Skinzaholic21 sits dead last in the Twisted Metal division and in the bottom percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly how it happened: six major reaches against zero steals, a blueprint for burning draft capital on players who weren't worth the price. The most damaging swing came in round two, where Tyler Warren, a TE4, got grabbed nearly a full round before his ADP. Warren is a fine player, but paying a premium for a tight end in a positionless format that rewards top-end flexibility is exactly the kind of reach that cascades. Then came TreVeyon Henderson at RB19, yanked off the board 2.6 rounds early, followed by Trevor Lawrence at QB10 taken 1.3 rounds ahead of schedule in round three. That is three of the first five picks leaking value before the roster even had a foundation to build on. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is the one legitimate anchor here, but one elite projection cannot paper over a draft that consistently paid tomorrow's prices for today's middling production.

Ensabbathnur played the 2026 draft about as cleanly as the process allows. Four values, fifteen chalk, one minor reach, zero major reaches: a profile that suggests discipline and restraint at every turn. Jake Ferguson fell nearly two rounds past his ADP, Dak Prescott dropped almost a full round, and the Prescott-Ferguson stack gives the roster a built-in multiplier that most managers would happily accept. Jonathan Taylor projects as RB4, Kyren Williams sits at RB15, and the depth behind them is real. So why does this feel like a team that will spend October watching its percentile drift? Because the wide receiver group is a quiet disaster that no amount of disciplined drafting can paper over. Chris Olave checks in at WR11 and then the drop is nearly vertical, with Travis Hunter at WR62 and nothing reliable after that. Add the unresolved situation surrounding Josh Jacobs, who carries genuine off-field uncertainty regardless of how his projection reads, and Ensabbathnur lands in the uncomfortable position of having done almost everything right and still not quite having enough.

Thumper enters 2026 ranked 11th in the Twisted Metal division and sitting at just the 41st percentile of the field, and there is not much in the draft ledger to suggest a turnaround is coming. The draft produced zero steals, fifteen chalk picks, and one major reach, Emanuel Wilson at RB69, burned six rounds early on a player the market barely values. The top of the roster is genuinely appealing, Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 give this team a real foundation, and the Goff-St. Brown stack adds a tidy bonus. But after that the projections get thin fast, with Makai Lemon at WR40 slotted as the weakest projected starter and Justin Herbert arriving with real questions about his ceiling. Herbert gets a new offensive coordinator in Mike McDaniel, which is an upgrade, but the Chargers have spent two seasons leaning on ball control under Jim Harbaugh, and Herbert's pass attempts have already slid. That is not a ceiling you want to depend on when your margin for error at the 41st percentile is essentially zero.

Jayden Reedles Kane sits ninth in the Twisted Metal division and checks in at just the 44th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The team produced zero steals and only one value on the board, with the lone bright spot being Justin Jefferson, a WR6 projection snagged at 2.05 against an ADP of 1.12. That is a real win, but one good pick does not rebuild a foundation. Harold Fannin projects as a TE6 and has genuine upside, though his ceiling is perpetually hostage to a Cleveland quarterback situation that currently orbits around Deshaun Watson, which is not a sentence that inspires confidence in anyone. Beyond Jefferson and Fannin, the roster thins out quickly, with Jayden Reed projected as a WR48 and flagged as the weakest projected starter. The draft also featured a major reach on Ted Hurst, taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no breakout candidate hiding in the depth chart ready to flip the script. This is a team hoping the projections are wrong, and that is a thin strategy.

Rudy enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Twisted Metal division and right at the 50th percentile of the field, which is a polite way of saying there is no margin for error and no obvious path to create any. The core is real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a legitimate foundation, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 round out a serviceable upper tier. But the drop-off is steep and the draft did nothing to disguise it. Fifteen chalk picks and zero steals means Rudy essentially paid sticker price for every asset on this roster, and the one splashy move, Justin Fields at QB38 taken more than five rounds before his ADP, is the kind of reach that tends to look worse in retrospect than it did at the time. Then there is Oronde Gadsden, projected at TE16 and already facing pressure from David Njoku arriving in Los Angeles. When your margin is thin and your lever is a reach at QB38, the math is just not friendly.

Warthog sits at 52nd percentile in the field, which sounds like a polite way of saying "probably fine, probably not." The foundation is genuinely good: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Omarion Hampton at RB9, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give this roster a top end that can absolutely carry a week. The problem is what happens when you scroll down the depth chart. Davante Adams at WR25 and Mike Evans at WR27 are veterans projecting as mid-tier starters, and a Purdy-Evans stack gives the lineup a real ceiling on the right Sunday. But 14 chalk picks in a draft where edge-making is everything, paired with a seven-round reach on Elijah Sarratt, suggests a manager who played it safe with one hand and threw money out the window with the other. Coming off a 39 percent win rate in 2025, Warthog needs its margins to break right, and right now the roster is built to survive the middle of the schedule, not dominate it.

SinkerFF sits at 53rd percentile in the field and sixth in the Twisted Metal division, which is the fantasy equivalent of being the most reliable person at a party where nobody is having a great time. The margins here are real. Tucker Kraft, projected TE5, is the clearest example: an elite-trajectory tight end who tore his ACL last November, returned healthy enough to come off the preseason PUP list before August, and now steps back into a Packers offense that lost more receivers than it added, meaning the target volume that briefly made him a star should be waiting for him. If Kraft regains his pre-injury form, that is a starting TE5 at a discount, since SinkerFF grabbed him at 6.01 with an ADP of 4.12. That kind of value is not a windfall, it is a single tick in the right direction. The Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack adds a reliable floor. Breece Hall at RB14 and Rashee Rice at WR13 give the lineup a credible top end. None of it screams dominant. All of it says competitive, and in a format this tight, competitive is where seasons are decided.

ClockDodgers didn't light any fireworks on draft day, and that's exactly the point. This roster was built on volume of correct decisions rather than a single headline move, and the results hold up. James Cook at RB5 anchors a backfield group that also includes Chase Brown (RB11) and Cam Skattebo (RB20) among the projected starters, giving this team a steady floor that most managers would quietly trade their draft for. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is the kind of pick that looks obvious in hindsight but still requires the conviction to pull the trigger. Kyle Pitts at TE7 rounds out a starting core that projects with real consistency across the board. The one blemish worth noting is Jordan James, reached 4.7 rounds ahead of his ADP at RB67, a cost that only stings if the rest of the roster makes you feel charitable toward it, and this one mostly does. Fifteen chalk picks sounds boring until you realize the field is full of teams that swung for the fences and missed. ClockDodgers didn't miss much.

Spectre's draft looks like a mess on paper and a masterpiece in practice, which is either the most encouraging thing you can say about a manager or the most suspicious. The major reaches tell the story: Adonai Mitchell taken 4.6 rounds early, Jaylen Wright grabbed 4.9 rounds ahead of consensus, Theo Johnson pulled forward 3.3 rounds before the board expected. Each one looks like a panic buy in isolation. Together they fill out a roster anchored by one of the most absurd receiver groups in the field, headlined by Puka Nacua at WR1, Drake London at WR7, and Nico Collins at WR9, all projected starters, all running routes for a team that finished at the 93rd percentile in scoring in 2025. Matthew Stafford stacking with Nacua gives this offense a clear identity and a ceiling that justifies the aggression. The question worth asking is whether Spectre saw something real in those reaches or just got away with it. The standings at season's end will settle that debate, but right now, the roster makes the draft look like genius.

Needles Kane did not win this draft with one thunderbolt swing. They won it round by round, pick by pick, building the kind of roster that earns its ranking through compounding advantages rather than a single coup. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give the team a genuine elite tier at the top, the sort of foundation that keeps a manager competitive even on a bad week. From there, the depth holds: George Pickens at WR10, Zay Flowers at WR16, and D.J. Moore at WR26 form a projected-starter core that would headline most rosters in this field. The draft process itself reflects the same discipline. Jaxson Dart arrived as a projected QB11 and came in on time; C.J. Stroud, projected QB22, fell more than three rounds past his ADP and landed in Needles Kane's lap at pick 12.10. The one legitimate concern worth flagging is Dalton Kincaid, whose chronic knee issue leaves his availability genuinely uncertain heading into 2026. But a roster that finished in the 95th percentile in scoring last season, and now sits at the 70th percentile in projected strength, is not in crisis. It is simply waiting to be proven right again.

patjoyce did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to experiment. Sitting second in the Twisted Metal division and in the 84th percentile of the entire field, this roster reads like a masterclass in disciplined drafting, built on value captured and talent deployed with quiet precision. The cornerstone is a tight end group anchored by Brock Bowers at TE1 and Colston Loveland at TE3, both projected starters delivering elite production from a position that routinely separates contenders from pretenders. Layered on top of that foundation are six draft values across the roster, including Malik Nabers falling nearly a full round past his ADP to land as a projected WR12 starter, and Sam LaPorta sliding more than a round to give patjoyce a TE8 at a discount. The lone blemish is Fernando Mendoza, taken about a round and a half ahead of consensus, and even that feels more like a reasonable bet than a regrettable overreach. Last season patjoyce finished in the 99th percentile of scoring. Nothing about this roster suggests a regression is coming.

Shutx didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it the way good drafts get built, by coming out ahead on pick after pick until the advantages accumulated into something real. Josh Allen at QB1, taken at 1.09 when his ADP sat at 1.05, is the kind of slight edge that compounds nicely when CeeDee Lamb falls to 2.04 despite projecting as WR5, and Jameson Williams and Jaylen Waddle land as projected starters further down. The receiver corps alone gives this team a starting group that most managers would envy, with Emeka Egbuka at WR18 and DK Metcalf at WR36 providing real depth behind Lamb. Travis Kelce raised some offseason questions about whether he'd return, but he's back and chasing a top-12 TE season, which gives shutx a credible option at the position. The draft charted 14 chalk and 4 values against zero major reaches, which is a quiet way of saying this manager never got greedy and never paid for it. Division rank first, tournament percentile at 87th. The Twisted Metal standings already know.
