GenesisFantasy finished in the 80th percentile last season, and the natural instinct is to expect more of the same. The roster says otherwise. The receiver group, the position where this format rewards depth and upside in equal measure, tops out at Christian Watson at WR28, with Michael Pittman at WR44 as the projected weakest starter, and it falls off sharply from there. That is not an 80th-percentile receiver room. The backfield is genuinely strong, with Chase Brown, Derrick Henry, Kyren Williams, and Travis Etienne all projecting as starters, and Etienne was a legitimate value at pick 8.03 against an ADP of 6.07. But the draft overall leaned chalk, with 13 chalk picks against zero steals, and the most aggressive swing was Jaxson Dart at pick 2.03, a reach of more than three rounds on a QB11 projection. Oronde Gadsden adds something at tight end, though the addition of David Njoku in Los Angeles clouds his target share. GenesisFantasy sits 12th in the division and in just the 6th percentile of the field. The reputation is 80th percentile. The projection is something much harder to look at.

Last year's A Thiefs End Zone finished in the 83rd percentile, a genuine performance that now hangs over this roster like a credential nobody can quite verify anymore. The 2026 version projects at just the 16th percentile, good for 11th in the division, and the gap between those two numbers is the whole story. The foundation is real: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this team a legitimate elite tier, and George Pickens at WR10 keeps the ceiling from collapsing entirely. But the quarterback room is where the reputation starts to curdle. Jordan Love, Baker Mayfield, and C.J. Stroud form a QB17/QB18/QB22 cluster that looks like depth until you remember that Love has finished outside the top 10 in fantasy scoring two straight years despite being a genuinely good NFL quarterback, a distinction that pays no bills in this format. The manager reached early for both Love and Mayfield,

spending real draft capital on quarterbacks who are collectively projected to be average. A Thiefs End Zone is not a bad team. It is, more painfully, a team that remembers being better.

There is no sugarcoating the spot Marion Ross is in. Sitting 10th in Uncharted 4: A Thiefs End and projecting at just the 23rd percentile of the field, this roster is running out of runway. The foundation is not nothing, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give the team a legitimate top tier, and the Caleb Williams / Luther Burden stack adds some ceiling on a big week. But the draft sheet tells a harder story: zero steals, four minor reaches, and two major ones, most painfully the double investment in quarterbacks, with Williams pulled 1.2 rounds early and Brock Purdy yanked 1.4 rounds ahead of his market. In a positionless format where those resources could have shored up depth that actually starts, that is capital that simply does not come back. The back end of this roster dissolves quickly after the headliners, and with no obvious reconfiguration available, Ross looks like a team hoping the stars align rather than one built to make them.

caitforshort did almost everything right on draft day and still landed at 29th percentile in the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole enterprise. The value discipline was real: Omarion Hampton at RB9 fell nearly a full round into lap 4, RJ Harvey at RB28 slid almost two rounds before being claimed, and Carnell Tate at WR29 came a round late as well. The problem is that value drafting is only as good as the players delivering it, and Harvey is the shakiest link here. Denver brought back JK Dobbins and then added Jonah Coleman in the fourth round of the 2026 draft, turning what was already a murky backfield into a full committee situation with Harvey trending toward the margins. A projected RB28 playing behind two other backs is not a bargain at any price. Sam Darnold reaching three rounds early at QB21 compounds things quietly. caitforshort earned better than ninth in the division. The draft just did not cooperate.

Nathan Drake Maye sits eighth in the Uncharted 4: A Thiefs End division and at just the 40th percentile of the field, and the draft chart offers little reason for optimism. The backfield is genuinely impressive, with James Cook (RB5), Breece Hall (RB14), Cam Skattebo (RB20), and Bucky Irving (RB21) all projected to start, but in a positionless format, quality at the top of the roster is what separates contenders from also-rans, and the receiver group simply does not hold up its end. Parker Washington (WR35) and Wan'Dale Robinson (WR47) are the projected starters at the position, and Robinson grades as the weakest projected starter on the entire team. Meanwhile, Trevor Lawrence (QB10) cost a third-round pick, more than a full round ahead of his ADP, which is a steep price for a player who sits outside the top five at his position. Trey McBride (TE2) and Harold Fannin (TE6) are legitimate assets, but when your clearest path to winning runs through a tight end and a backfield, while the rest of the roster shrugs, there is no obvious lever left to pull.

The Travis Treasure Hunters finished 64th percentile in scoring last year and have somehow managed to slide to 42nd percentile in projections heading into 2026, which is the wrong direction for a team that was supposed to be building toward something. The core looks fine on the surface: Joe Burrow at QB4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 are legitimate weapons, and landing Lamb at 2.07 when his ADP sat at 1.11 is the kind of draft-day win that should anchor a contender. But that steal is nearly the whole story. Burrow was a major reach at nearly a full round before his ADP, the tight end situation is a liability with Pat Freiermuth projecting at TE30 and Mike Gesicki at TE33, and Saquon Barkley, the name that was supposed to stabilize the backfield, is no longer the same force he was in 2024. At 29, with Philadelphia reportedly looking to lighten his workload after a year in which the offensive line never got healthy, Barkley's floor matters a lot more than it used to, and it is shrinking. This roster has pieces, but not enough of them, and no obvious move left to close the gap.

Libertalia finished 2026 as the tournament's version of a rounding error, sitting at 45th percentile with a division rank of six, and the margins are exactly where this season will be decided. The core is genuinely good: Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the lineup, Ashton Jeanty projects as RB7, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 was a legitimate find, snagged more than a round past his expected landing spot. That foundation gives Libertalia real floors. But the draft tells a conflicted story underneath it: Matthew Stafford, taken at 3.05 with an ADP of 6.02, is a nearly three-round overpay for a QB14 who will rarely see the field in a positionless format, and Evan Engram cost two and a half rounds of draft capital to land a projected TE36. Those reaches did not wreck the roster, they just quietly narrowed the margin for error that a 45th-percentile team can least afford to lose. Libertalia has enough to win any given week and enough soft spots to lose any given week. That is the whole season, right there.

Big Bonus Ballers land at the 72nd percentile, and the draft tells you exactly why: not a single jaw-dropping steal, but a steady drumbeat of smart decisions that compounded into something real. The anchor is a receiver corps that reads like a highlight reel, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, and Nico Collins at WR9 all projected to start. Collins and St. Brown deserve extra credit because the manager didn't just land talented players, they landed them late. St. Brown fell nearly a full round past his ADP, Collins fell even further, and both ended up in the starting lineup anyway. Layering the Jared Goff and St. Brown stack on top of that only sharpens the upside. The major reaches on Jordan James and Theo Johnson are real and worth noting, but in a format this fluid they don't define the roster. What defines it is a manager who kept winning small coin flips at the draft table until the collection quietly became one worth watching.

There was no single moment where fantasyacumen swung for the fences and connected. There was just round after round of quiet competence, and by the time the draft ended, this roster sat at the 74th percentile without ever needing a miracle. The backbone is genuinely impressive: Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors a backfield corps that keeps producing starters, with Jeremiyah Love (RB13), Josh Jacobs (RB16), and TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) all projecting into the lineup. Jacobs carries some real-world uncertainty after an offseason arrest, with charges still pending and the full picture unsettled, so that RB16 projection comes with an asterisk that has nothing to do with fantasy. The draft process itself told the same story as the roster: three values, thirteen chalk picks, and only three minor reaches, none of them alarming. Ladd McConkey at WR20 fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed here. Henderson slipped a similar distance. fantasyacumen did not manufacture luck; they simply kept showing up to collect it.

Hector AlcaJaMarr landed in the 77th percentile and sits third in the Uncharted 4: A Thiefs End division, and the draft record tells you why: not a single dramatic swing, just a consistent pattern of getting value. The centerpiece is a receiver group that most managers would envy, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Justin Jefferson (WR6), with Jefferson representing the clearest win of the draft, snagged at pick 2.10 against an ADP of 1.12. Malik Nabers (WR12) adds another layer, and his context matters here: after a torn ACL scared off enough managers to drop his value from a top-10 receiver to WR21 at his lowest, Hector bought in at 5.03 while Nabers was flashing his old quick-twitch self in camp, a full 1.3 rounds after his ADP. That is the draft in miniature: patient, opportunistic, and almost never forced. The Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce stack adds a reliable floor, and when a team this well-constructed lands in the top quarter of the field, the arrow points up.

Drakes Fortune didn't win the draft in one flashy moment, they won it pick by pick, and the wide receiver group is the clearest evidence. Drake London at WR7, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Zay Flowers at WR16 form a projected starting core that most managers would sign off on before their coffee cools, and all three fell past their ADP, meaning this manager collected real value without ever having to gamble. D.J. Moore at WR26 and Quentin Johnston at WR41 extend that depth further, giving the lineup options that hold up even when things get weird in the back half of the season. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the backfield and brings the kind of week-to-week reliability that makes the rest of the roster easier to manage. The one genuine overpay, Ja'Kobi Lane taken nearly three rounds before his ADP, is a footnote on an otherwise disciplined board. Sitting second in the Uncharted 4: A Thief's End division and projecting into the 79th percentile of the field, Drakes Fortune looks like exactly what it is: a team built by someone who simply kept making the right call.

TDsnTailgates sits at the top of the Uncharted 4: A Thiefs End division and in the 97th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: six values, zero reaches, not a single round where the manager flinched or panicked. That kind of discipline compounds. Puka Nacua at WR1 is the headliner, but the connective tissue is what makes this roster hum. Kyle Pitts, drafted at 6.12 despite an ADP of 5.07, lands as TE7 with zero cost premium. Dalton Kincaid fell a full round past his ADP and slots in as TE11. Tucker Kraft, who was pacing toward 1,000 yards before a November ACL injury, came off the preseason PUP list healthy, steps back into a Packers offense that lost more receivers than it added, and projects as TE5. Three tight ends with genuine upside, collected at a collective discount, is not luck, it is a manager who knew what things were worth and waited. The weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48. That is a very short list of complaints.
