There is no flattering angle here, no buried lede that makes FearlessSnailzz look shrewd in hindsight. The defining story of this draft is a manager who fell in love with running backs before the market did and paid dearly for it, reaching nearly three rounds early on TreVeyon Henderson and then doing it again with Bucky Irving just one round later, both of whom project as RB19 and RB21 respectively. Those are fine players, but fine players drafted like elite ones leave a team perpetually underpaying at the margins, and the margins are where this roster quietly collapses. The wide receiver group is the wound that never closes, with Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 as the lone projected starter of consequence and Travis Hunter at WR62 as the next man up. Four major reaches across the full draft, zero steals, and a division rank of 12 that places this team in the 2nd percentile of the entire field. The snail in the name, it turns out, was not a personality. It was a warning.

There is no polite way to dress this up: BaileysBall grades out at the 15th percentile of the field and sits 11th in the Waluigi division, and the draft did not do much to change those odds. The most damaging decisions came early, when the manager spent a second-round pick on Caleb Williams (QB6) and then doubled down in the fourth on Bo Nix (QB15), burning premium capital on a position that punishes that kind of investment hardest. Those reaches cascaded downward, and by the time the later rounds arrived the roster was already playing catch-up. Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3) is a genuine anchor, and Saquon Barkley (RB8) gives the team a second star worth building around, but after that the projected starters are a collection of WR35s and TE14s who need to hit on optimistic projections just to keep pace. Quinshon Judkins (RB22) is reportedly on track from his fractured fibula, which matters, because BaileysBall is the kind of team that needs every projection to land exactly right and then needs a little luck on top of that.

There is no spin available for FFChrisB in 2026, and the draft sheet makes that plain. The most damning evidence sits at the top: Justin Herbert, taken at 2.12 despite an ADP of 3.09, is a QB8 in a positionless format where quarterback rank barely matters until you are reaching for one in the second round. That pick did not secure an advantage, it just cost one. The damage compounds at the back end, where four major reaches produced Brandon Aiyuk at WR81, Cooper Kupp at WR88, and Malachi Fields at WR90, three of the projected starters sitting in the bottom tier of the position. Brock Bowers is real, Kyle Pitts is real, Tucker Kraft rounds out a genuinely strong group there, but the top of the projected starting lineup otherwise bottoms out at Jayden Higgins at WR54. The 2026 tournament percentile projection sits at 17th, last in the Waluigi division, and nothing in this draft suggests that number is unfair. FFChrisB did not get unlucky. They drafted this outcome.

Stevietpfl sits ninth in the Waluigi division and projects at just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The two clearest building blocks, Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), are legitimate weapons, but the support around them thins out quickly. Brock Purdy (QB13) would ordinarily steady things at the position, except his situation in San Francisco is a mess: Brandon Aiyuk is gone, George Kittle is recovering from a torn Achilles with his early-season availability in doubt, Ricky Pearsall is nursing lingering knee swelling that could threaten his entire year, and even newly signed Mike Evans is already banged up. Purdy's weapons are a question mark stacked on a question mark. Equally telling is the draft process itself, which produced zero steals and zero values across seventeen chalk selections, meaning Stevietpfl arrived at this roster without manufacturing a single edge. When the floor is already low and the draft left no upside baked in, it is very hard to see where the season turns around.

TheMesso drafted with genuine patience. De'Von Achane came at RB6 a few spots later than his ADP suggested he would, Michael Wilson fell nearly two rounds to become a projected starter at WR25, and the roster is littered with chalk that cost exactly what it should have. Four values, zero major reaches, a draft executed with quiet discipline. And yet the projected finish sits at 48th percentile, eighth in the Waluigi division, which is roughly where last year's 33rd-percentile squad has deposited its spiritual heir. The problem is not process, it is outcome. The projected starters are serviceable at the top and thin at the edges, with RJ Harvey, a reach taken nearly a round and a half early, penciled in as the weakest among them. Josh Jacobs brings the RB16 projection but carries real-world uncertainty that the data cannot fully account for. TheMesso found value and still ended up with a roster that projects to hover just below average, which is the kind of result that makes a manager question whether the value game was ever the right game to play.

ChimRichaldsMD sits at the 55th percentile and seventh in the Waluigi Division, which tells you almost everything: this is a team built to compete on thin margins, not to blow anyone out. The foundation is genuinely good, Joe Burrow at QB4 stacked with Tee Higgins at WR19 gives the team a reliable floor when the rest of the field is variance-hunting, and George Pickens at WR10 was the draft's clearest win, falling more than a round past his ADP to land at 4.05. The problem is that the margins cut both ways. Jayden Daniels at QB5 cost a first-round pick when the field was taking him in the second, a premium that buys redundancy at the position where this format rewards it least. Factor in Jadarian Price projected as the weakest starter at RB26, and you see where the edges get thin. Burrow and Pickens can carry a week, but in a field this deep, the teams that advance don't just have stars, they have no soft spots to exploit. ChimRichaldsMD has a few.

ManisObsolete didn't manufacture a roster through bold swings, just through repeatedly getting more than the market offered. The tight end group anchors everything: Colston Loveland at TE3, Tyler Warren at TE4, and Harold Fannin at TE6 give this team a tier of production at the position that almost nobody else in the field can match, and all three project as starters. On the perimeter, Puka Nacua lands at WR1, with Ladd McConkey, Brian Thomas Jr., and Quentin Johnston rounding out a projected starting group that holds real depth behind it. Johnston himself is part of the value story, falling nearly two rounds past his ADP before ManisObsolete picked him up, one of three players the team acquired below market. The draft chart shows mostly chalk, which is not a criticism, it means the manager identified the right players and paid fair prices rather than chasing bargains into bad decisions. A 68th-

percentile projection in a competitive field, with starters this settled across the board, is a team built to compete through any lineup variance the season throws at it.

Waluigi The Winner! didn't win the draft with one bold swing, they won it by just consistently making the right calls, pick after pick. The backfield anchors the whole operation: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, James Cook at RB5, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give this roster a depth of projected production that most managers in this field simply cannot match. Chris Olave landing at WR11 while sliding four picks past his ADP is exactly the kind of quiet advantage that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones, and pairing him with Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Carnell Tate at WR29 keeps the receiving corps firmly in the respectable column. The quarterback group is the one area where the math gets tighter, with Baker Mayfield sitting at QB18 and Daniel Jones at QB25 as the realistic ceiling options, but in a positionless format this flexible, that is a manageable tradeoff when the rest of the roster looks like this. Fifth in the division and 73rd percentile overall, Waluigi The Winner! earned their position through craft, not chance.

jomo1224 did not win the draft on one flashy swing. They won it the way a good poker player wins a long session, picking up small edges, round after round, until the pile is undeniable. Trey McBride at TE2 slid four picks past his ADP and jomo1224 was right there to collect him at 1.12. Rome Odunze, projected WR30 and a legitimate starter on this roster, fell more than a full round and landed at 8.01. Jakobi Meyers, another starter at WR45, drifted nearly two rounds past his number. None of those were lottery tickets. They were just good process, repeated. The foundation underneath the values is real too: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Derrick Henry at RB12 give this team a top-end that most managers would not argue with, and the Kyler Murray and Jefferson stack adds a ceiling the projections alone do not fully capture. jomo1224 sits 73rd percentile in the field entering 2026, fourth in the Waluigi Division. The roster got there the boring way, which is usually the right way.

The Waluijeantys landed at 74th percentile and third in the division, and the draft sheet looks like a cautionary tale of a manager who kept jumping the line. Ashton Jeanty, Christian McCaffrey, A.J. Brown, Jameson Williams, reaching here, reaching there, draft capital spent a round early and sometimes more. And yet. McCaffrey at RB3 and Jeanty at RB7 anchor a genuinely elite top end, Brown at WR8 was the one place the board actually rewarded patience, and the Goff-Williams stack gives the lineup a ceiling-raiser that connects two of its projected starters in the same offense. The reaches that look hardest to defend are Shedeur Sanders and Tory Horton, pulled 3.2 and 4.2 rounds ahead of their ADPs respectively, and both project as bench contributors at best. But that is the thing about conviction drafting: the misses sit quietly at the bottom of the roster while McCaffrey and Jeanty do their work up top. Whether this manager saw something the field missed or simply got away with it, the roster they built is very good.

MikeD302 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. The draft was just quietly, consistently right. The centerpiece is the Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack, and the beautiful thing is that Lamb arrived at a discount, taken at 2.08 against an ADP of 1.11, a WR5 projection sliding nearly a full round past where he should have gone. MikeD302 was there to collect. Prescott came at 4.08 against a 3.07 ADP, a QB7 projection absorbed at below-market cost, which means the stack itself was assembled at a bargain relative to what the field was paying for comparable upside. Bijan Robinson at RB2 gives the roster a true difference-maker at the top, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 rounds out a projected starting group with genuine depth of quality. The result is a team sitting second in the Waluigi division and in the 80th percentile of the field, and nothing about this draft suggests that outcome was an accident. This is what getting ahead of the room looks like when it's done without drama.

Jrouse888 enters 2026 sitting in first place in the Waluigi Division and projecting at the 97th percentile of the field, and the draft that built this roster tells you exactly why. There was no single transcendent pick, just a steady accumulation of advantages that compounded across seventeen rounds. The foundation is genuinely elite: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Drake London at WR7, Nico Collins at WR9, and Rashee Rice at WR13 give this team a top tier that most managers can only sketch out on a whiteboard. London and Rice were both secured past their ADPs, meaning Jrouse888 got quality and got it at a discount. Jake Ferguson arriving at TE12 while falling more than two rounds past his ADP is the kind of quiet win that separates organized drafters from lucky ones. Yes, there are reaches on the board, including Kaelon Black and Ty Simpson taken well ahead of consensus, but those are footnotes on a transcript that is otherwise full of A's. Coming off a 64 percent win rate in 2025, this team looks built to go further.
