As the 2025 season looms, Anthonyc24 stands on uncertain ground, balancing between potential and disappointment. His performance might be the linchpin for the season, as

any faltering could spell disaster. With an average age of just 24.9 years, they're one of the younger squads out there, perhaps too green to outmaneuver more seasoned opponents. Their bold moves to draft Tahj Brooks and Kyle Williams earlier than expected will need to pay off if they are to rise from the ashes of mediocrity. In a landscape where every point matters, Anthonyc24 seems destined to drift, caught in the undercurrents of an unforgiving competition.


