ThomasEmerick finished 2025 in the 38th percentile and the trajectory in 2026 looks worse, not better, with a projected 5th-percentile standing that puts this roster near the bottom of the Princess Peach Division and almost the entire field. The honest problem is that the high-end talent simply does not match the draft capital spent to acquire it. Justin Herbert cost a 2.04 pick, reached 1.4 rounds early, and while QB8 is a fine projection, burning that kind of premium selection on a quarterback in a positionless format is the kind of decision that quietly poisons a roster. The two players who could flip the narrative, Bucky Irving and Bhayshul Tuten, are projected RB21 and RB25 respectively, useful but not the difference-makers a rebuilding roster needs. Tuten's upside is real if the Jacksonville backfield opens up the way the offseason suggests it might, but "maybe the backfield opens up" is a thin thread to hang a season on. There are no obvious levers left. This is a team hoping things break right, which is another way of saying a team without a plan.

There is no charitable read available for jameskozak in 2026, and the draft sheet confirms it in brutal detail. Christian McCaffrey and Jonathan Taylor give this roster a legitimately elite foundation, projected at RB3 and RB4 respectively, but the construction around them is where things fall apart, and they fall apart in a very specific, self-inflicted way. jameskozak posted zero steals and zero values across the entire draft while racking up three major reaches, the worst of which was grabbing Chris Brazzell II at pick 16.02 when his ADP sat at 23.07, a 7.4-round overpay for a WR101 projection that should not be anywhere near a starting lineup. Terry McLaurin was taken nearly two rounds early as well, and he projects as a WR24, which is fine, except fine does not justify the cost when your receiver group bottoms out at Romeo Doubs as your projected weakest starter. A team that finished in the sixth percentile of scoring last season and now drafts like it is hunting for favorites rather than value is not rebuilding, it is repeating. Division rank 11, 20th tournament percentile, and no reason to expect otherwise.

The Fantasy Couriers sit 10th in the Princess Peach Division and at the 26th tournament percentile, and the draft chart offers little comfort: two major reaches, four minor reaches, and just one steal across the whole board. That steal, Jake Ferguson at TE12, is a fine footnote, but a footnote does not flip a projection. The most useful story on this roster is Harold Fannin, a TE6 projection who earned that number by outplaying his predecessor in Cleveland and inheriting the starting role outright. The problem is that Fannin's ceiling runs directly through a Browns offense that could hand the keys to Deshaun Watson, and Watson is not exactly a rising tide. Rashee Rice checks in at WR13 and gives the team a genuine weapon, but the drop-off is steep, with Michael Wilson projecting as a WR39 and the weakest projected starter on the field. Drake Maye grades as a QB2 and flashes real upside, but when the margin for error is this thin, upside is just another word for hope.

Chasen JJs Fantasy finished 2026 feeling like a house that looks fine from the street but has a cracked foundation. The receiving corps is genuinely impressive, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) anchoring a group that grades out strong. But the rest of the roster conspires against them. Saquon Barkley (RB8) gives the backfield a credible top end, yet Rico Dowdle projects as the weakest starter at RB32, which is a real ceiling on weekly floor production. The draft board tells a similarly frustrating story: Chasen logged zero steals, two values, and absorbed two major reaches, most painfully Alvin Kamara at RB50, taken a full 3.2 rounds ahead of his ADP. That is not aggressive roster-building, that is leaving chips on the table while also overpaying for them. The team sits ninth in the Princess Peach division and ranks in the 31st percentile of the field, and with the draft leverage already spent and the projections baked in, there is no obvious move left to make this roster into a contender.

DCHoosierGirl drafted almost perfectly by the numbers and still landed in the bottom half of the Princess Peach division, which is the kind of outcome that should come with a formal apology from the universe. The process was sound: 17 chalk picks, two genuine values, and only one real mistake, Jalen Tolbert at WR102 taken a staggering 6.2 rounds ahead of schedule. The problem is not how the roster was built but what it produced. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Joe Burrow at QB4 are legitimate anchors, and Breece Hall alongside Chase Brown gives this team a credible backfield core. But the projections flatten out fast after that, and Chuba Hubbard sitting at RB29 as the weakest projected starter is a quiet indictment of the depth beneath those top names. After a 2025 season that finished in the 95th percentile of scoring, the 45th percentile projection this year stings. DCHoosierGirl did the homework, got fair prices, and the market still did not care.

Only Winners Get Wings sits at 47th percentile and seventh in the Princess Peach Division, which means every week is a coin flip dressed up as a football game. The roster has real anchors: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Ashton Jeanty checks in at RB7, and Tyler Warren slots at TE4, giving this team a legitimate core that can beat anyone on a given week. The problem is the margins, and the margins here cut both ways. The Bo Nix and Jaylen Waddle stack is a reasonable swing, but Nix projects at QB15, which is good enough to keep pace and rarely good enough to win a week outright. The draft tendencies compound the concern slightly: Rachaad White came off the board two rounds ahead of his ADP at RB39, which is the kind of draft-room enthusiasm that rarely pays off at that projection level. This team will not fold, and it will not frighten anyone. It will simply need Gibbs, Jeanty, and Warren to be exactly as good as advertised while waiting for the field to blink first.

SDragonhead sits at the 49th tournament percentile, which is about as on-the-nose a definition of "fine" as you will ever find. The floor here is legitimate: Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of advantage that quietly wins close weeks, A.J. Brown at WR8 gives the lineup a true alpha, and Derrick Henry at RB12 still commands respect even if the clock is ticking on his legs. But the ceiling is where the uncertainty lives. Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and Carnell Tate at WR29 are all projected starters with real upside and real question marks baked into those numbers. Trevor Lawrence at QB10 can lift this roster on a good stretch, but Daniel Jones sits behind him at QB25 for a reason. The draft was almost entirely chalk, meaning there are no late-round lottery tickets hiding in this lineup to bail out a cold week. SDragonhead will not blow anyone out. It will not roll over either. Margins decide this season, and right now those margins are too close to call.

Deredactyl didn't win the draft on any single pick. They won it by not losing it. The top of this roster is genuinely hard to argue with: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the Princess Peach division would trade for without hesitation, and Jayden Daniels landing at QB5 after slipping a full round past his ADP is exactly the kind of quiet competence that separates a good draft from a forgettable one. Layer in four projected starters in the running back tier, from Josh Jacobs at RB16 through Quinshon Judkins at RB22, and you're looking at a roster where the depth isn't papering over a weak top end, it's reinforcing one that already holds up. Five values, thirteen chalk, and zero major reaches in the draft log tells you this was a disciplined room. The 2025 campaign finished at the 100th percentile in scoring, which sets a high bar, but the construction here suggests Deredactyl is at least asking the right questions about how to clear it.

theleafnode didn't win the draft with a single thunderbolt pick. They won it by not losing it, and the numbers bear that out: 16 chalk selections, two values, and zero major reaches across the entire board. The foundation is legitimately difficult to argue with. Josh Allen is a QB1, Colston Loveland projects as TE3, and Tucker Kraft slots in at TE5, giving this roster two premium contributors at a position where most managers are scraping. The double stacks, Allen paired with Dalton Kincaid and Jordan Love paired with Kraft, add a layer of upside that could inflate a good week into a great one. Kincaid does carry real injury concern after a knee issue that Bills GM Brandon Beane described as too early to call for 2026, and that's the one genuine question mark in an otherwise settled lineup. The 2025 campaign landed at the 23rd percentile in scoring, so there is ground to make up. But the construction here is sharper, the top end is better, and theleafnode enters the Princess Peach division sitting

comfortably at the 72nd tournament percentile with every reason to expect the results to follow the process this time.

Unit1979 lands at third in the Princess Peach division and the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: nearly the entire roster was taken at or near consensus value, with the execution sharp enough that the edge is baked in from pick one. The receiver group is the engine here, with Puka Nacua (WR1), Nico Collins (WR9), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Jameson Williams (WR21) all projected as starters and all projecting as top-25 options at their position. That is not luck, that is a manager who identified a tier and attacked it. The Matthew Stafford and Nacua stack adds a correlation bonus that could pay off in big weeks when the Rams are cooking. Brenton Strange came in as the one legitimate value, sliding to 11.03 against an ADP of 9.11 and landing as a projected starter at TE17. Nothing here screams lottery ticket, but Unit1979 does not need one. A 61 percent win rate and nearly 4,800 points in 2025 say this manager builds floors, and this roster was built the same way.

Murrrk didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by consistently winning the small battles, and those accumulate. Five value picks across a draft of 20 rounds is exactly the kind of quiet competence that shows up at the top of standings in October. The headliners are real: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a backfield foundation that most managers would envy, and Achane arriving nearly a full round past his ADP means Murrrk was paying attention when others weren't. Jalen Hurts, projected QB9, fell almost a full round past his ADP as well, landing at 4.09 for a manager who simply stayed patient while the board did the work. George Pickens at WR10 costs a minor reach, but taking a projected WR10 at 2.09 is the kind of reach that ages well. The result is a roster that projects 87th percentile in the field, second in the Princess Peach division, and built with the margins that win leagues, not the highlights that win arguments.

Koopa Troopa DeJean didn't need a lottery ticket to build a contender, just a draft that kept finding value where the board offered it. James Cook falling more than a round past his ADP to land at RB5 was a coup, and pairing him with TreVeyon Henderson at RB19, another player who slid a round and a half, gave this team a backfield foundation that most managers in the Princess Peach division would envy. The receiver group is where things get genuinely impressive: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 form a top-end duo, and Malik Nabers arriving at WR12 after sliding nearly a full round turns impressive into something close to unfair. The Jaxson Dart and Nabers stack ties those investments together. Brock Purdy carries real injury and weapons concerns heading into 2026, but at QB13 he functions here as a high-floor complement rather than the load-bearing wall. Five values against one major reach in a positionless format is a draft that consistently came out ahead, and at 92nd percentile, the results back up that read.
