As @aintSaadatcha gears up for the 2025 season, the prospects appear rather bleak. Following a dominant 2024 where they enjoyed a top-ten percentile finish and a 78% win rate, the team now finds itself languishing in the lower echelons of their division at rank 9, with a dismal 27th percentile tournament placement. This drastic slide can largely be attributed to a series of questionable draft decisions, most notably reaching significantly early for Derrick Henry, which has left them scrambling for depth and value in critical positions. While their wide receiver corps offers a glimmer of hope with Puka Nacua leading the charge, the inconsistency of Mike Evans and Rome Odunze could prove detrimental, especially given their middle-of-the-pack divisional ranking. Furthermore, the tight end position, anchored by Isaiah Likely, remains a glaring vulnerability. Likely's performance will be crucial; however, his standing as TE18 suggests he may struggle against more

formidable opponents. With key drafts like Omarion Hampton and Dalton Kincaid taken prematurely, there's little room for error. The once-promising future seems overshadowed by missteps and mounting pressure, setting the stage for what could be a challenging and disappointing campaign.
