back up, and that is where Biggoron Mike's Studs finds itself heading into 2026. Last year's squad went 29-7 and scored in the 98th percentile. This year's version sits 11th in the division and projects to just the 13th percentile of the field, which is less a fall from grace than a collapse of the scaffolding. The top of the roster is real, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Nico Collins at WR9 give the team a genuine foundation, but the draft process is where the gap between reputation and reality starts to show. Three major reaches on the board, including Chris Godwin pulled two full rounds ahead of his WR38 projection and Sean Tucker taken more than four rounds early as essentially the team's only backfield piece, suggest a manager drafting on instinct and name recognition more than position. The floor is not zero. It almost never is when Chase is in the lineup. But the 98th percentile version of this team is not walking through that door.

The Triforce Titans enter 2026 sitting 10th in their division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason to argue with those projections. The receiver group is genuinely strong, headlined by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Drake London at WR7, and Luther Burden carries real upside after a second-half 2025 surge that has Ben Johnson already drawing comparisons to St. Brown in training camp. But a receiver corps can only carry so much weight when the quarterbacks behind it grade out as badly as this one does. Tua Tagovailoa at QB31, J.J. McCarthy at QB37, and Justin Fields at QB38 form one of the weakest quarterback rooms in the tournament, and the draft did not help matters. Tagovailoa was the big value find, taken nearly four rounds after his ADP, but landing a QB31 at a discount is still just landing a QB31. When your best quarterback lever is "we got a bad quarterback cheap," the uphill road ahead is less a metaphor and more a promise.

Diegofvc sits ninth in the Ocarina of Time division and at the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster carries four major reaches against zero steals, a ledger that rarely ages well. Josh Allen is a genuine asset at QB1, and De'Von Achane at RB6 gives the team a real spike play, but below that tier the floor drops faster than you'd like. The wide receiver group grades out weak, with Rome Odunze at WR30 and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 leading a corps that never quite gets dangerous. What makes the outlook harder to shake is that the draft-capital inefficiencies were concentrated in the wrong places: Chuba Hubbard, reached for by more than two rounds, projects as the weakest starter on the board, and similar early investments in Jacory Croskey-Merritt and Brian Robinson suggest a manager who bet heavily on upside that the rankings don't yet see. Allen and Achane are a foundation, just not quite enough of one.

jimbo831 is sitting at 40th percentile and eighth in the Ocarina of Time division, and the draft history doesn't offer much comfort. The backfield is genuinely strong, with Saquon Barkley, Breece Hall, Josh Jacobs, and Bucky Irving all projecting as starters, but the receiver group grades out as the team's anchor in the worst possible sense, with Makai Lemon as the top projected option at WR40. That means jimbo831 is essentially hoping the run-heavy approach floats everyone to safety while the receiver corps quietly drowns. The draft didn't help matters. Jacobs was reached 1.8 rounds early to land an RB16, and the receiver additions, Troy Franklin and Pat Bryant, were both taken well ahead of ADP despite projecting at WR80 and WR86 respectively. You can reach on players if they pay off, but reaching on WR80s is just paying a premium for median. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no single move that reshapes the roster's ceiling, and the standings are likely to reflect that.

The Water Temple finished last season at 12-24 with a 19th-percentile scoring output, and the 2026 projections are not asking anyone to revise that opinion upward. The floor here is Brock Bowers (TE1) and Colston Loveland (TE3), a genuinely elite top of the roster that gives the Water Temple a real edge at the position, but after that the picture gets murky fast. Sam Darnold grades out at QB21, which in a positionless format means the manager is burning a starter slot on a back-of-the-pack quarterback. Malik Nabers (WR12) and Tee Higgins (WR19) provide some legitimacy in the middle of the lineup, but this roster projects seventh in the division and in the 41st percentile of the field, and there is no obvious corrective on the horizon. Quinshon Judkins, still working back from a fractured fibula that cut his 2025 short, carries the most upside among the RB group at RB22, but banking a season on a bounce-back from injury is less a plan than a prayer.

There was no lottery ticket moment in this draft, no swing-for-the-fences gamble that either made or broke the team. What A Link to the Pass built instead was a roster where almost every pick landed right or better. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the receiving corps, and Trey McBride slipping to 1.12 despite an ADP of 1.08 is the kind of quiet win that compounds over a season when TE2 production is sitting in your lineup every week. The steal of the draft was C.J. Stroud, snagged at 12.01 despite an ADP of 9.08, giving the team a fallback at quarterback that most managers would happily start. Add Derrick Henry at RB12 and Javonte Williams at RB17 providing a sturdy floor, and the pattern becomes clear: this team did not outsmart the board on one pick, it just kept not losing rounds. The result is a 57th-percentile projection that feels like a floor rather than a ceiling, built on a 2025 campaign that already finished at 54th-percentile scoring with a 61 percent win rate.

tstrack didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right over and over. The anchor is a projected WR5 in CeeDee Lamb, taken at 2.04 when the field valued him closer to 1.11, a full round of surplus value before the draft was barely underway. From there, tstrack kept finding the same edge at a smaller scale: Davante Adams at WR25 slipping a round and a half past his ADP, Tetairoa McMillan projecting as a WR15 starter, Zay Flowers and Jaylen Waddle rounding out a receiver group that gives this team real firepower at the top of the lineup. The Lamar Jackson and Flowers stack adds a correlation bonus that could spike the ceiling on any given week. The draft grades out as mostly chalk with a handful of genuine values, which sounds modest until you realize that consistently beating ADP is exactly how winning rosters get assembled. Sitting fifth in the Ocarina of Time division and at the 58th percentile, there is room to climb, and this roster has the talent to do it.

williamrpowell3 enters 2026 looking less like a team built around a single bold swing and more like the product of someone who simply kept winning individual draft decisions until the whole thing accumulated into something formidable. The backbone is undeniable: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 form a top-of-market foundation, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 arrived a full round late, a quiet win that most managers in the field did not get. Jayden Daniels at QB5 similarly fell nearly a round past his ADP, meaning williamrpowell3 essentially collected a top-five quarterback at a discount and moved on without ceremony. The 2025 track record, a 78 percent win rate and 85th-percentile scoring, suggests this is not a lucky draw but a manager who executes. At 74th percentile in projected scoring and fourth in the Ocarina of Time division, the ceiling here is real, and the floor is the kind of steady competence that tends to compound over a long season.

Kokiri Kittle drafted like someone who actually did their homework, and the results speak for themselves: one steal, four values, and only a single minor reach across the entire board. The anchor of this thing is a receiver room that would make most managers quietly close their laptop in envy, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, Ladd McConkey at WR20, and Parker Washington at WR35 all slotted as projected starters. The Matthew Stafford and Nacua stack adds a layer of ceiling that pure talent accumulation alone cannot buy, and Stafford himself came a full round after his ADP, making it one of the cleaner quarterback acquisitions in the field. Harold Fannin at TE6 and George Kittle at TE9 give the manager two legitimate top-ten options at a position where most rosters are crossing their fingers. The 2025 campaign backed all of this up, a 30-6 record and 92nd-percentile scoring are not flukes, they are the signature of a manager who builds with discipline and lets the value do the talking.

Master Sword Mafia didn't win the draft with one bold swing, they won it by grinding the market down pick after pick. James Cook (RB5) and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) give this roster an elite ceiling right out of the gate, and what followed was a masterclass in patience: Baker Mayfield (QB18) slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, Kyle Pitts (TE7) fell a full round into their lap, and Chase Brown (RB11) came at a discount on top of that. Five values against zero major reaches is not luck, it's discipline compounding across eighteen rounds. The Baker Mayfield situation deserves a closer look, sure, with Mike Evans gone and consensus still skeptical he returns to his QB5 2024 form, but the price already reflected that pessimism, which is exactly the point. This roster landed at the 80th tournament percentile and second in the division, and the draft log explains why. When every transaction tilts slightly in your favor, the final product doesn't need a single signature moment to be very, very good.

LukeJukeEm sits atop the Ocarina of Time division and at the 100th percentile of the entire field, and when you look at how this roster was built, neither fact is surprising. The foundation is legitimate: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this team two of the most productive backs in the format, and a receiving corps anchored by George Pickens (WR10), Rashee Rice (WR13), and DeVonta Smith (WR14) would make most managers quietly close their laptops in envy. What elevates this from a good team to a great one is the draft discipline behind it. Patrick Mahomes came in 1.7 rounds after his ADP, Rice slid another round past his, and Mahomes stacking with Rice turns that late value into a correlated upside play. The only real uncertainty is Dalton Kincaid, whose knee health remains an open question heading into 2026, but Kincaid's floor when healthy is a consistent contributor running routes for Josh Allen. That is a fine worst-case scenario. This roster has very little to criticize and a lot to fear.
