As dibari22 embarks on the 2025 fantasy football season, hopes are tempered by a stark reality check. Despite last year's impressive performance, finishing in the top 4 percent of teams and boasting an impressive 81 percent winning rate, this season's prospects look grim. Currently ranked at the bottom of their division, the Vegas Golden Knights, and languishing in a low percentile overall, the team seems to be grappling with a roster that's a shadow of its former self. The decision to rely on Geno Smith, a quarterback only ranked 26th in his position, raises serious concerns about the team's offensive potential. Though they have a solid wide receiver lineup led by Jaxon Smith-Njigba and Tee Higgins, reaching for players like Geno Smith and Chris Godwin well ahead of their ADP has

left the team lacking depth and value. The strategic missteps in the draft only compound the challenges ahead, casting doubt over dibari22's ability to turn the tide this season.

prepare to tackle the season, armed with the kind of blind optimism usually reserved for lottery tickets and reality TV auditions.
