J.J. McCarthy and Sam Darnold round out the QB lineup with performances that could best be described as enthusiastic attempts at mediocrity. It's a curious strategy, relying on tight ends to carry the load, but when you've got Brock Bowers TE1, maybe leaning on him like a crutch isn't such a bad plan, especially when Jonnu Smith TE15 appears to have joined mainly to ensure nobody feels left out on the bench. Meanwhile, the wide receiver corps, led by the likes of Travis Hunter WR12 and Tetairoa McMillan WR24, are poised to remind everyone that you don't need to make flashy catches when your main

job is keeping the bench warm. The team's draft decisions were a masterclass in timing, though perhaps not in the way fantasy experts typically recommend; Bryce Young picked at 5.07 was the kind of inspired move that usually earns a slow clap or two. Yet, amidst this kaleidoscope of quirky choices, there's Jake Ferguson—a lone bright spot snatched after his ADP, proving even a stopped clock is right twice a day. With an optimistic division rank of 12, GreyDuck is ready to tackle another season, no doubt fueled by the winds of youthful exuberance—or possibly just the winds.

Meanwhile, Baker Mayfield (QB9) offers a solid backup option, providing a small stack advantage when paired with wide receiver Mike Evans (WR21). However, the receiving corps ranks 8th in their division, with D.J. Moore (WR22) and Jaylen Waddle (WR30) needing to step up alongside Jerry Jeudy (WR32) to

elevate SullyItUp's standing. The tight end position remains a concern, with Dalton Kincaid (TE13) stepping into a starting role, albeit selected slightly later than his projected draft value. The team gambled by picking Amari Cooper much earlier than his ADP, which could prove costly or rewarding. As the season unfolds, SullyItUp will rely heavily on their quarterbacks to overcome challenges and improve their standings both within the division and across the broader competition.
