As the 2025 fantasy football season looms for Armando Marsal (@Armando\_Marsal), optimism is in short supply. Following a dismal 2024 campaign with a paltry win rate of 29% and resting in the 26th percentile, hopes for a turnaround appear slim. Ranked dead last in their division and barely scraping the bottom of the barrel overall, the team faces an uphill battle. Despite boasting a strong wide receiver corps led by Justin Jefferson, Garrett Wilson, Terry McLaurin, and others, the glaring weaknesses in other positions are hard to overlook. The running back situation, with Breece Hall as the only reliable option, is particularly concerning, especially with Jaydon Blue expected to shoulder significant responsibility despite being the weakest link. The tight end position adds little value to

the roster, and the quarterback situation, while perhaps receiving a slight boost from a well-timed pick with Matthew Stafford, is muddled by reaching early for C.J. Stroud, leaving questions about strategic decision-making. This season appears poised to mirror their previous struggles, as poor draft value and positional imbalances threaten to keep them firmly planted at the bottom of the rankings.

As Mitch Frerichs (@unipanther7) gears up for the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook is less than promising. Despite a stellar performance last year, finishing comfortably in the 70th percentile, the team appears to be facing a steep uphill battle. Occupying an unenviable 11th place in a division that demands excellence, they find themselves languishing in the bottom 10 percentile across the board. Amon-Ra St. Brown and Nico Collins, who were both selected significantly earlier than their average draft positions, anchor what is arguably one of the stronger receiving corps, yet the gamble on Emeka Egbuka as a starter could prove costly against more formidable opponents. The running back situation is dire, with Kyren Williams failing to inspire confidence as the lone RB standout, ranking near the bottom. Desperation seemed to mark the draft strategy, reaching for Jared Goff and others, perhaps as a misguided attempt to recapture last year's magic. Yet, without a

solid foundation and with glaring gaps in the roster, especially at running back, the season ahead looms like a storm cloud over Mitch Frerichs' aspirations, threatening to wash away any lingering glimmers of past success.

As they brace for the challenges ahead, it's clear that Scott Connor will need to rely heavily on its backfield prowess to navigate through a season that promises to test their mettle at every turn.
