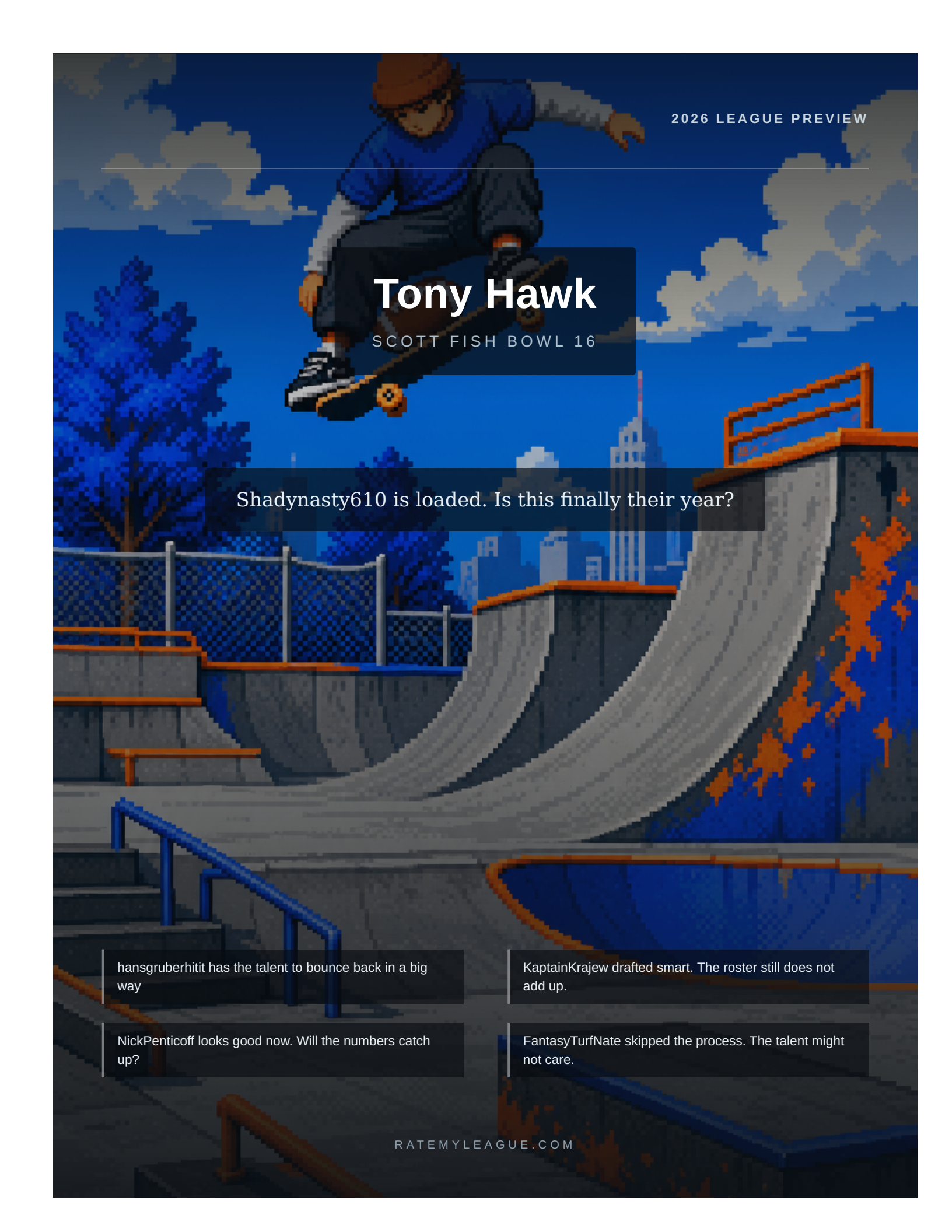

BigDoug77 enters 2026 sitting at the bottom of the Tony Hawk division, and the draft record explains exactly why: four major reaches, zero steals, and a paper trail that reads like a series of panic decisions made on a kitchen timer. The most damning entry is Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 whom BigDoug77 pulled nearly six rounds ahead of consensus, which is the kind of move that haunts a manager the way a bad tattoo haunts a wedding photo. That pick burned a sixth-round slot that could have shored up genuine depth, and instead the quarterback room projects as the weakest positional group on the roster. There are legitimate weapons here, George Pickens, Malik Nabers, Rashee Rice, and Garrett Wilson form a receiver corps that would make most managers jealous, and Brock Bowers at TE1 is a real asset. But Nabers was himself a reach at 2.12, and with C.J. Stroud projecting as QB22, the engine does not match the horsepower available to it. BigDoug77 won 78 percent of games in 2025. The 2026 projection puts them 12th in the division. Somewhere in that gap is a draft that went very, very wrong.

There is no polite way to dress this up: GreyDuck is sitting 11th in the Tony Hawk division, projecting in the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The quarterback situation is quietly ruinous, with Sam Darnold at QB21 and Cam Ward at QB23 as the projected starters, and Ward was taken three full rounds before his ADP suggested he would be available, meaning the draft capital spent to acquire that level of production was wildly inefficient. Trey McBride at TE2 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are legitimately elite, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 give this team a real foundation, but in a positionless format those strengths have to compensate for a quarterback room that grades out near the bottom of the tournament. Four major reaches across the draft left little margin for error, and there was no error margin to spare. GreyDuck went 50-50 in 2025 and nothing on this sheet suggests the arrow is pointing upward.

DylanBaum enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Tony Hawk division and in just the 23rd percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The headliners are real: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and James Cook at RB5 give this team a legitimate foundation, and Jalen Hurts as a QB9 starter is nothing to apologize for. But the drop-off comes fast and it comes hard. Beyond that top tier, the projected starters include Xavier Worthy at WR49 and Isaiah Likely at TE13, which is not a lineup that inspires confidence when you need depth performances to carry a week. The draft offered almost no margin for error, producing zero steals across 18 rounds, and the one moment DylanBaum swung early was on Jaydon Blue, reached a staggering 6.8 rounds ahead of ADP and currently projected at RB70. That is the kind of bet that needs to hit big to matter, and right now it looks less like a bold move and more like a prayer. This team needs things to break right. There is no indication they will.

Last year, NickPenticoff finished in the 94th percentile, and the ghost of that performance is doing a lot of heavy lifting right now, because the 2026 version of this roster projects out at the 28th percentile, ninth in the Tony Hawk division. The skeleton of something real is here: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine anchor, Drake London at WR7 gives the team a credible top option, and the Brock Purdy/George Kittle stack offers upside if San Francisco clicks. But pulling Purdy at pick 3.12 against an ADP of 5.09 is the kind of move that looks ambitious in February and haunted in September, and the depth thins out fast, with Michael Pittman projecting as the weakest starter at WR44. The 2025 campaign was real, the points were real, the wins were real. The 2026 roster, though, reads less like a defending contender and more like a team that kept the logo while quietly shipping the talent elsewhere, and no amount of reputation changes what the projections say.

KaptainKrajew ran a disciplined draft, taking 16 chalk picks and coaxing genuine value out of Caleb Williams, who slid nearly a full round past his ADP. The process was sound. The product is quietly alarming. The quarterback room projects as a genuine asset, with Joe Burrow at QB4 and Williams at QB6 forming a pairing most managers would envy. But this format rewards depth across the roster, and the receiver group does real damage to the overall picture. The projected starters top out at Jameson Williams at WR21 and D.J. Moore at WR26, and the third spot belongs to KC Concepcion at WR50, a projection that would make most managers reach for something stronger. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Derrick Henry at RB12 give the backfield genuine upside, but talent at the top cannot compensate when the middle of the roster projects this thin. KaptainKrajew did almost everything right on draft day and still landed at 32nd percentile. The draft was clean. The ceiling is not.

ATriBaldQuest sits 7th in the Tony Hawk Division and projects at just the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster's construction explains exactly why. The backfield is genuinely impressive, with Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) anchoring a deep group that grades out as a strength. But in a positionless format where you start your ten best players, the receiver room becomes the ceiling, and that ceiling is painfully low: Michael Wilson (WR39), Stefon Diggs (WR56), and Keon Coleman (WR91) are the entire receiving corps. Lamar Jackson (QB3) adds real value, but much of the remaining draft capital went toward questionable bets, most notably a five-round reach on Michael Penix Jr. (QB33) in round 12 when the roster already carried Jackson and Jordan Love (QB17). That is draft currency that could have addressed the receiver weakness instead propping up a position that was already covered. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and the schedule does not care.

CKutzerFF is the team that makes you look twice at the standings and then shrug, which is both the problem and the path forward. The receiver group is legitimately dangerous at the top, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 forming a projected starting core that most managers in the Tony Hawk division would trade for without blinking, and Lamb arriving as a genuine value at pick 2.03 makes that pairing even cleaner. The issue is that everything else sits in that uncomfortable middle register, where Justin Herbert at QB8 is good enough to start but not so dominant he tilts the floor, and the projected floor drops notably once you get past the top names. A 42nd-percentile tournament projection and a sixth-place division ranking both say the same thing: this roster wins when the right players hit and loses quietly when they don't. In a tournament decided at the margins, CKutzerFF needs Brown and Lamb to be every bit as good as their projections suggest, because there is very little slack further down the lineup to absorb a bad week from anyone near the top.

FantasyTurfNate built something real here, and the draft log makes it look more reckless than it was. Three major reaches on the board, and yet the roster landed at the 52nd percentile with a genuine foundation underneath it. The clearest example of conviction paying off is Davante Adams, taken a full 1.6 rounds before the market caught up, and while that looks aggressive in isolation, pairing him with Matthew Stafford in a live stack gives the pick structural logic. The bigger gamble is Daniel Jones, reached 2.6 rounds early to land a QB25, which is the kind of move that either looks prescient in October or becomes the footnote on a frustrating season. What keeps the outlook cautiously bright is that those quarterback questions sit on top of a genuinely strong skill-position floor: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this team two projected starters who can carry weeks on their own, and Colston Loveland at TE3 adds another reliable anchor. The board said reach, the roster said sure, go ahead.

Last year, hansgruberhitit finished in the fourth percentile in scoring, a number so grim it barely registers as a season. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine correction. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, the kind of anchor that makes a lineup competitive before you fill in a single other name, and the names that follow are genuinely good: Chris Olave at WR11, Zay Flowers at WR16, and Tee Higgins at WR19 give this team a receiver corps that should generate points in volume. Layered on top is a quarterback situation that quietly works, with Jayden Daniels projecting as a QB5 and a Shough-Olave stack adding a ceiling game on nights when Tyler Shough is cooking. The draft was mostly chalk, but two values, including Tre Harris falling more than two rounds past his ADP, gave the manager a little cushion. A team sitting at the 55th percentile in the field has room to climb, and after a season like 2025, climbing is the whole point.

There was no lottery ticket here, no one swing that either made or broke the draft. derekf17 just kept coming out ahead, round after round, and the ledger reflects it. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9 form a projected starting core that most managers in the Tony Hawk division would trade their entire late-round budget to own, and Collins arriving half a round early is the closest thing to a complaint you can level at the top of this roster. From there, the draft became a quiet accumulation of surplus value: Omar Cooper Jr. at WR60 fell more than two full rounds past his average draft position, Jake Ferguson arrived two rounds late at TE12, and Brenton Strange slid nearly two rounds to fill out the tight end room. Against twelve picks worth calling chalk, that kind of consistent extraction is how rosters end up at the 72nd percentile without a single transformative moment you can point to. derekf17 finished 2025 above the field in wins and comes into 2026 with a deeper, better-constructed team. Third in the division is a floor, not a ceiling.

CamSwarts did not win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a long session: steadily, hand after hand, never overplaying their position. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, but the real texture of this build is in how the value accumulated beneath him. Marvin Harrison Jr. landed at WR33 despite an ADP that had him going nearly a round and a half earlier, and Khalil Shakir followed a similar path, slipping to WR51 well past where the field expected him to land. Paired with A.J. Brown, who brings WR8 projection and a genuinely exciting new situation alongside Drake Maye in New England, the aerial attack projects as legitimately dangerous. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Breece Hall at RB14 give the ground game the same kind of quiet credibility. Three values, sixteen chalk, and a 2025 record of 23 wins against 13 losses tells the story: CamSwarts is not flashy. They are just consistently right, and in the Tony Hawk division, that distinction matters.

Shadynasty610 sits at the top of the Tony Hawk division and in the 99th percentile of the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. This was not a lucky roster, it was a disciplined one. Seven values across the draft, zero major reaches, and a clear-eyed willingness to let talent come to them. Drake Maye sliding a full round past his ADP to land at 3.05 is the kind of gift that happens when a manager is patient enough to let the board break right. Sam LaPorta fell 1.3 rounds. Dalton Kincaid fell 1.5. Kyle Pitts fell over a round. Collectively, those are not accidents, they are the compounding returns of a drafter who trusted the process and kept picking. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a starting group that is hard to argue with, and a 22-14 record with 4679 points last season suggests this manager knows what to do with a good roster once they have one. Shadynasty610 built this thing correctly from the ground up.
