There is a version of this roster that looks exciting on paper, and then there is the version that actually has to compete in the Scott Fish Bowl, sitting dead last in the Fallout 3 division and in the bottom 10 percent of the entire field. Matthew Stafford and Justin Jefferson headline the squad, but the problems run deeper than star power can fix. Stafford was taken 2.1 rounds before his ADP, and Tua Tagovailoa was grabbed nearly three rounds early, meaning Demorralizer burned premium draft capital on two quarterbacks projected QB14 and QB31 respectively, neither of whom moves the needle in a positionless format where roster construction demands efficiency above all else. CeeDee Lamb and Jefferson are genuine WR5 and WR6 anchors, and the Stafford-Davante Adams stack adds upside, but the rest of the projected starters grade out as roster filler, and the draft log shows zero steals and zero values against 17 chalk selections. A team that drafted like it was playing it safe ended up with a roster that cannot afford to.

DeJavu went zero-for-the-draft in a very specific way: not a single steal, not a single value, five major reaches, and a QB room that reads like a cry for help. Sam Darnold at QB21 was taken 2.3 rounds early, which would be defensible if Darnold were a fantasy engine, but the Seattle passing game ran almost entirely through Jaxon Smith-Njigba last season and Darnold's numbers reflected it. Then, apparently unsatisfied with one overpriced game-manager, DeJavu circled back in round nine for Bryce Young at QB26, another 2.4 rounds ahead of consensus. That is two early investments in quarterbacks who project as afterthoughts. The receiver group is genuinely good, Smith-Njigba at WR3, George Pickens at WR10, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, Jaylen Waddle at WR23, and the position grades out strong, but those players cannot save a roster whose draft capital was routinely dumped into players like MarShawn Lloyd, taken a staggering 6.8 rounds early. DeJavu sits eleventh in the Fallout 3 division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and nothing about how this roster was assembled suggests those numbers will move in a more forgiving direction.

Brian Robinson RB1 played the value game almost flawlessly and has nearly nothing to show for it. Saquon Barkley, taken nearly a round after his ADP, and Jayden Daniels, scooped up more than a round late, are the kind of slides that make a draft room feel clever in the moment. The trouble is that clever moments do not fix what surrounds them. The wide receiver group bottoms out at KC Concepcion, a WR50 projection whose upside is permanently hostage to whatever Cleveland decides to do at quarterback, and the projected starting floor sits at Rico Dowdle as RB32. In a positionless format, the quality of your top players is the whole argument, and that argument here is strong at the top and then drops off a cliff. Jonathan Taylor and Barkley are genuine pillars. George Kittle and Sam LaPorta give the manager two TE8-or-better starters. But pillars need something to hold up, and at 26th percentile in the field, this roster is evidence that drafting at or after ADP is necessary and, unfortunately, not sufficient.

AskiaS drafted with genuine discipline. Fifteen chalk picks, three values, zero major reaches, and the only times the board was jumped early were for Travis Kelce and Mason Taylor at tight end. Kelce came a round early, but with real uncertainty hanging over whether he would even return in 2026, locking him in at TE10 before someone else did made sense. The problem is that patience and good process can still leave you staring at a roster that simply does not project as a winner, and that is where AskiaS sits, ninth in the Fallout 3 division and in the 28th percentile of the field. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Drake London at WR7 are genuine weapons, but the projected starters thin out fast, and by the time Jordan Addison at WR43 is filling a lineup spot, the depth that felt like an asset during the draft has quietly become a ceiling. AskiaS did nearly everything right and still ended up here, which is the kind of outcome that makes you want to retire from fantasy football entirely.

ScaryKerryDeadskins sits 8th in Fallout 3 and in the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster grades out about as well as that sounds. The foundational pieces are genuinely good: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Colston Loveland slots in at TE3, and Harold Fannin at TE6 gives this team real depth at that position. But the rest of the starting lineup asks a lot of faith. Brock Purdy at QB13 and Chris Olave at WR11 are fine starters, not weapons, and from there the projected starters fall off fast, bottoming out with Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, a player who should be competing for a roster spot in most formats. The draft offered little relief: 12 chalk picks and zero steals mean this team is almost exactly what it looks like on paper, with no hidden upside waiting to emerge. When your best argument for optimism is hoping Gibbs carries you while everyone else overperforms their projection, the ceiling is lower than the floor needs to be.

SpectacularLes finished 2026 at the 61st percentile and seventh in Fallout 3, which is about as median as a team can be without seeming like it was designed that way. The margins are real, and they cut both directions. On the upside, Lamar Jackson at QB3 stacked with Zay Flowers at WR16 gives this team a legitimate ceiling, the kind of week where everything goes sideways for opponents and SpectacularLes walks away with a comfortable win. Trey McBride at TE2 is a quiet edge that compounds over a long season. But the floor is exposed in spots: Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest starter at RB27, and the draft leaned almost entirely on chalk, with just three values across the board and a notable reach on Rashod Bateman, taken nearly three rounds ahead of his ADP. A team that drafted conservatively and starts Warren in crunch spots is betting that its ceiling plays more often than its floor. In a format where margins decide everything, that is either a reasonable wager or a slow bleed. Probably both.

NoMoreWarmHugs didn't chase the flashy pick or swing for the fences on a boom-or-bust gamble. They just kept winning exchanges. Joe Burrow at QB4 slid to them in Round 2, Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 fell more than a round past his ADP, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 did the same, two wide receivers the rest of the field essentially handed over for free. Stack those values on top of Brock Bowers at TE1 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and you have a lineup with real teeth at the top. The one genuine variable is Burrow, who is arguably the best fantasy quarterback in the league when healthy but has a well-documented history of significant injuries that can erase entire seasons. When he has played, the production has been elite, and the weapons around him are all back, so the ceiling here is massive. At 61st percentile in the field heading into 2026, NoMoreWarmHugs has the kind of quietly constructed roster that tends to look a lot smarter by October.

Flutie Flakes lands at 64th percentile in the field and fifth in Fallout 3, which sounds like a team that drafted carefully and stayed in their lane. They did not. Four major reaches dot this roster, and yet the finished product is genuinely good, which is either a vindication of process or a reminder that confidence and recklessness look identical until the results come in. The case for conviction starts at the top: Josh Allen is a QB1, Trevor Lawrence is a QB10, and Nico Collins is a WR9, and none of those players arrived without the manager paying up. The Adonai Mitchell reach at pick 12.07 against an ADP of 15.09 is the one that will define the narrative, because if Mitchell develops into a weekly starter, this whole draft looks like vision rather than stubbornness. The floor here is solid regardless, with Tyler Warren as a TE4 and Tee Higgins as a WR19 providing real anchor value. Flutie Flakes reached for a ceiling and mostly found one. That is a harder trick than it looks.

TheEsquilax didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept connecting. The foundation is a receiver group that would make most managers in the Fallout 3 division quietly reconsider their life choices: Puka Nacua at WR1, A.J. Brown at WR8, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 all project as starters, and Wilson himself was a genuine value, falling a full round past his ADP before TheEsquilax scooped him at 5.07. That kind of quiet patience showed up across the draft, which logged four values and zero major reaches. The minor reaches that did appear, Brown, DK Metcalf, Hunter Henry, were all modest and concentrated at positions where the manager clearly had conviction. The Jalen Hurts and Dallas Goedert stack adds a reliable floor to the QB room. At 65th percentile and fourth in the division, this roster is not a championship lock, but it was built without a single embarrassing moment, and in a field this competitive, clean drafting is its own kind of statement.

Choppa City Jukers didn't need a lottery ticket to build a contender in Fallout 3, they just needed to keep winning small. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster two players who can carry a week on their own, and the supporting cast around them is where the draft really earns its stripes. DeVonta Smith (WR14), Ladd McConkey (WR20), and D.J. Moore (WR26) were all secured as projected starters, with Chase Brown falling a full round past his ADP to land at RB11. That is not luck, that is a manager who did their homework and let the board come to them. Mike Evans brings real upside after signing with the 49ers following a difficult injury-shortened season in Tampa, and at WR27 the price was right. The result is a squad sitting at 67th percentile tournament-wide and third in the division, not because of one bold swing, but because almost every decision quietly held up.

scottyknows sits second in Fallout 3 and in the 82nd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet is a big reason why. The headline is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 anchoring a starting group that projects to put points on the board week after week, and scottyknows got Achane a full round later than market price. Tucker Kraft at TE5 pairs with a Jordan Love stack that carries real upside if Green Bay leans on Love's arm the way the Packers are reportedly planning to, though Kraft is returning from a late ACL injury and the receiving room around Love has never given him the volume to consistently rank as a fantasy QB1. The draft discipline shows up in the counting too: four good values and a steal, with Jake Ferguson sliding all the way to 10.12 despite projecting as TE12. One minor reach on Brandon Aiyuk late in round 17 is barely worth mentioning. This roster was built with patience and precision, and the standings reflect it.

engineerchange enters 2026 looking like the blueprint for how this tournament is supposed to be drafted, and the numbers back up every bit of that swagger. Sitting first in Fallout 3 and in the 91st percentile of the entire field, this roster was built with the kind of patience and precision that makes other managers question their life choices. The crown jewel of the draft is Malik Nabers, a WR12 projection scooped up at pick 6.05 when his ADP was 3.11, a two-and-a-half-round windfall that would make any scout blush. Caleb Williams and Justin Herbert anchor things at quarterback, with Herbert himself arriving as a quiet steal, falling nearly a full round past his ADP into engineerchange's lap. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 keep the starting lineup flush with upside. The draft logged just one minor reach across the entire board and zero major ones. When a team posts a 78-percent win rate the year prior and then drafts cleaner than that, the only honest response is to tip your cap and move on.
