Last year c2rhino10 went 29-7 and scored in the 82nd percentile, which is the kind of season that earns a manager a reputation. The 2026 roster does not care about reputations. A fifth-percentile tournament projection and a last-place division ranking are not the opening acts of a comeback story, they are the story, and the distance between what this team was and what it is projected to be is genuinely uncomfortable to look at. The foundation is real enough: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and James Cook at RB5 give c2rhino10 a legitimate top end. But beyond that the drop-off is steep and unkind. Malik Nabers at WR12 and Garrett Wilson at WR17 hold up their end, yet Wan'Dale Robinson projects as the weakest projected starter at WR47, and the tight end position offers T.J. Hockenson at TE23 and David Njoku at TE29, neither of whom inspires much confidence. The draft produced zero steals and one minor reach on Bucky Irving that cost nearly a round and a half. This is a team living off a last name it hasn't quite earned yet in 2026.

bwehrley0 enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Duke Nukem division and in just the 15th percentile of the field, and the roster map explains why without much ambiguity. CeeDee Lamb, Justin Jefferson, DeVonta Smith, and Emeka Egbuka form a genuinely elite upper tier, and George Kittle and Travis Kelce give the team real upside at TE9 and TE10. But this is a positionless format, and when you scroll past those names the drop-off is severe enough to matter. Blake Corum grades out at RB35, Jordan Mason at RB41, and then it gets thinner from there. More damaging, the quarterback situation is a quiet disaster: Malik Willis projects at QB24, Daniel Jones at QB25, and Aaron Rodgers at QB29, none of them starters, none of them particularly close to becoming one. The draft did not uncover hidden leverage either, producing zero steals and one major reach in Keenan Allen, who came off the board nearly five rounds before his ADP suggested he should. Last season's 79th-percentile scoring looks like the high-water mark, not the floor.

There is no polite way to say this about @TerryVelcro's 2026 squad: the floor is visible and the ceiling is not much higher. The roster sits at the 20th percentile of the field and ranks 10th in the Duke Nukem division, which is about as bleak as a forecast gets. The good news is that Christian McCaffrey at RB3, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this team a genuinely elite top of roster. The bad news is that almost everything else is asking a lot. Trevor Lawrence enters the year coming off a career-best season, but that campaign was built on a patchwork of contributors rather than any stable offensive identity, which makes projecting a repeat feel like guesswork at QB10. Pair Lawrence's uncertainty with a wide receiver group that bottoms out at Xavier Worthy at WR49 as the top option, and the math gets uncomfortable fast. The draft offered no relief, producing two major reaches and zero steals. McCaffrey and Achane can carry a team, but they cannot carry a roster.

Last year desfido posted a 27-9 record and scored in the 94th percentile, the kind of season that makes a manager look like a genius. The 2026 roster suggests the market has corrected. The team sits at the 32nd percentile in projected scoring and ranks ninth in the Duke Nukem division, and the draft did not do much to close that gap, producing zero steals and leaning heavily on chalk picks. The lone bright spot in the draft ledger is Sam LaPorta falling a full round past his ADP, a genuine find at TE8. But that is sandwiched between two major reaches, Travis Etienne at RB18 pulled nearly two rounds early and Pat Bryant, a projected WR86, taken almost three rounds ahead of his market price. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is a real pillar, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds upside, but the distance between what this team was and what it is currently projected to be is a chasm the marquee names alone cannot close.

MichaelKJordan sits seventh in the Duke Nukem division and in the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster explains exactly why. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), Zay Flowers (WR16), Jameson Williams (WR21), and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) forming a top tier that most managers would envy, and Colston Loveland (TE3) and Kyle Pitts (TE7) add real punch at tight end. The problem is that none of it matters much when the quarterback situation looks like this: Matthew Stafford projects as a QB14, which is serviceable, but both Stafford and Bryce Young carry asterisks suggesting they'll see the field together, and Young grades out at QB26. In a positionless format, your worst projected starters drag on every week's ceiling, and Young is currently the weakest projected starter on the roster. The draft offered no steals and zero major reaches, which means this is essentially what the manager intended to build. There is no hidden value waiting to emerge, no overlooked pick quietly waiting to flip the outlook. What you see is what MichaelKJordan gets.

Sitting eighth in the Duke Nukem division and projecting at just the 34th percentile of the field, aeledin's 2026 roster reads like a team that already made its best moves and still came up short. The foundation is real enough: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Drake London at WR7 give the lineup genuine top-end pop, and those two alone could carry a bad week. The problem is what surrounds them. The draft leaned heavily on chalk, and when aeledin did deviate from consensus, the results were mostly costly, including three major reaches highlighted by Josh Jacobs taken a full 1.6 rounds before his ADP and Mike Washington Jr. pulled nearly three rounds early to land at RB59. Neither move generated value, and those early investments left the back of the roster thin on upside. Dallas Goedert projects at TE15 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23, which would be serviceable depth on a contender, but on this roster they are asked to be more than that. There is no obvious trade chip to flip, no late-round steal quietly waiting to break out. The ceiling is visible, and it is not high enough.

ProfFost sits at 39th percentile in the field, which is exactly as unnerving as it sounds: good enough to believe, not good enough to relax. The case for optimism starts at the top, where Drake Maye projects as a QB2 and pairs with Amon-Ra St. Brown, a WR4, in a stack that gives this roster a genuine ceiling on any given week. Add Chris Olave at WR11 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 as fellow projected starters and the high end of this lineup can genuinely hurt people. The doubt creeps in around the margins. Brian Robinson was the draft's one major reach, taken more than three rounds before his ADP and projecting only as an RB45, which means ProfFost paid a steep price for a player who may not even crack the starting lineup on his best weeks. RJ Harvey slots in as the projected weakest starter at RB28, a reasonable enough floor but hardly a comfort. This team went 67 percent in 2025 and could replicate that, or it could watch a few close losses compound into irrelevance. The margins, not the stars, decide it.

CharlieMcflyy sits fifth in the Duke Nukem division and at the 56th percentile of the field, numbers that feel almost deliberately modest given what this roster actually looks like. The draft sheet reads like a confession: six minor reaches, two major reaches, zero steals. And yet here we are with Bijan Robinson at RB2, a genuine Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack, and Luther Burden projected as WR22, all penciled into a starting lineup. The conviction was real, and so far the conviction was right. The catch, of course, is Burrow himself. He is a QB4 when healthy, arguably the best fantasy signal-caller in football, but "when healthy" has done a lot of heavy lifting in that sentence across his career. The grade-3 turf toe that wiped out most of his 2025 season is the freshest reminder that Burrow's floor is a calendar, not a stat line. If he plays, CharlieMcflyy looks like a team that won a draft by ignoring the consensus. If he doesn't, well, reaching works until it doesn't.

scootross didn't construct this roster with one knockout punch; they built it the way a good poker player accumulates chips, steadily and without drama. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs, a projected RB1 who anchors the entire enterprise, and Tucker Kraft checking in as a TE5 gives this team a genuine advantage at a position that separates the contenders from the pretenders. The draft methodology reinforces the narrative: Justin Herbert and Patrick Mahomes both fell past their ADP by over a round, meaning scootross collected QB8 and QB12 value without paying market price. Yes, Derrick Henry was taken 1.2 rounds early relative to ADP, and that reach deserves a raised eyebrow, but Henry landing as a projected RB12 suggests the outcome justified the aggression. Sitting fourth in the Duke Nukem division and at the 57th percentile of the field, this is a team that earned its spot through process rather than lottery tickets. The floor is real, the ceiling is worth respecting, and the draft gave them every reason to believe.

There was no single heist that defines je7f's draft, just a quiet, relentless accumulation of edges that left this roster sitting at the 93rd percentile of the field. The engine is obvious: Josh Allen at QB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this team a pair of projected studs that most managers would trade a late-round pick to own. But the real story is what happened in the middle rounds, where je7f found Mark Andrews at TE14 a full 1.7 rounds after his ADP and Harold Fannin at TE6 more than a round late, turning what could have been a positional afterthought into a genuine strength. Layer in Rashee Rice at WR13 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 as projected starters, and the starting lineup assembles itself without much prayer involved. The one blemish, Rashod Bateman taken three rounds ahead of his ADP, is the kind of minor indulgence a team can afford when everything else was bought at a discount. Third in the Duke Nukem division is where this team sits entering 2026, but the draft suggests that undersells it considerably.

Sitting at 95th percentile in the field and second in the Duke Nukem division, drewhannis built something genuinely hard to pick apart. The receiver corps alone is almost unfair: Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, and George Pickens at WR10 form a top line that most managers would trade their entire draft for, and D.J. Moore at WR26 and DK Metcalf at WR36 are what you field when your depth is your weakness's absence. The draft discipline behind the roster is just as impressive. Courtland Sutton fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed at 10.12; Isaiah Likely dropped a similar distance and became the TE13 at 11.01. Those are not accidents, they are a manager watching the board and acting. Jalen Hurts at QB9 adds another round of value in the quarterback spot. The Kimani Vidal reach is the one honest critique, but one overpay on a roster this clean barely registers. This is what a disciplined SFB draft looks like from start to finish.

The headliner is Brock Bowers at TE1, but the real surgical move was landing Trey McBride at TE2 in the second round when his ADP said first round, turning a single pick into a positional stranglehold that most managers can only dream about. Caleb Williams at QB6 arrived almost a full round late, and he comes pre-stacked with Rome Odunze, meaning remdog gets the upside of that connection baked right in. Zoom out and the draft log reads like a clinic: six value picks, one outright steal in McBride, zero reaches anywhere on the board. The projected weakest starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, which says everything you need to know about the floor this roster is sitting on. Clean process, clean roster, very little to argue with here.
