As jb38 prepares for the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook is anything but promising. Burdened by a lackluster draft strategy, the team is already lagging behind in both division and overall rankings. With an uninspiring 11th place in their division and languishing in the low tournament percentile, it's hard to see a path forward for significant improvement. While the wide receiver corps, led by standout Ja'Marr Chase, offers a glimmer of hope, the inclusion of Jayden Higgins as a starter is a glaring weakness that could easily be exploited by opponents. The running back situation is hardly better, with middling performances expected from Chuba Hubbard and D'Andre Swift, who fail to inspire confidence. Questionable draft choices further compound their troubles, as reaching for players like Drake London and Jauan Jennings seems like the kind of gamble that's unlikely to pay off. Without meaningful changes or unexpected breakout performances, jb38 will struggle to gain any traction this season, likely remaining stuck in the depths of obscurity.
