Catsgotmytongue1 enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Cool Boarders division and in just the 4th percentile of the overall field, and the roster makes it easy to see why. The draft was the team's best chance to build a winner, and it mostly squandered it, burning two first-tier picks on quarterbacks nobody needed that urgently: Lamar Jackson, taken nearly a full round early at 1.06, and Jared Goff, reached almost two rounds early at 4.07. In a positionless format, that kind of premium real estate spent on a QB3 and a QB16 is a bet that those two slots will carry the lineup, and nothing here suggests they will. The receiver group grades out weak, with Garrett Wilson at WR17 as the best of a thin group and Rashid Shaheed, projected WR57, holding down a starting spot. Mark Andrews fell far enough past his ADP to count as the draft's one genuine win, but one late-round bargain at TE14 does not rebuild an offense built on shaky foundations. This roster has no obvious lever left to pull.

There is a specific kind of draft misery reserved for managers who did everything right and still ended up here, and RTDB has earned every drop of it. The values came in on schedule: RJ Harvey landed 1.5 rounds after his ADP, Terrance Ferguson fell nearly two rounds into the sixteenth, and the board cooperated in all the ways it was supposed to. The roster shows for it, too, with Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchoring a group that grades average at best at the skill positions and weak everywhere else. The cruelty is in the ceiling, not the process. A 4-32 record last season that landed in the 4th percentile in scoring left no margin for another mediocre build, and that is precisely what materialized. Brock Purdy at QB13 leads a quarterback room that bottoms out at Michael Penix Jr., a player reached three full rounds early, which is either a bold conviction play or

the one moment the discipline broke. Either way, RTDB sits 11th in the Cool Boarders division with a 20th-percentile outlook and the hollow comfort of knowing the draft grades out fine.

Canuckgurl sits 10th in the Cool Boarders division and at just the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The receiver group is the soft underbelly of this build, with Jaylen Waddle (WR23) as the lone projected starter worth trusting and Tyreek Hill clocking in at WR77, a shell of the player that rank would have been unthinkable for just a few seasons ago. What makes it worse is that Hill was a major reach, taken 2.8 rounds before his ADP, so Canuckgurl paid a premium for a declining asset while surrendering draft capital that could have shored things up elsewhere. The draft sheet overall is bleak reading: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches against a backdrop of 15 chalk picks. Josh Allen (QB1) and Ashton Jeanty (RB7) give this team a genuine ceiling, but when your weakest projected starter is Rhamondre Stevenson (RB31), you are one bad week from a lineup that cannot keep up with the division's better-constructed rosters.

kraush77 sits ninth in the Cool Boarders division and projects out at just the 34th percentile, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The RB group is legitimately good, anchored by Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and De'Von Achane (RB6), but the rest of the roster struggles to keep pace with that top end. The receiver group is average at best, and Alec Pierce (WR32) is the kind of player who looks better on paper than he scores on the sheet, given that he has never cracked 50 receptions in a season and HPPR and PPR formats blunt his big-play value considerably. Pierce also came out of the offseason with ankle surgery and a PUP list designation, meaning he could miss the first four games if he does not clear by late August cut-downs. Meanwhile, kraush77 reached nearly two rounds early for Patrick Mahomes (QB12) in a positionless format, a luxury spend that did not come back with a discount anywhere else on the board. Zero steals, zero values, and a ceiling that is hard to identify. This team needed everything to break right, and it is already breaking wrong.

cmcclore19 did almost everything right at the draft table. Travis Etienne fell a round past his ADP, Jerry Jeudy dropped nearly three rounds before being scooped up, and the Herbert-McConkey stack adds a structural bonus on top of a receiver corps anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4. The process was sound. The outcome is still an 8th-place division projection and a 35th percentile tournament standing, which is the draft equivalent of doing the math correctly and still getting the wrong answer. The issue is not any single decision but the cumulative weight of the whole. Geno Smith cost nearly three rounds of draft capital above his QB30 projection, a reach that quietly poisoned the well. Tyler Shough slots in as the secondary quarterback option at QB20, but at 27 years old with an unresolved ceiling question, he offers little upside insurance. Quentin Johnston projects as the weakest starter at WR41. Add it up and cmcclore19 earned better than this roster, which almost makes it worse.

chams24 enters 2026 sitting at the exact median of the field, 49th percentile, and the roster reflects that positioning with uncomfortable accuracy. The receiver room is genuinely elite: Puka Nacua (WR1), A.J. Brown (WR8), and Nico Collins (WR9) give this team a ceiling that most managers in the Cool Boarders division can only dream about. But the draft tells a more complicated story. Three major reaches, including Elijah Arroyo (TE40) taken nearly six rounds early and C.J. Stroud (QB22) grabbed 2.5 rounds ahead of schedule, signal a manager who drafted with conviction and occasionally without patience. Those early commitments have consequences down the ballot. A 64 percent win rate last season proves chams24 knows how to translate a roster into results, and the top of this lineup is good enough to make noise. The question is whether Nacua, Brown, and Collins can carry enough weight to cover the draft capital that got away, because in a field this deep, the margins decide everything.

SNOWJUNGLE sits at the 49th percentile, sixth in the Cool Boarders division, and the numbers basically shrug at you. Not a threat, not a target, just a team that will win or lose on the margins all season long. The core is legitimately good: Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Harold Fannin as TE6, and Sam LaPorta as TE8, giving this roster a genuine high floor when things break right. The question marks live at the edges. Trevor Lawrence is the most interesting one, coming off a career year built on confusing inputs, a 4,000-yard season and nearly 30 passing scores despite his supposed weapons largely underperforming, which makes projecting him feel like assembling furniture without the instructions. He ranks QB10, and if that holds, SNOWJUNGLE has real upside. If Lawrence regresses to the theoretical version of himself, the margin for error shrinks fast. Chuba Hubbard projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB29, and in a team built this close to the median, that's exactly the kind of soft spot that decides a season.

Dobi1kenobi didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by never losing a round. The centerpiece is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, a projected starter who gives this roster a genuine top-end anchor, and Colston Loveland at TE3 is the kind of positional advantage that quietly tilts weekly matchups. Stack those two with Caleb Williams, a QB6 projection pairing directly with Loveland, and you have a core that most managers would build a season around without apology. The supporting cast holds up: Emeka Egbuka at WR18 and Carnell Tate at WR29 are both projected starters, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 adds real depth behind Loveland. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk just means getting what you paid for every single time. Dobi1kenobi sits fifth in the Cool Boarders division and at the 60th percentile of the field, numbers that feel conservative given the quality sitting at the top of this lineup.

After a 2025 campaign that landed Champules in the 5th percentile in scoring, the rebuild looks real and the rebound feels close. The anchor of this turnaround is a receiving corps headlined by CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Malik Nabers (WR12), both projected starters and both capable of carrying a week on their own. Nabers is the one to watch closely: he avoided the PUP list and looked explosively himself in training camp after a concerning offseason following his torn ACL, and his value is still climbing back from a July low of WR21. That upside, still discounted, is exactly the kind of thing that separates a 61st-percentile team from one that crashes the top quarter. Drake Maye (QB2) keeps the ceiling honest at quarterback, and Tyler Warren (TE4) was the draft's clearest value, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. This is not a roster that needs to hope for luck. It needs Nabers healthy and Maye to take the next step, and if both happen, Champules stops being a cautionary tale and starts being a contender.

Lukasm drafted with a singular vision in 2026, and the Burrow-Chase stack is the spine the whole roster bends around. Joe Burrow checks in as QB4 and Ja'Marr Chase as WR2, meaning when this pairing runs hot, Lukasm is generating points from two directions on the same drive, which is exactly the kind of ceiling-building correlation that separates contenders from also-rans in a field this competitive. The supporting cast is genuinely strong enough to hold up that architecture: George Pickens at WR10 and Zay Flowers at WR16 give Lukasm a second and third projected starter who could carry a week if Burrow-Chase goes quiet, and Breece Hall at RB14 adds another high-floor contributor. The draft itself was mostly chalk, which is not a knock on the approach so much as a reflection of a manager who knew what he wanted and paid market price to get it. The real question is variance. Lukasm's 2026 ceiling is tied to whether the Bengals cook, and if they do, third in the Cool Boarders division looks like a floor, not a destination.

mrcoutts sits second in the Cool Boarders division and in the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains both the achievement and the anxiety underneath it. The foundational picks are legitimately excellent: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors everything, Drake London projects as WR7, and Tetairoa McMillan, taken a full round after his ADP, looks like the shrewdest patience of the whole draft. But mrcoutts also reached three times in ways that raised eyebrows in real time. Kaytron Allen came off the board 2.8 rounds early, Theo Johnson nearly 3.5 rounds early, and Jacory Croskey-Merritt, the projected weakest starter at RB40, was grabbed two rounds ahead of schedule. None of those picks are indefensible, but they represent conviction that the market had not yet caught up with. The honest read is that the top of this roster is good enough to carry the bottom regardless. The question is whether mrcoutts drafted that belief correctly, or just loudly.

SamAlexF sits first in the Cool Boarders division and in the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headline is the tight end situation: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Trey McBride at TE2 are both projected starters, and McBride came off the board at 2.03 against an ADP of 1.08, a clean half-round of value on a player who projects as the second-best at his position. Then Dallas Goedert, identified here as the weakest projected starter, fell 2.6 rounds past his ADP before SamAlexF scooped him at TE15, which means the floor of this starting group is a mid-tier TE15. Beyond the tight ends, the draft held its discipline across 16 rounds: two steals, three values, and zero major reaches is the kind of ledger that signals a manager who knew their prices and never panicked. Dak Prescott at QB7 arrived 2.2 rounds late, and Parker Washington at WR35 slipped 1.3 rounds. This roster was built with patience, and the standings reflect it.
