As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, stiles08 is facing a daunting uphill battle in both their division and overall standings. After a dominant 2024 campaign that saw them soar to a remarkable 97th percentile finish, the team now finds itself languishing at the bottom of their division, the Washington State Beavers, ranking 12th, and struggling in the 15th percentile overall. Despite having a formidable tight end duo in Trey McBride and Evan Engram, the rest of the roster appears fraught with challenges. The wide receiver corps is particularly concerning, with Michael Pittman projected as a starter despite his WR48 status. While Marvin Harrison Jr. and Chris Godwin offer some hope, the overall depth and strength of the position rank among the weakest in the division. Drafting Darnell Mooney and Tua Tagovailoa later than expected offered some consolation,

but the team reached significantly on players like Bucky Irving and James Cook, raising questions about the strategy behind those picks. Even with stack bonuses from Kyler Murray paired with Marvin Harrison Jr. and Trey McBride, inconsistency looms large, casting a shadow over any potential for success this year. The success of last season feels like a distant memory as this year's outlook appears bleak, with little to inspire confidence for a turnaround.

running back department, proudly holding his title as the weakest link. Despite Bijan Robinson's best efforts to carry the load, Travis Etienne—a tasty reach himself—and J.K. Dobbins are more likely to share the spotlight of underachievement. With this roster, Turd Ferguson may just redefine what it means to aim high and hit low.
