Kyler Murray and Matthew Stafford earlier than necessary now loom large over this weary squad. As they navigate the challenges of the upcoming season, NeilG51628 must rely on their running backs and tight ends to carry the load if they hope to improve their standings and recapture some of last year's magic.

In this realm, where Josh Jacobs' early arrival at 2.03 and Zach Ertz's unexpected embrace at 10.10 might seem folly, woobennynmu dances on the line between brilliance and madness, a team eternally teetering on the edge of potential and absurdity.

quarterback and receiver performances to climb higher in their standings and make a significant impact this season.
