verbalrugby enters 2026 sitting at the 5th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change the trajectory. The roster leans hard on a strong running back group, with Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and De'Von Achane at RB6 anchoring things, but when your receiving options thin out to Malik Nabers at WR12 and Courtland Sutton at WR37, you are asking a lot of two players to carry an entire side of the roster. The quarterback situation compounds the problem. Bo Nix grades out at QB15, which is fine until you remember that verbalrugby burned a seventh-round pick on Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 who went five-plus rounds before the market agreed. That is the kind of draft capital that should have been shoring up weaknesses, not backing up a starter who was already in the fold. Nix has a safe floor given his volume, but this team needed a ceiling, and nothing in the draft suggests they found one.

SoulaPowa lands at 11th in the Tecmo Bowl division and the 23rd percentile of the field, and it is hard to find the hidden gear that changes that projection. The top of the roster is genuinely decent: Lamar Jackson stacks with Zay Flowers, Trey McBride grades out at TE2, and Kyren Williams and Josh Jacobs give the lineup a pair of viable RB starters. The problem is that everything below that tier falls off a cliff. Michael Pittman, the projected weakest starter at WR44, is the player being asked to hold the lineup together when things go sideways, and that is a fragile plan. The draft board does not offer much comfort either, with 14 chalk picks, one piece of real value in T.J. Hockenson, and a major reach on Jacobs at 1.7 rounds early suggesting the manager may have already spent ahead of the curve to get here. SoulaPowa is a team that needed everything to break right and instead arrived at a place where the ceiling and the floor are uncomfortably close together.

There is a particular kind of fantasy heartbreak reserved for managers who did everything right and still wound up here, and scifijon has earned every bit of it. The draft was disciplined almost to a fault: Christian McCaffrey slid to the second round, Kenneth Walker III fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and Alvin Kamara arrived in round 17 like a gift left on the doorstep. Steals and values outnumber reaches four to one. By any process-based accounting, this should be a contender. And yet the team sits tenth in the Tecmo Bowl division and projects to the 28th percentile of the field, which means the universe has looked at scifijon's tidy draft receipt and shrugged. The starters are real, Justin Jefferson and McCaffrey heading a lineup that looks the part, but the depth collapses fast, and Chigoziem Okonkwo projecting as the weakest projected starter at TE19 is the sort of detail that haunts a manager at two in the morning. The process was sound. The outcome is a eulogy.

CalebRavens enter 2026 sitting ninth in the Tecmo Bowl division and in just the 31st percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The foundation looks decent enough on paper: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and James Cook at RB5 give the lineup legitimate star power, and both were taken at reasonable cost. But the 2025 campaign already told the story, an 11-25 record and a 20th-percentile scoring season, and the 2026 projections suggest more of the same. Below the top tier, the supporting cast thins out fast. Makai Lemon grades out as the weakest projected starter at WR40, and the depth behind the headliners is a collection of fringe contributors who project as WR66, WR74, and beyond. The draft offered no steals, just two values against thirteen chalk picks and a handful of minor reaches, meaning there is no buried treasure waiting to emerge. This roster is not broken in one obvious place, it is just quietly insufficient across the board, with no clear fix available.

CommishDig enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting eighth in the Tecmo Bowl division and projecting out at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much in the way of hope. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 all projecting as starters, but that strength gets diluted fast. The quarterback situation is quietly catastrophic: Tyler Shough projects as QB20 and Cam Ward as QB23, meaning CommishDig is leaning on two of the weakest projected starters at the position in the entire tournament. In a positionless format, you can compensate for almost anything with enough quality depth, but quality depth requires good drafting, and this roster logged zero steals, fourteen chalk picks, and a major reach on Ryan Flounoy taken nearly three rounds before his ADP. The top of this roster is real. Everything behind it is a prayer, and the schedule does not grade prayers.

twatterson29 sits seventh in the Tecmo Bowl division and in the 43rd tournament percentile, and the roster does not hide why. The wide receiver group has genuine upside, Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Nico Collins (WR9) are legitimate weapons, but the supporting cast dissolves fast, with Rashid Shaheed landing at WR57 after being reached nearly two and a half rounds early, and Rashod Bateman at WR92 after a reach of more than five rounds. Paying that kind of premium for depth players is the kind of draft math that haunts a manager come week three. The running back group grades average at best, with Rhamondre Stevenson projected as the weakest starter at RB31, and Breece Hall (RB14) is not elite enough at that ranking to carry a lineup on his own. Chase is a legitimate ace, but one ace does not win a tournament, and with two major reaches baked into the draft and no obvious waiver magic to conjure, twatterson29 looks like a team that has already spent its leverage.

showyadukes didn't reshaping this draft with one splashy gamble. They just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick. The foundation is legitimately strong: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, and Saquon Barkley, despite a 2025 step back and genuine whispers about a lighter workload in Philadelphia, still slots in as RB8, giving this roster a top-of-the-lineup punch that most teams in the Tecmo Bowl division would envy. The draft execution quietly backs the roster up, too. Joe Burrow lands as QB4 and was taken a half-round past his ADP, and David Njoku came off the board a full two rounds after his, meaning showyadukes collected real value without forcing anything. The wide receiver group is the one area where the projections thin out, with Quentin Johnston as the projected weakest starter at WR41, but in a positionless format that limitation is manageable when your best players are this good. Sitting sixth in the division and in the 57th percentile of the field, this team isn't the story yet. It has the pieces to become one.

Brutus0114 landed in the 65th percentile of the field not because of one splashy pick but because round after round the board just kept going their way. The foundation is real: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 give this roster two projected top-tier contributors, and the Goff-St. Brown stack means those two are already tied together, so when Detroit moves the ball, Brutus0114 tends to benefit twice. Jake Ferguson slipping nearly two full rounds past his ADP and landing as a projected TE12 is the kind of quiet win that separates competent drafters from lucky ones. The one legitimate question mark is Kyler Murray, the projected weakest starter, who is walking into a Minnesota quarterback competition still carrying the shadow of a Lisfranc injury that cost him most of last season. The prevailing read is that the job is Murray's to lose, which is either reassuring or ominous depending on your tolerance for that phrase. Either way, the rest of this roster is sturdy enough to carry the uncertainty.

There was no singular heist in this draft, no moment where eearmyh2o mortgaged future picks to land a generational talent. Instead, this is a roster built pick by pick, each selection arriving at roughly fair market value or better, and the cumulative effect is something worth respecting. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, and pairing him with D.J. Moore as a stack means the team's ceiling rises every time Buffalo lights up a scoreboard. A.J. Brown at WR8, Rashee Rice at WR13, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 form a projected starting core that most managers would build entire drafts around, though Rice carries real weight beyond the stat sheet, between a knee procedure and a probation violation that could shave meaningful weeks off his season. The saving grace is that eearmyh2o does not need Rice to be heroic every week, just present. Matthew Stafford landing 1.4 rounds past his ADP adds quiet depth. Fourth in the Tecmo Bowl division and 74th percentile tournament-wide, this team did not overpay for its ceiling, and that discipline is exactly the point.

Last year was rough for DiamondDave1969, a 9-27 record and a scoring total that landed in the bottom 14 percent of the field. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Omarion Hampton at RB9, a pair of projected starters so productive at the top that the roster was already competitive before DiamondDave filled out the rest. Then came the draft intelligence: Justin Herbert landed at 4.12 despite an ADP of 3.09, and Travis Kelce slipped 1.7 rounds past his ADP before DiamondDave snapped him up at 9.01. Herbert stacks with Ladd McConkey, adding a layer of upside that last year's roster simply never had. The result is a team sitting third in the division and in the 77th percentile of the field, a genuine leap from the wreckage of 2025. This is not a team hoping to survive, it is a team built to remind the Tecmo Bowl what DiamondDave1969 looks like when things go right.

emacthecav didn't make any single move that will get replayed on a highlight reel, but round after round this draft quietly came out ahead, and the standings reflect it: second in the Tecmo Bowl division and the 80th percentile of the field. The foundation is a receiver group that is genuinely hard to argue with. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, George Pickens as WR10, and both Colston Loveland (TE3) and Tucker Kraft (TE5) give this lineup two of the better tight end options in the tournament. Jaxson Dart landed at QB11 after slipping nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Brian Thomas Jr. came in at WR31 after a similar fall of over a round, both without emacthecav having to reach. The one soft spot worth watching is Matthew Golden, the projected weakest starter at WR52, who hasn't yet turned early expectations into production and faces a thinning supporting cast in Green Bay. That's a manageable concern on an otherwise clean roster built by a manager who simply kept winning individual draft decisions until it added up to something.

Duke It Out is sitting at 95th percentile in the field and first in the Tecmo Bowl division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The quarterback situation alone would satisfy most managers: Drake Maye at QB2 and Caleb Williams at QB6, both projected starters, both taken at or near their value. But what separates this roster from the merely good ones is the discipline shown in the middle and late rounds. Harold Fannin was the marquee moment, a TE6 who slid more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed at 7.06 while other managers looked away. Then the patient work continued: Colby Parkinson nearly two rounds after his ADP, Jake Tonges a round and a half late, Xavier Worthy more than a round past his number. Seven value picks and one steal across the whole board, zero reaches, and a projected starting lineup that pairs Bowers at TE1 with Fannin at TE6. Wan'Dale Robinson is the weakest projected starter, and that is a fine problem to have.
